LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones earned a series split and closed out a 6-3 B with a 8-1 victory vs. Hudson Valley on Sunday afternoon...Brooklyn erupted for 5 runs in the bottom of the first...C **Ronald Hernández** worked a 2-out bases-loaded walk before 2B **D'Andre Smith** cleared the bases with a 3-run double down the right-field line...Smith closed out the 5-run frame by stealing third and scoring on a throwing error...C **Chris Suero** added a solo home run in the 6th and Hernández capped the scoring with a 2-run knock in the 8th...3B **Jacob Reimer** and CF **Carson Benge** registered 2-hit games, while SS **Kevin Villavicencio** went 3-for-3 with a double...Hernández and Smith each had 3-RBI contests...RHP **R.J. Gordon** tossed 3.1 innings of shutout ball , taking a no-decision...RHPs **Dylan Ross**, **Ben Simon**, and **Anthony Nunez** combined to toss 5.2 innings of 1-hit relief, adding 7 strikeouts.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On April 15, 2022, RF **Brandon McIlwain** picked up a pair of hits, while C **Nic Gaddis** registered a double and a 2 RBI, as the Cyclones defeated Jersey Shore at home, 4-1...RHPs **Evy Ruibal** (0.1 IP), **Jesús Vargas** (3.0), and **Justin Courtney** (2.0) combined to throw 5.1 innings of 4-hit shutout relief in the win.

ROSTER MOVES: On Tuesday, the Cyclones made a series of roster moves...INF **Jesús Báez** was transferred to Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie and RHP **Justin Lawson** was added from Double-A Binghamton...SS **Kevin Villavicencio** was transferred to St. Lucie and OF **Troy Schreffler Jr.** was placed on the Development List in corresponding moves...Báez played 8 games for Brooklyn last season, going 8-for-30 (.267) with a home run and 4 RBI...In 2025, the 20-year-old went 5-for-23 (.217) in 6 games for the Mets...Lawson was on Binghamton's Development List, but posted a 2-4 record with a 2.49 ERA (17 ER in 61.1 IP) and tied for South Atlantic League lead in saves (8)...Villavicencio was 5-for-11 (.455) in 4 games with Brooklyn, while Schreffler Jr. is 1-for-15 (.067) in 4 games.

VETERAN PRESENCE: OF **Rafael Ortega** remains with the Cyclones on a minor league rehab assignment from Triple-A Syracuse...Through 2 games, the 33-year-old is 0-for-8 at the plate with a stolen base...This is Ortega's second stint in the New York Mets organization after spending most of the 2023 season with the club...The El Tigre, Venezuela native played 30 games at Triple-A Syracuse and another 47 with the Mets, hitting .219/.341/.272 with a home run and 8 RBI for the Big League club...Ortega has appeared in 425 MLB games with the Colorado Rockies, Los Angeles Angels, Miami Marlins, Atlanta Braves, Chicago Cubs, Chicago White Sox, and Mets, slashing .245/.322/.349/.671 with 22 home runs and 110 RBI...Ortega also played for Single-A Asheville in the South Atlantic League in 2011, hitting .294/.335/.438 with 9 homers and 66 RBI in 113 games.

SUERO SUAVE: C **Chris Suero** has picked up where he left off in Brooklyn so far in 2025...The Bronx native was recognized on MiLB's "Prospect Team of the Week" on Monday after going 10-for-29 (.345) with 5 doubles, 3 home runs, and 9 RBI over his first 8 games...Entering play on Tuesday, the 21-year-old leads the South Atlantic League in doubles (5), extra-base hits (8), and total bases (24)...He is also tied with 2 others for the league lead in home runs (3)...Suero also ranks 2nd in slugging percentage (.828) and OPS (1.234), as well as 7th in batting average (.345)...The 2022 international signee has a hit in 7-of-8 games played and reached base safely in all 8 contests.

THOR'S HAMMER: LHP **Zach Thornton** picked up right where he left off in 2024...After 5.0 more shutout frames on Saturday, the Grand Canyon product is now 2-0, has yet to allow an earned run, and holds a 14:2 strikeout-to-walk ratio...Thornton is 1 of just 2 pitchers in the circuit to have thrown at least 10.0 innings this season...He is also 1 of only 3 arms at the High-A level to toss 10.0 or more innings without allowing an earned run (Great Lakes' RHP **Brooks Auger** & Vancouver's RHP **Grant Rogers**)...Thornton is the only one to not allow a run at all...His 14 strikeouts are tied for 3rd in the SAL, while his outstanding 0.60 WHIP is 2nd amongst those qualified...Thornton also sits 5th in the circuit in batting average against (.121).

ROTATION IS ROLLING: Brooklyn's starters have been exquisite over the season's first 9 games...Cyclones starting pitchers possess a microscopic 1.42 ERA (6 ER in 38.0 IP)...Under the leadership of first-year pitching coach **Jordan Kraus**, the starters hold an impressive 47:12 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The 1.42 ERA is the lowest among starting pitching staffs in the South Atlantic League and second among all High-A franchises...Only Cincinnati's High-A Dayton (1.16) has tallied a lower ERA...Overall, Brooklyn's pitching staff has an SAL low 2.92 ERA (25 ER in 77.0 IP), which is good for third-lowest at High-A behind San Diego's High-A Fort Wayne (2.08) and Milwaukee's High-A Wisconsin (2.76).

R-ELI-ABLE: OF **Eli Serrano III** has impressed to begin his High-A career...On top of making an outstanding catch colliding into the left-field wall on Thursday night that was featured on ESPN's *SportsCenter* Top 10, the Fuquay-Varina, N.C. native has also shined at the plate...Serrano has reached base safely in 7-of-8 games played and collected a 4-game multi-hit streak from April 5-9...The left-handed swinger enters Tuesday tied for 4th in the South Atlantic League in walks (8), 6th in OPS (1.013), and 8th in on-base percentage (.457)...Serrano's 3 outfield assists are also tied for the most in the circuit.

REIM TIME: It's difficult to get out to much of a hotter start than Cyclones INF **Jacob Reimer**...Through 9 games, the California native is an impressive 11-for-36 (.306) at the plate with 8 RBI and 4 extra-base hits...Reimer recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...The Yucaipa, Calif. native is tied for 6th in the South Atlantic League in hits (11), tied for 7th in RBI (8), tied for 8th in extra-base hits (4), and 9th in total bases (16).

RAKIN' IN THE BENGE-AMINS: OF **Carson Benge** has shown a keen eye at the plate to start his first full professional season...The 19th-overall pick in the 2024 draft posted his first multi-hit game of the season on Sunday vs. Hudson Valley and has reached base safely in all 6 games with the Cyclones...Benge enters Tuesday ranked 5th in the South Atlantic League in on-base percentage (.480).

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn treks south for their first road trip of the season...The 2-week stretch begins with 6 games against the IronBirds...Aberdeen enters the series after taking 4-of-6 on the road against Jersey Shore...In 2024, Brooklyn went 11-13 against the IronBirds and 4-8 at Ripken Stadium...Aberdeen boasts 11 of the Orioles' Top 30 prospects: OF **Vance Honeycutt** (5), INF **Griff O'Ferrall** (7), RHP **Michael Forret** (8), RHP **Nestor Germán** (11), LHP **Luis De León** (14), RHP **Trey Gibson** (15), INF **Aron Estrada** (16), C **Ethan Anderson** (18), INF **Leandro Arias** (21), OF **Thomas Sosa** (23), and OF **Austin Overn** (30)...De León and Sosa are currently on the injured list...In 263 all-time meetings since 2002, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 137-126 (.521).

THE LONG HALL: RHP **Noah Hall** is off to a wonderful start to 2025...Over his first 2 starts, the 2023 draftee is 1-0 with a 0.93 ERA (1 ER in 9.2 IP), 11 strikeouts and only 4 hits allowed...The right hander tossed 4.2 innings of 1-run ball, taking a no-decision, in Thursday's loss vs. Hudson Valley...The righty punched out a career-high 8 batters, and gave up only 1 hit...All this came after Hall spun arguably his best career pro outing on Opening Day for Brooklyn...The 2023 draftee picked up the win, thanks to 5.0 innings of 1-run ball...Hall surrendered only 3 hits, and gave up just 1 run...The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the first player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

LEVITTOWN LEGEND: INF **Nick Roselli** provided the decisive base hit in Saturday's Game 2 victory over Hudson Valley...The infielder came through with the bases loaded in the 3rd, smacking a 2-run single that accounted for all of Brooklyn's scoring in a 2-1 victory...His 5 RBI are tied for 3rd on the team...Roselli grew up 34 miles northeast of Maimonides Park in Long Island's Levittown...The 11th round pick played his college ball at Binghamton University, where he was a career .349 hitter for the Bearcats...The Division High School product grew up a huge Mets fan, and was considered to have the "Best Pro Debut" of any member of the 2024 Mets draft class by *Baseball America*.

YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT...YOU GET THE POINT: In a lopsided victory over Wilmington on April 5, Brooklyn put up some gaudy numbers that haven't been seen on the boardwalk in quite some time...The 15 runs scored are the most scored in a single game by the Cyclones since Brooklyn scored 18 times in an 18-1 victory at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...The Cyclones offensive output was their best at Maimonides Park since June 24, 2010, vs. Hudson Valley, in a 16-5 win...Additionally, Brooklyn's 20 hits collected on Saturday were the most hits the 'Clones in any game since a 20-hit effort in a 13-0 triumph vs. Aberdeen on July 21, 2011...The contest was just the second game since 2005 where Brooklyn accumulated 15+ runs and 20+ hits in the same contest...The Cyclones first accomplished the feat with 16 runs and 22 hits in a 16-7 win at Tri-City on July 13, 2007.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After four former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, three alumni had already accomplished the feat before the end of March in 2025...C **Hayden Senger** ('18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF **Jake Mangum** ('19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP **Mike Vasil** debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 1B **Ty France** for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is nine in 2015 and 2017.

GOMEZ GEARED UP FOR ROUND TWO IN BK: Cyclones manager **Gilbert Gómez** embarks on his second season at the helm after serving as the youngest manager in franchise history in 2024...The 33 year old becomes the first Cyclones skipper to begin a 2nd consecutive season as manager since **Edgardo Alfonzo** (2017-2019)...Gómez led Brooklyn to a 65-67 record during his inaugural season at the controls...Gómez spent the winter as the head man for Tigers del Licey in the Dominican Winter League.

FAMILIAR FACES: 21 players on the Cyclones break camp roster had previous playing experience in Brooklyn...Notables include: INF **Boston Baro**, who played in 11 games with Brooklyn towards the end of last season...INF **Jacob Reimer**, who suited up in 39 games for the 'Clones over the last two years...RHP **Dakota Hawkins** had a hand in the first nine inning no-hitter in franchise history last year...RHP **Ben Simon** logged 22 appearances, the most amongst any returning pitcher outside of Hawkins.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: 7 members of the Mets' 2024 draft class began the 2025 campaign with the Cyclones...RHP **Ryan Lambert** was the lone '24 draftee that returned to the Brooklyn roster, while 1st-round selection OF **Carson Benge**, 2nd-round pick LHP **Jonathan Santucci** and 4th-rounder OF **Eli Serrano III** all made their High-A debuts...RHP **Brendan Girton**, RHP **R.J. Gordon** & INF **Nick Roselli** round out the class.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 8 of the Mets Top 30 prospects...Those include OF **Carson Benge** (3), INF **Jesús Báez**, LHP **Jonathan Santucci** (13), INF **Boston Baro** (14), INF **Jacob Reimer** (21), C **Chris Suero** (22), OF **Eli Serrano III** (23) and C **Ronald Hernández** (27)...Of those 8, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also posses 6 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per *Baseball America*...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Suero (20), and Reimer (21).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss in his professional debut last Wednesday afternoon vs. Hudson Valley...Allowed 2 runs on 6 hits over 4.0-plus innings...Did not issue a walk and struck out 5...Charged with a wild pitch...Surrendered a solo home run to 3B **Brenny Escanio** to lead off the top of the 5th...Threw 66 pitches and 45 strikes (68.18%)...Relieved by RHP **Ben Simon** with the bases empty and nobody out in the top of the 5th and Brooklyn trailing 2-0...The Renegades would explode for 4 more runs in the 6th and snapped the Cyclones' 4-game winning streak to start the season, 7-2.

PROSPECT RADAR: Entering the 2025 season, Santucci was ranked as the New York Mets' No. 13 prospect by MLB Pipeline and No. 16 by *Baseball America*... Deemed to have the "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2024 draft class by *Baseball America* for his slider.

SPRING BREAKOUT: Santucci was a member of the Mets' 2025 Spring Breakout roster...While still awaiting his official professional debut, the southpaw entered in relief of RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** in the bottom of the 5th inning...Santucci tossed a scoreless inning of work, facing one over the minimum, allowing one hit and one walk, and inducing a double play.

MAIDEN VOYAGE: Santucci made his professional debut last Wednesday afternoon...The 22-year-old did not pitch after signing with the Mets on 7/22/24 for \$2.03 million...Santucci was the second player to make his professional debut for the Cyclones in 2025...RHP **R.J. Gordon** made his pro debut for Brooklyn last Tuesday night, tossing 4.1 innings of 2-run ball.

DEVILISHLY GOOD: Santucci spent his three-year collegiate career at Duke University...As a junior in 2024, the 22-year-old compiled a 6-1 record with a 3.41 ERA (22 ER in 58.0 IP), 36 walks, and 90 strikeouts in 13 starts for the Blue Devils...Santucci was named to the All-ACC First Team and recognized on the Golden Spikes Award mid-season watch list...Missed three weeks during the 2024 season with a rib injury...Punched out a career-high 14 batters against Akron on 3/1...Was the second of back-to-back 10+ strikeout performances, whiffing 11 against Northwestern on 2/23...Limited to only 7 starts as a sophomore due to elbow surgery to remove bone chips...During his career at Duke, Santucci accrued a 10-6 mark with a 3.86 ERA (55 ER in 128.1 IP), 72 walks, and 198 strikeouts in 40 appearances (27 starts).

DUAL THREAT: During his high school career, Santucci was a two-way player at Phillips Academy (Andover, Mass.)...The left-hander registered a .322 batting average in high school, adding six doubles, two triples, three home runs, and 29 RBI...Santucci also received opportunities at the plate during his time at Duke...At the plate in college, the Leominster, Mass. native posted a .217 average (5-23) with two doubles, a home run, and 5 RBI in 24 plate appearances...Santucci played four games in the outfield at Duke, with three in right field and one in center field.

FAMILY TIES: Jonathan is not the only athlete in the Santucci family...Dad, **Steven**, played baseball at Assumption University (Worcester, Mass.) from 1991-93...Cousin, **Nick**, also played collegiate baseball at Rollins College (Winter Park, Fla.).
