Welcome to the Show: Catcher Gabriel Moreno went 1-for-4 with a single and a run scored in his MLB debut Saturday for the Blue Jays at Comerica Park against the Detroit Tigers, becoming the 168th all-time Lugnut to reach The Show. He joins Oakland A's relievers Zach Logue and Zach Jackson and infielder Christian Lopes, Toronto Blue Jays utilityman Vinny Capra, Seattle Mariners reliever Danny Young and Boston Red Sox starting pitcher Josh Winckowski as former Lugnuts to make it to the Major Leagues this year.

**Heating Up:** OF **Lawrence Butler** is off to an excellent start in the month of June. He leads the team through 12 games with a .341 batting average, 15 hits, tied with three doubles and two triples. Butler currently has a 9-game on-base streak and an 8-game hitting streak. Butler started slow in April hitting .158 with 28 strikeouts, in May it got better swinging .258 with 23 hits and four HR. Now in June, he has started rolling. In 12 games: .341/408/.568 with 5 BB and 12 K.

Lansing, Here I come: OF Denzel Clarke, the Athletics 2021 fourth round selection, has been promoted from Stockton (A) to Lansing (A+) for the first time. The Athletics brought up the 22-year-old on June 13. This year in 42 games in Stockton: 14 2B, 2 3B, 7 HR, 26 RBI, 28 BB, 56 K, .295/.420/.545. In his debut on Tuesday, Denzel Clarke didn't get a hit, but did walk twice and stole a base.

**Onward and Upward:** After the conclusion to the Lugnuts series with West Michigan, the Athletics have promoted three Lansing Lugnuts up to Midland (AA). P **Jeff Criswell**, P **Hogan Harris** and OF **Austin Beck**. Criswell racked up 58 strikeouts in his 10 starts, and had a 2.88 ERA in May. Harris in seven starts, allowed just two earned runs with 18 K and 7 BB. The former 2017 first rounder and sixth overall pick Austin Beck hit the second most HR's (8) this year for the Nuts and was slashing .324/.349/.432 in 10 games in June.

Happy Hour: P Blake Beers has turned in three impressive starts for Lansing after moving up from Single-A Stockton in the California League. Beers debuted with 11 strikeouts in six scoreless innings at Beloit, followed up with seven strikeouts in six innings with two earned runs allowed at home against powerful Cedar Rapids, and then twirled seven innings of one-run ball yesterday against West Michigan. The results have been especially stunning considering Beers's college performance in Ann Arbor, where he recorded a 6.56 career ERA over 71 1/3 innings, including an 8.42 ERA in 25 2/3 innings as a senior last year before the Athletics selected him in the 19th round.

# 26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.
