BULLPEN STRUGGLES IN 10-3 LOSS

Despite homers from **Jacob Berry** and **Ethan O'Donnell** and three hits from **Joe Mack**, the Jumbo Shrimp lost 10-3 to the Bulls. Mack lined an RBI single in the first inning. After Durham tied things in the third on a **Raynel Delgado** single, Berry's fifth-inning blast gave Jacksonville a 2-1 lead. However, **Logan Davidson** crushed a three-run homer in the bottom of the fifth and the Bulls added two more long balls during a four-run sixth. Delgado doubled in a pair in the eighth. In the ninth, O'Donnell's solo shot set the final margin at 10-3.

DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS

Jacksonville has yielded the fourth-fewest runs (124) in Triple-A while posting the level's fifth-best ERA (3.94). While the club leads all Triple-A staffs in strikeouts (329), the Jumbo Shrimp have also done a phenomenal job at turning batted balls put into play into outs; Jacksonville ranks second in Triple-A by turning 73.3 percent of balls put into play into outs. Only two clubs have recorded a rate of at least 72 percent this season.

STARTER FLUID

Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded two runs or fewer in 18 of the last 22 games. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have ceded only 38 runs, 36 earned, on 72 hits (5.8 H/9) in 111.0 innings for a 2.92 ERA, totaling 48 walks (3.9 BB/9) against 118 strikeouts (9.6 K/9). On the season, Jacksonville starters collectively lead Triple-A in batting average against (.191) and WHIP (1.13) while ranking second in strikeouts (150), third in innings (137.2), tied for third in fewest runs (54) and fourth in ERA (3.40), fewest hits (93) and GO/AO (1.25). Of the club's 30 games this season, Jumbo Shrimp starters have surrendered more than three runs just three times.

HOUSE OF HORRORS

Since rejoining Triple-A in 2021, the team Jacksonville has struggled the most against is by far the Durham Bulls. The Jumbo Shrimp are just 45-69 (.395) against the Bulls. In Durham, Jacksonville is 22-35 (.386), getting outscored by a 330-262 margin. The Jumbo Shrimp have won only three of the nine series the clubs have played at the DBAP since 2021.

ON THE OFFENSIVE

Heading into play on April 22, Jacksonville had scored at least five runs in a contest just three times in 22 affairs, ranking last in Triple-A in runs scored (68, 3.1 per game) and each slash line category (.186/.296/.282/.578). The Jumbo Shrimp have now plated at least five runs six times in the eight games since, awakening a previously-dormant offense. During this stretch, the club ranked fifth in Triple-A in runs scored (52, 6.5 per game). They also place in the top 12 in OBP (7th, .363), average (8th, .275), SLG (12th, .426) and OPS (10th, .789). Jacksonville was hitting just .166 with runners in scoring position over the season's first 22 games; they are 26-for-90 (.289) in those situation over the last eight contests.

SNELLING BEE

After **Robby Snelling** surrendered three runs in his April 3 start against Sugar Land - still the only time in 17 career Triple-A starts he has ceded more than two runs - the southpaw has been on a tear. Snelling has struck out 25 against only 10 walks and six hits allowed in 16.0 innings of two-run ball over his last three starts, posting a .118 opponents' batting average. The Reno, Nev., native has registered six career scoreless outings in Triple-A out of those 17 starts.

BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry struggled significantly over the 2025 season's first 33 games, going just 13-for-103 (.126/.229/.223/.452) at the plate with 35 strikeouts in 119 plate appearances (29.4 percent). The Queens Creek, Ariz., has been truly excellent since that point. Over his last 112 Triple-A games, Berry is batting .307/.394/.452/.846, cutting his strikeout rate by more than half at 14.2 percent with just 63 over 442 plate appearances. Over his last 19 games this season, Berry is 23-for-64 (.359/.463/.531/.994) with five doubles, two home runs, 14 RBIs, 14 walks and 11 runs scored.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville finished the month of April with a 14-14 record - it marked their first non-winning month of April since 2019, when they were just 10-15... Ten of the Jumbo Shrimp's 14 wins (.714) have come by margins of three runs or fewer.

ABOUT ROBBY

-Snelling was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the supplemental first round (39th overall) of the 2022 draft.

-*MLB Pipeline* ranks Snelling as the No. 39 prospect in baseball entering 2026.

-On July 30, 2024, the Padres traded Snelling, infielders Jay Beshears and Graham Pauley and right-handed pitcher Adam Mazur to the Miami Marlins in exchange for right-handed pitcher Bryan Hoeing and left-handed pitcher Tanner Scott.

-As a senior at Robert McQueen High School in Nevada, Snelling set a Nevada record for strikeouts in a seven-inning game with 20 strikeouts and posted a state large-class record with 145 strikeouts in 62.1 innings. He posted a 0.56 ERA.

-Snelling was a star high school quarterback and linebacker, and as a 4-star linebacker recruit, had offers to be a two-sport athlete in college. He likely would have committed to Arizona to play both sports, but when then-U of A baseball coach Jay Johnson accepted the same position at LSU, Snelling committed there to only play baseball. He passed on that commitment to sign with the Padres.

-During the summer of 2021, he participated in the High School All-American Game as well as in the All-Star High School Home Run Derby at Coors Field where he hit 21 home runs.

2025 SEASON

-Snelling was named the Marlins' Minor League Pitcher of the Year, an International League All-Star and a 2025 Rawlings Gold Glove Award® recipient for defensive excellence. He is the just the fifth Jacksonville player ever to earn a Gold Glove.

-Snelling was named the International League Pitcher of the Month for August after allowing just five runs (three earned) in 30.0 innings over five starts for a 0.90 ERA and 3-1 record. Among those five starts, he had two scoreless outings and struck out 38 against just nine walks. Opponents hit just .189 against Snelling.

-Snelling compiled three double-digit strikeout games with Jacksonville. He did not yield more than two runs in any outing in the regular season. In game one of a doubleheader on September 3 at Charlotte, Snelling fanned 13 batters, the most for a Jumbo Shrimp pitcher since 2019.

Painter and Snelling were the only two to reach Double-A.
