EDUCATION DAY DOMINANCE: The Delmarva Shorebirds opened their series with the Salem Red Sox with a convincing 10-2 victory on Tuesday afternoon. The offense used a pair of five run innings in the third and the fifth to jump out to a huge lead early. Minor League rehabber, **Ryan Higgins**, drove in three runs with a bases clearing double in the fifth. In the fifth, they scored a pair of run on a pair of wild pitches before **Noelberth Romero** concluded the inning with a home run over the left field wall to make it 10-0. Led by starter **Alfred Vega**, the Red Sox were limited to just two runs on three hits on Tuesday as Delmarva cruised to an easy 10-2 victory in the series opener.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: The Shorebirds and Red Sox get set to play two games on Wednesday to make up a rain out from April 30 at Perdue Stadium. **Wyatt Cheney** will start game one for the 'Birds with **Jared Beck** getting the call for game two. **Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz** will get the ball for game one and the Red Sox No. 22 prospect has been tremendous this season for Salem as he owns a 5-1 record in 9 starts with a 2.29 ERA. This will be the second time Rodriguez-Cruz faces the Shorebirds with his only prior time coming on April 8 when he threw three shutout innings. **Luis De La Rosa** is slated to start game which is lined up to be a bullpen game for the Red Sox.

FEELIN' YOUNG: Carter Young has become an incredibly consistent hitter for the Shorebirds as of late. Since May 16, Young is batting .345 which is good for the second best average in the league in that 21 game sample size, behind **Jacob Burke** of Kannapolis (.388). He has scored 19 runs in that time frame which is the most in the Carolina League, and has an OPS of .933 during his current run. He has 33 runs scored total, which is tied for the most on the team with **Elio Prado**.

MOVING UP THE LADDER: Samuel Basallo's strong first season in affiliated baseball has elevated him to inside the Top 100 overall prospects for Baseball America as he comes in at No. 81 on the mid-season list. Basallo is now ranked the No. 7 prospect in a deep, Oriole's farm system and he is one of eight Baltimore prospects currently in the top 100.

WELCOME BACK TRENDON: Trendon Craig has had an instant impact for the for the Shorebirds since rejoining the team on June 9 after two months on the injured list. In four games since returning, Craig is 5/14 with two doubles, two RBIs, and has also drawn three walks. Craig has played in a total of ten games for the Shorebirds this season and has reached base at least once in all of them.

OVERCOMING ADVERSITY: The Shorebirds are currently in the midst of their toughest stretch of the season as they are 3-12 in their last 15 games. In this current stretch, they have lost two games by two runs, five games by one run, and four games in extra innings.

EXTRA BELLONY: Isaac Bellony has made an instant impact for the Shorebirds since joining their roster on May 30. In 11 games for the Shorebirds, Bellony is batting .279 (12/43) and has three doubles, three triples, with nine RBI. He's collected two RBI in three of those games and is already the team-leader in three-baggers after picking up his third on Tuesday night versus Down East.

SILENCE IS GOLDEN: Quietly, the hottest pitcher on the Delmarva staff is **Alfred Vega** who tossed another scoreless outing on Tuesday afternoon. Vega has not allowed a run in his last five appearances and has a scoreless streak of 18.1 innings after 4 more scoreless frames in the series opener at Salem.

BACK WHERE IT BEGAN: The Shorebirds head back to Salem where they face the Red Sox for the second time at Salem Memorial Ballpark. Delmarva won two of three from the Red Sox to open the season and are 7-2 against Boston's affiliate this season.

TODAY'S STARTER: Wyatt Cheney gets the ball for game one of the doubleheader against the Salem Red Sox. The right-hander will look for better luck this time around after five unearned runs scored on him in a 7-1 loss to Down East.

LAST OUTING (6/8 vs DE): Cheney was the victim of a tough defensive night in his last start as he allowed five unearned runs on four hits in a six-run loss to Down East last Thursday. The Delmarva defense committed a season-high six errors with five of them occurring while Cheney was on the mound.

vs. SALEM: This will be the second time Cheney will face the Salem Red Sox with this being the first time he starts against them. In his only other prior outing against the Sox on April 27, Cheney pitched three innings of relief allowing three runs (two earned) on five hits while striking out four. Delmarva would go on to win the game 8-5 and Cheney will get the winning decision.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: The right-hander appeared in just two games for the Shorebirds after being drafted out of McClennan Community College in Texas. His first outing was a full inning against the Pirates in the FCL where he dealt a full inning with two strikeouts as he retired the side in order. He faced just two batters in his only Delmarva appearance where he faced two batters, allowing a hit and a walk. Appeared in 16 games at McClennan in 2022, making 15 starts where he struck out 122 in 81.2 innings to earn a 10-3 record and an ERA of 3.20. Struck out 11 batters or more in three starts including a career-high 13 versus Hill College on March 19.



FELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

MANAGER



Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

PITCHING COACH



Bleday enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019. He is the brother of current Oakland A's Outfielder J.J. Bleday.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

HITTING COACH



Josh Bunselmeyer takes over as the Shorebirds Hitting Coach in 2023 after spending the last three seasons as a hitting coach for the Orioles between the Florida Complex League and the Dominican Summer League. Before coaching, Bunselmeyer played independent ball for the three season in the Frontier League as a utility player after playing college baseball for Saint Louis University.

FUNDAMENTALS COACH



Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.

Collin Murray is the Shorebirds Development Coach and this is his second season as a coach in Delmarva and in the Orioles' organization.
