PICARD'S FIRST-CAREER QUALITY START GIVES FIREFLIES 3-2 WIN: Coleman Picard recovered from a rough first inning by pitching five-straight scoreless innings to close out his first-career quality start in a Fireflies 3-2 win over the Charleston RiverDogs Friday night at Segra Park. Picard worked six innings, allowed two runs on four hits and gathered a pair of strikeouts before passing the ball to the bullpen. Dalton Hill, Michael Braswell and Andy Basora all spun one scoreless inning in relief to close out the game for Columbia. Basora earned his team-leading eighth save of the year in the win. He left the game-tying run 90 feet away on a groundout to end the game. After the win, the Fireflies are now 18-22 in one-run games.

LUMOS LOMBARDI: Michael Lombardi has been a master of the strikeout this season. Wednesday, he etched one strikeout in 1.2 innings of work. Lombardi leads the Carolina League with 122 strikeouts. That's the fourth-most strikeouts for a Fireflies pitcher in a single season in franchise history. Tony Dibrell owns the Fireflies single-season strikeout record at 147. Chase Ingram has the third-most strikeouts in a single season in franchise history. He wrung up 132 during the 2016 season.

DON'T LET THE MUGGLES GET YOU DOWN: After a slow start to the season, Sean Gamble has turned the page and become one of the top hitters in the Fireflies lineup. Since May 21, Gamble is hitting .259 across 73 games. He leads the team in stolen bases (32) and runs scored (47) and is second in OPS (.780) and third in OBP (.375) on the stretch. He is also one of five Fireflies to notch at least five homers since May 21.

THE BOY WHO LIVED: Josh Hammond has the second-most hits in a season in Fireflies franchise history. The infielder has 125 hits over his first 109 games including 24 doubles, three triples and five homers. The 124 hits trails only Ronnie Mauricio for Columbia. The current New York Mets infielder had 126 hits during the 2019 season.

HOMERING HISTORY: Friday, Gabriel Silva tallied the fourth two-homer game of the season for the Fireflies. It was Silva's second multi-homer game as a Fireflies player and his first since June 8, 2025 when he accomplished the feat at L.P. Frans Stadium. 21 Fireflies players have had multi-homer games over the team's first 10 seasons. Only eight players have had more than one multi-homer game. Gabriel Silva is now tied for the second-most multi-homer games in franchise history. Juan Carlos Negret leads the way. The outfielder had four two homer games in his 23 homer season in 2021.

I SOLEMNLY SWEAR THAT I AM UP TO NO GOOD: Friday night, Andy Basora earned his team-leading eighth save of the 2026 season. Columbia's righty hasn't allowed an earned run in his last five outings, dating back to August 15. On the run, he is 3-3 in save opportunities and has struck out 11 in 7.1 innings. He's held opponents to a .214 average on six hits and only one walk during the stretch. His ERA has dropped from 5.36 to 4.76 on the run.

MISCHIEF MANAGED: It's the final weekend at Segra Park during the 2026 season. Tonight is Harry Potter Night with a Mason wizard bobblehead giveaway and post-game drone show. Tomorrow night is Fan Appreciation Night with in-game giveaways, post-game fireworks, kids run the bases and a full-team autograph session.

He dominated in May with a 0.84 ERA across five appearances where he allowed just one run in 10.2 innings while whiffing 13. In June, he posted a 1.93 ERA with 18 strikeouts in 18.2 innings, to earn a promotion to the Columbia Fireflies. In his last start of the season September 5 at Myrtle Beach, he worked five scoreless innings and allowed five hits and one walk, while keeping the Fireflies in control for a 6-1 victory.

MiLB: Opened the 2025 season with a career-best six strikeouts across 2.1 innings in a 9-1 drubbing of the DSL Astros Orange June 2. He set career-bests in wins, ERA, innings pitched, strikeouts and opposing batting average in the DSL in 2025... Across three occasions in 2025, the southpaw worked at least three scoreless innings. The last time he did it was August 5 when he went 3.1 scoreless against the DSL Dodgers Bautista... Amezquita dominated lefties, holding them to a .210 average across 27 at-bats during the season.

2026: After a tough start in April, where the righty held a 12.10 ERA through eight appearances, Basora has quietly turned into one of Columbia's most consistent relievers. He recorded a 4.22 ERA in 10 appearances in May spanning 10.2 innings and is off to a hot start in June. The reliever is 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA in seven appearances over 10.2 innings in the third month of the season so far.

MiLB: After being signed, he made his debut in 2022 in the Dominican Summer league where he appeared in 13 games, logging 27 innings... Allowed one earned run or less in final seven appearances of standout 2023 season. In final season in DSL, the righty decreased his WHIP to 1.12 from 1.38. Went stateside in 2025 and transitioned to a full-time reliever role. He earned his first save in a 3-1 victory over the ACL Brewers June 4. Basora slung 1.1 scoreless frames in the contest.

He struck out 15 compared to just three walks and held opponents to a .140 average to compliment a 0.73 WHIP on the run...

MiLB: Was placed on The Fireflies 2025 Opening Day roster. After beginning the year with Columbia, he was assigned to the ACL Royals in May where he found his stride offensively. In June, he hit .299 with a .537 slugging percentage, where he had 20 hits, five doubles, three home runs, and eight RBIs. His strong production continued into July where he batted .304 with seven RBI's. His best stretch with Columbia came during a road series at Kannapolis April 15-20.
