The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the San Antonio Missions 9-3 on Wednesday evening from Riders Field, Frisco (25-22, 69-47) opened the scoring against San Antonio (22-24, 53-61) in the home half of the third inning when Alejandro Osuna broke the scoreless tie with a solo homer, his fourth as a RoughRider. In the bottom of the fourth the Riders added another run as Abimelec Ortiz crossed the plate on a sacrifice fly by **Aaron Zavala**, giving Frisco a 2-0 lead. **Kumar Rocker** was dominant again in his fifth start at the Double-A level. The Rangers No. 2 prospect spun 4.2 innings of scoreless baseball, surrendering just three hits and one walk while fanning eight. The Missions cut into the deficit in the fifth against a rehabbing Jacob Latz (1-0). Connor Hollis made it a 2-1 contest with a solo homer to left field. Latz allowed one run on two hits and two walks across one inning of work. Leading 2-1 in the home half of the sixth, Ortiz unleashed on a three-run homer to give Frisco a 5-1 advantage, Zavala tacked on a pair of runs with an RBI single in the seventh that plated Maximo Acosta and Ortiz to make it 7-1. The Riders pushed across three more runs in the bottom of eighth on an RBI double by Acosta that scored Tucker Mitchell before Cody Freeman delivered a sacrifice fly to push the lead to 9-1. San Antonio loaded the bases for the third time in four innings in the top of the ninth, scoring two runs on a groundout and a Marcos Castanon RBI single to make it 9-3. Rocker, Latz, Jackson Kelley, Dane Acker and Bryan Chi set a season-high by stranding 15 San Antonio runners on base. Offensively, the Riders notched twelve hits with both Osuna and Acosta collecting three hits. Mieses and Zavala each snagged two hits.

With Jacob deGrom expected to rehab for the RoughRiders, that would put Frisco at eight rehabbers this season. The hitters include Josh Jung and Nathaniel Lowe while Cody Bradford, Dane Dunning, Josh Sborz, Jacob Latz and Tyler Mahle make up the pitchers. In 2018, the RoughRiders had 12 rehabbers, the most in franchise history. This season marks the highest volume of rehabbers since 2018.

PLEASE DON'T HIT ME ONE MORE TIME:

The Riders pitching staff has been a strenghth this season, but they have struggled over their last eight games. During that stretch, Springfield and San Antonio have hit .340 (105-for-309) with 21 doubles, six home runs and averaging 7.0 runs per game on the offensive side, taking six of eight games. Frisco's bullpen had a 8.45 ERA (31ER/33.0 IP) and has allowed 58 hits over 33.0 innings while blowing leads in four of their six losses. The Riders have lost back-to-back series for the first time all season now and are 4-10 in their last 14 games.

HOMER HAPPY

On Friday, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with Luis Mieses capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit eight home runs in the last five games, with those eight home runs being second in the Texas League this week (Amarillo, 10). Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 84 across their 116 games (on pace for 99, which would be tied for the fourth-fewest in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

RISP-ECT THIS PLEASE:

Over the last 25 games, the Riders are fourth in the Texas League with a .738 OPS, third with a .264 batting average and are sixth with 4.3 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .197 (47-for-239) with runners in scoring position over their last 26 games.

READY TO ROCK(ER):

RoughRiders starting pitcher Kumar Rocker has been fantastic in his five starts with the RoughRiders since returning from his "Tommy John" surgery rehab this season. In the four starts, he has pitched 19.2 innings, allowing just one run on nine hits and three walks with 29 strikeouts. Additionally, he has been incredibly efficient, averaging just 13.0 pitches per inning with the Riders. Rocker, who was selected by the Rangers as the No. 3 overall pick in the 2022 draft, is the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers organization and the No. 1 pitching prospect.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 37-21 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco has a +65 run differential, a 4.08 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .765 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 32-26 with a 3.22 ERA, but a +21 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .638 OPS (10th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has nine of his 13 home runs at home while Abimelec Ortiz has hit nine of his 10 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .313/.408/.534/.942 at home as opposed to .138/.202/.204/.406 on

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

-During COVID-19, finding a place to throw was difficult, so he built a bullpen in the backyard of his home in Newmarket, Ontario to keep throwing. While most Canadian schools were not able to start playing baseball in 2021, Bratt made the decision to transfer to Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Georgia (outside of near Savannah). He completed his final year of high school online while playing baseball.

-After spending two months at GPA, he played in the MLB Draft League during the summer of 2021, going 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA while playing for the West Virginia Black Bears.

-Baseball America ranked Bratt as the No. 3 Canadian prospect going into the 2021 draft.

-Committed to play baseball at Florida State

-Made one start for Team Canada in the 2023 World Baseball Classic as a 19-year-old against Team USA, going 0.1 IP, 3 H, 6 R, 6 ER, facing MLB All-Stars Mookie Betts, Mike Trout, Paul Goldschmidt, Nolan Arenado, Kyle Tucker, Tim Anderson and IT Realmuto.

2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.

-After tough first start of the season (3.0 IP, 8 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 0 BB, 4 K vs. JS) with Hickory, has gone 6-3 with a 2.30 ERA over his last 16 games (14 starts) with 80 strikeouts to 16 walks over 74.1 innings.

-In last 10 games in Hickory (nine starts), went 4-1 with 1.35 ERA, striking out 55 over 53.1 IP to 11 walks, holding opponents to .182 batting average.
