**Tonight:** The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fourth game of a six-game series against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, High-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers, having won two of the first three games. Today is also the fourth game of a 12-game, 13-day road trip to Wisconsin and South Bend to end the Lugnuts' 2022 road schedule.

**Starting Matchup:** Right-hander **Jake Walkinshaw** makes his eighth start of the year with the Lugnuts, taking on Timber Rattlers right-hander **Israel Puello**, making his 10th start of the year. Each pitcher has struggled recently; Walkinshaw has allowed 14 runs in 14 innings in his last three appearances while Puello has allowed 29 runs in 23 innings in his last six appearances.

**Yesterday:** Lugnuts 6, Timber Rattlers 1. 20-year-old **Joey Estes** notched his second quality start of the year with six shutout innings, striking out six and limiting Wisconsin to one hit, in leading the Nuts to the victory. **Joshwan Wright** went 3-for-5 to lead an 11-hit attack, **Shane McGuire** drove in runs in three different innings, and **Sahid Valenzuela** delivered a two-run single in a three-run eighth to lead the offensive cause.

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts play the Timber Rattlers through Sunday before proceeding onward to Four Winds Field to challenge the South Bend Cubs, followed by a six-game homestand with the Dayton Dragons at Jackson Field to end the 132-game Midwest League season.

### LUG•NOTES

**Transaction:** Outfielder **Gabriel Maciel** went on the Covid Injured List, retroactive to yesterday, to become the Lugnuts' fifth current player on the Covid IL. In a corresponding move, infielder **Alexander Campos** returned to the Lugnuts from Single-A Stockton. This is Campos's fourth stint with the team, joining the Nuts previously from June 2-12, July 14-20, and July 27-August 9. Interestingly, Campos has had much success with the Nuts than the Ports, hitting .347/.458/.510 in 17 games in the Midwest League compared to .250/.377/.327 in 32 games in the California League.

**Draft Impact:** The first members of the 2022 draft to arrive with the Lugnuts, 12th-rounder **TJ Czyz** and 8th-rounder **Micah Dallas**, were added from the Arizona Complex League A's earlier yesterday and made their official Midwest League debut during last night's game. Czyz fired a scoreless seventh inning, striking out two batters around an Eduardo Garcia double, and Dallas recorded a perfect eighth inning with two strikeouts.

**Roster Crunch:** With Czyz's and Dallas's debut last night, the Lugnuts have now used 53 different players this year: 25 position players and 28 pitchers (plus two position players pitching), with 18 different starting pitchers. Pitcher **Mason Miller**, added to the roster yesterday, has yet to make his Lugnuts debut.

**Running Men:** The Lugnuts stole four more bases yesterday, two by birthday boy **Max Muncy**, giving them 40 steals in 47 attempts through 21 games in August, averaging over two stolen bases attempts per game. The increasingly aggressive Lugnuts had only eight stolen bases in April, 14 steals in May, 18 steals in June and 31 steals in July.

**They Know Their Trade:** Lansing has four players acquired by the Athletics via trade: **Cooper Bowman** (New York Yankees, acquired 8/1/22, for Frankie Montas and Lou Trivino); **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Joey Estes** (Atlanta Braves, 3/14/22, for Matt Olson); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17).

**Loaded With Talent:** With Miller and first baseman/outfielder **Lawrence Butler** activated from the Injured List yesterday, the Lugnuts now have seven top prospects on their roster. See below:

- Phil briefly played for the independent Laredo Lemurs in 2015, managed by Pete Incaviglia, hitting .311/.407/.473 with three home runs in 23 games. Laredo finished 57-43 and won the American Association championship.

- Since Phil is a native of Cooperstown, the National Baseball Hall of Fame is following his career closely. His gameworn Lugnuts baseball cap from the season's first weekend was sent to the Hall of Fame, by request.

**To the Show:** Ten former Nuts have debuted in MLB this year, namely A's pitchers **Norge Ruiz** (2021), **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013); Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra** (2018), catcher **Gabriel Moreno** (2019) and pitcher **Max Castillo** (2018); M's reliever **Danny Young** (2016); Red Sox pitcher **Josh Winckowski** (2019) and Marlins pitcher **Jake Fishman** (2017).

**Skipper for the Series:** When **Phil Pohl** went on scheduled vacation from August 16-21 vs. Great Lakes; **Veronica Alvarez** steps in as interim Lugnuts manager through Sunday. A standout at Villanova, Alvarez served as the starting catcher for Team USA Baseball Women's National Team, winning medals in 2008 (bronze), 2010 (bronze), 2012 (silver) and 2015 (gold). She joined the Team USA's coaching staff as assistant coach in 2018, rising to manager of the Women's National Team beginning in 2019, when she led Team USA to a 7-0 record and the gold medal at the Women's Baseball World Cup Qualifier in Mexico, earning her the honor of 2019 USA Baseball Rod Dedeaux Coach of the Year. Since 2019, she has worked as a coach in Spring Training for the Oakland Athletics.

**Inside the Park and Out of This World:** On August 2-3, 2022, CF **Denzel Clarke** joined Fred Bello (Everett, July 2-3, 2010) as the only Minor Leaguers since 2005 to have inside-the-park home runs in back-to-back games. The feat has never occurred in the Majors.

**2012:** The Nuts tied the franchise record with their 78th win of the season (on their way to 82 in the season) and pitched their league-leading 16th shutout of the year, with Noah Syndergaard and two relievers combining on a five-hitter over Fort Wayne, 4-0.  
**2017:** Nash Knight went 5-for-6 and Jake Fishman pulled off the rare feat of striking out seven batters in two innings of relief (four in the 8th, aided by a dropped third strike, and three in the 9th), but the Nuts lost 7-6 in 11 innings to Fort Wayne.

**Take Two:** Joined Lugnuts in initial flight from Spring Training and was scheduled to be part of the starting rotation, but was placed on Injured List on Opening Day and flew back to Arizona (elbow)... made two Arizona Complex League starts in rehab, totaling 4 2/3 IP... flew to Double-A Midland on June 24 to be ready in case of emergency, but was not needed... returned to Lugnuts on June 28, tossing three scoreless innings at Lake County.

**Back to the Rotation:** Allowed just two runs in 20 innings in first five starts with the Lugnuts ( 5 BB / 26 K, .181 avg.)... made first relief appearance on August 12, taking over for Jorge Juan one out into the 2nd inning... blanked the West Michigan Whitecaps through the 3rd, 4th and 5th innings, but then allowed seven runs in the 6th, capped by a three-run homer to center field by Trei Cruz.

**Last Start, August 19 vs. Great Lakes:** Struggled early with diminished heat, then settled in late and found his velocity, finishing with a fastball at 95-97 mph... pitched around a two-out single in the 1st inning... gave up Damon Keith solo HR in the 2nd... gave up leadoff walk and then four straight hits in four-run 3rd... issued leadoff walk in 4th, but runner caught stealing... set down final five batters faced, finishing five innings... Nuts lost, 12-7.

**In the Classroom:** Attained Bachelor's degree in Sport Management in three years at SNHU, posting a 3.88 GPA, then attained his MBA, focusing on project management, with a 4.0 GPA... interned in the SNHU athletic department, filming sporting events... twice was named Northeast 10 (NE10) Academic All-Conference and was named Academic All-District as a grad student.

**On the Field:** In high school, played shortstop when not pitching, batting second in the lineup... turned in an outstanding college career at SNHU, finishing 23-5, 16 saves – 11 in 2016, 2nd most in a season in school history – 1.93 career ERA, 76 G, 22 GS, 233 IP, 168 H, 62 BB, 234 K... finished 2nd in career wins, 2nd in ERA, 4th in strikeouts and 5th in innings pitched in SNHU record books... other NE10 rivals included Lake County's Zach Hart (Franklin Pierce University) and former Lugnut and current Stockton Port Edward Baram (Adelphi)... in 2019, named D-II East All-Region First Team, ABCA East All-Region Second Team, NCBWA East All-Region Second Team, and NE10 All-Conference First Team... SNHU was ranked No. 17 in the nation, but lost in the NCAA East-Super Regional to NYIT, finishing one victory shy of punching its ticket to the D-II College World Series in Cary, N.C.

**The Penmen?** Yes, SNHU's nickname is the Penmen, created by the editorial cartoonist of the Union Leader, Bob Murphy. Southern New Hampshire University was originally founded as New Hampshire College of Accounting and Commerce. The "pen" refers to the quill used by an accountant of colonial New Hampshire. The current logo, however, shows a Revolutionary War patriot holding an American flag bravely rushing forward.

**Into the Workforce:** Currently serves as Special Project Coordinator at Advanced Theory & Performance (ATP)... first came to ATP while rehabbing from Tommy John surgery in 2017, leading to post-college work opportunity.

**Going Pro:** Signed with the Athletics for \$1,000... debuted in 2019 with A's Green in the Arizona League, making 18 relief appearances, holding lefties to .200 avg. while righties hit .302... moved up to Stockton in 2021, converting from relief pitcher to starter, and had similar success vs. lefties (.248) compared to righties (.320)... worked this past offseason to change the spin of his slider to get more horizontal and vertical movement, seeking increased swing and miss.
