LET'S GO WITH LORENZEN

Texas Rangers rehabber RHP Michael Lorenzen is slated to get the start in game one for Round Rock to open the series with Oklahoma City. Lorenzen is preparing for his third start with the Express after he missed all of Spring Training and signed with the Rangers on March 22. The righty owns a 5.40 ERA (4 ER/6.2 IP) with four walks and seven strikeouts through his first two starts.

BRENNAN GETS THE BALL

The Express will plan to send RHP Tim Brennan to the bump for game two of the doubleheader. Brennan will be making his second start of the season, after he went 4.1 innings allowing three runs on six hits and three walks earning a no decision in an 8-4 Round Rock win over El Paso on April 2.

GOING DEEP

The Express have relied on the long ball early in the season. They are 4-1 in games where they homer compared to 1-3 when they do not. Round Rock enters Wednesday's contests tied for second in home runs in the Pacific Coast League with 13. Their lone home run on Sunday was an inside-the-park homer for OF Dustin Harris.

SOME SERIOUS SPEED

Express 3B Dustin Harris recorded an inside-thepark home run in the fifth inning on Sunday. It was the first inside-the-park home run by a Round Rock hitter since June 18, 2022, when OF Bubba Thompson rounded the bases against Sugar Land.

WENDZEL MOVES UP

Express INF Davis Wendzel was called up to the Texas Rangers on Monday and started Tuesday at third base in his debut against the Oakland Athletics. In his first nine games this year, Wendzel slashed .314/.419/.657/1.076 with three doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, 10 runs scored, four walks and four strikeouts. In 226 games over parts of the last four seasons in Round Rock, Wendzel blasted 51 home runs, which is the most in the Pacific Coast League during that span.

NOBODY IS STOPPING SANDRO

Express RF Sandro Fabian picked up three hits and collected his fifth consecutive multi-hit game on Sunday in El Paso. He has a hit in all seven games he has played in this year and is slashing 483/.500/.759 with five doubles, a home run, 11 RBI, five runs scored, one walk and three strikeouts.

DEBUT OF DE GOTI

Following the recent call-ups of INFs Justin Foscue and Davis Wendzel, INF Alex De Goti was promoted from Double-A Frisco on April 9. De Goti is a career .250 (640-2561) hitter in 721 games across eight minor league seasons. He made his Major League debut for the Houston Astros in 2021, going 2-for-6 with two runs scored, an RBI and a walk in two games.

WELCOME, WITTE

Texas signed INF Jantzen Witte and assigned him to Round Rock on April 10. Witte brings nine seasons of minor league experience, posting a lifetime average of .274 (860-3141) with 80 home runs and 471 RBI in 872 games.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the

most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.



- Was in Major League spring camp for a third time (also 2021, 2023) and is entering his fifth season in the organization (did not see official game action in 2020) since being chosen with the Rangers' top pick (15th overall) in the first round of the 2018 MLB Draft.
- Owns a career 26-23 mark and 5.39 ERA (226 ER/377.1 IP) across 96 appearances (80 starts) over his previous four minor league seasons.
- The right-hander is seeking a return to form following an uneven 2023 season at Triple-A Round Rock in which he posted a 7.22 ERA (81 ER/101.0 IP) over career-high 29 appearances (13 starts).
- Captured the organization's Nolan Ryan Minor League Pitcher of the Year award and started for the American League in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game in 2021.
- Made professional debut for High-A Hickory in 2019, going 4-4 with a 4.46 ERA (34 ER/68.2 IP) and 65 strikeouts in 18 starts.
