THREE-RUN FIRST STANDS AS CARDS DOWN SURGE: Edwin Nuñez,

Wilfredo Pereira and Andrew Marrero made a three-run first inning stand as the Springfield Cardinals defeated the Wichita Wind Surge 3-1 on Friday night at Riverfront Stadium. Pereira got the win for Springfield with 5.1 scoreless innings and Marrero picked up his second save of the season with a 1-2-3 ninth. The Cardinals collected 12 hits and got at least one hit from all nine starterrs, including multi-hit games from four different hitters. Springfield, however, went 2-for-11 with runners in scoring position. The Cardinals are 9-1 against the Wind Surge this season.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Pierson Ohl** makes his 9th start (10th appearance) for the Wind Surge...Picked up the win in his last start on Sunday against San Antonio allowing just 1 R on 4 H with 5 K over 6.2 IP...Wichita won the game 3-1...Over 5 starts in May went 2-0 with a 2.20 ERA after going 1-2 with a 5.40 ERA in April...Has struck out 43 batters while walking 9 in 48.2 IP...Started against the Cardinals on April 13 at Hammons Field and took the loss allowing 4 ER on 6 H with just 1 K over 5.0 IP... Allowed 2 HR, one to RJ Yeager and one to Ramon Mendoza...Split the 2023 season between High-A Cedar Rapids and Wichita going a combined 9-7 with a 3.32 ERA, striking out 115 while walking just 18 batters in 127.1 IP over 24 appearances (21 starts)...Went 2-1 with a 3.52 ERA in 3 starts against the Cardinals last season...Spent the 2022 season with Low-A Fort Myers going 6-7 with a 3.53 ERA...Selected by the Twins in the 14th round of the 2021 draft out of Grand Canyon... Went 10-2 with a 2.60 ERA with 7 CG in 15 starts as a junior at GCU...WAC Pitcher of the Year and WAC Tournament MVP...2nd team All-American by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, GCU's first Division I All-American...24 years old

CARDS MAKE FIRST OF TWO TRIPS TO WICHITA: The Cardinals make their first trip into Kansas this week for a six-game series against the Wichita Wind Surge (Double-A, Minnesota Twins). The Cardinals swept the Surge in a six-game series at Hammons Field in early April, and the two clubs split 24 games 12-12 in 2023.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

MAY I END WITH A FLURRY?: After starting the month of May 5-9 incluiding a stretch of losing 6 straight and 9 of 12, the Cardinals finished strong winning 3 of their last 4 and 5 of 7. The Birds went 13-14 in May.

HITS, HITS: This week in Wichita the Cardinals' bats have gotten hot, wrapping out double-digit hits in three of the four games at Riverfront Stadium. Springfield is batting .292 through the first four games and are batting .302 over their last 12 games, averaging 9.6 hits per game during that time. For the season the Cardinals are batting .273, the top mark in Double-A, and have 439 hits, 17 more than any other Double-A team.

SWINGS AND MISSES: After finishing the month of April at 7th in the Texas League in strikeouts, the Cardinals pitching staff has been racking up the whiffs in the month of May. Springfield's 238 strikeouts in May ranked 3rd in the Texas League behind NW Arkansas (248) and Corpus Christi (239). The Cards now rank 3rd in the circuit with 445 K's. Cardinal starters are 2nd in the Texas League in K's with 239 trailing only Corpus Christi. This week in Wichita the Cardinals sport a 2.83 ERA over 4 games.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats. The Cards have struck out just 348 times in 49 games, the 3rd-fewest in all of full-season Minor League Baseball. Springfield trails the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (341 K in 48 games) and Frisco RoughRiders (342 K). The Cards are averaging just 7.1 K's per game.

NIP AND TUCK: Springfield has excelled so far this season in close games, especially of late. After Tuesday night's 2-1 victory, the Cardinals are 12-3 in games decided by one run this season. Four of the Cards' last six wins have been by one run, and over their last 6 wins total they have outscored their opponent by just 8 runs.

BIG INNINGS, LONGBALL PLAGUING CARDS STAFF: So far in 2024, home runs and the big inning have hurt the Birds. Springfield has surrendered 36 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 36 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 140 of the 261 total runs scored by the opposition, 53.6% of the runs the Birds have allowed this season. Springfield has allowed that production in just 8.8% of their innings pitched. In the other 380.2 IP Springfield has allowed 121 runs, which comes out to 2.865 runs per 9 innings.

The Cardinals have also allowed 57 homers in 49 games this season, most in Double-A.

RED HOT RIVAS: Riding a six-game hitting streak and an extended solid 12-game stretch, Cardinals shortstop **Jeremy Rivas** has seen his name rise amongst the top hitters in the Texas League at 4th among qualified hitters with an average of .314. Over his last 13 games since May 16, **Rivas** is batting .390 (16-for-41), 2nd in the league behind **Bryan Torres** (.409) during that time.

TORRES AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS: With a recent hot streak, Spring-field leadoff man **Bryan Torres** finds his name at or near the top of several Texas League categories. Torres is the leading hitter among active, qualified hitters in the Texas League with a .340 batting average. He is 3rd with a .416 OBP, tied for 2nd in hits (52) and 3rd in stolen bases (15). Springfield's leadoff man is 15-for-33 during a current 8-game hitting streak, and has led off the game for the Cardinals with a base hit in 5 of his last 8 games.

SLAM THE DOOR: Since the promotion of **Andre Granillo** to Triple-A Memphis on May 21, Cardinals reliever **Matt Svanson** has been a workhorse at the end of Springfield's bullpen. **Svanson** leads the Texas League in appearances with 20 and is 8-for-8 in save opportunities, also tops in the circuit. Since May 21, Svanson is 4-for-4 in save opportunities and has not allowed an earned run.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 23 straight games without a home run.




