TONIGHT'S GAME: The Quakes continue a six-game road trip tonight, as they take on the Visalia Rawhide (Arizona Diamondbacks) in game four of a six-game series at Valley Strong Ballpark. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, August 20, hosting the Lake Elsinore Storm in a six-game series.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the 22nd of 30 meetings between the two clubs in 2024 and the 13th of 15 at Valley Strong Ballpark. The Quakes are 11-10 against the Rawhide in 2024, 7-5 here in Visalia. Last season, the Quakes went 17-13 against the Rawhide, 10-8 at Valley Strong Ballpark.

LAST GAME: The Quakes bounced back from an ugly loss on Wednesday, as they held on for a 6-3 win over the Visalia Rawhide on Thursday night at Valley Strong Ballpark. Samuel Munoz (4) slugged a three-run homer in the second and Jose Meza had a two-run triple in the third, as the Quakes built a 6-0 lead against Visalia starter Adonys Perez (5-7). Rancho starter Hyun-Seok Jang was strong, allowing just one hit and two walks, while striking out seven over three scoreless innings. Noah Ruen (3-1) was credited with the win, after working 2.2 perfect relief innings. The Rawhide made a run at it in the ninth, but Felix Cabrera got the only batter he faced, popping up Demetrio Crisantes to end the game, earning his second save. The win gives the Quakes two of three in the series.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made a total of four moves in the last two days, placing RHP David Tiburcio on the Injured List and RHP Samuel Sanchez on the Development List on Wednesday. Taking their respective spots on the roster are RHP Seamus Barrett and RHP Dilan Figueredo. Barrett, drafted in the tenth round of the 2024 draft out of Loyola-Marymount University, has yet to appear in a pro game. Figueredo, who signed with the Dodgers in 2021 out of Venezuela, went 1-0 with a 1.84 ERA over 13 games and 14.2 innings of relief in the ACL this year.

CLEAN SWEEP FOR WEEKLY AWARDS: The Quakes had a great week at home, taking four of six, but they got a couple stand-out efforts and for the first time this year, swept the Player of the Week Awards. RHP Roque Gutierrez was named Cal League Pitcher of the Week, after he allowed one run on three hits over seven innings, striking out a career-high 13 Fresno hitters in a win over the Grizzlies. OF Jose Meza was named the Cal League Hitter of the Week, as he slugged four homers and drove in 11 runs in five games, batting a team-high .412 (7-for-17) in the Fresno series.

ANOTHER SERIES WIN: The Quakes are in the midst of their best stretch of the second half, having won nine of their last 12 and 14 of their last 21 games. Saturday's win over Fresno gave them their third straight series win (at Inland Empire, vs San Jose, vs Fresno) and they currently own the best second-half record in the league, now two games up in the South over the Visalia Rawhide and the Lake Elsinore Storm. In order to make the playoffs, Rancho must finish the second half ahead of both Visalia and Inland Empire (six games back).

SEAN PAUL LINAN: Right-hander Sean Linan makes his 11th appearance and his fourth start, his second start against Visalia. In his only game against the Rawhide, he allowed four runs on seven hits over 4.2 innings in a loss on July 3. In his last outing overall, he scattered five hits over seven scoreless innings in a win over Fresno on August 9. He's allowed one unearned run on eight hits over his last two starts and 12.1 innings. Linan signed with the Dodgers in 2022 out of Columbia.

CASEY ANDERSON: Right-hander Casey Anderson will make his 18th start of the year and his fourth against the Quakes. In three starts against Rancho, he's 0-2 with a 14.29 ERA, allowing 18 earned runs on 19 hits over 11.1 innings. In his last start overall, he allowed three runs (two earned) on four hits over five innings in a no-decision on August 9 at Modesto. Anderson was drafted by Arizona in the 11th round of the 2023 draft out of Utah Valley University.
