LAST GAME

The Baysox came from behind twice, walking off the Akron RubberDucks 6-5 on Sunday evening. After a 1 hour, 14 minute rain delay pushed back the scheduled start time, Bowie fell in an early 2-0 hole on a run-scoring wild pitch and solo home run in the first three innings against left-handed starter Cade Povich, who allowed just the two runs, striking out seven through five frames. The Baysox tied the game in the sixth on a two-out RBI single from Shayne Fontana, followed by an RBI double from Greg Cullen. Akron retook the lead in the seventh, scoring three runs off two RBI singles and an error, before Bowie bounced back with three runs of its own in the bottom half. Donta' Williams walked with the bases loaded, before Jackson Holliday grounded into a double play where another run was pushed home, before John Rhodes notched the game-tying single with two outs. That score held until the ninth, when right-hander Xavier Moore stranded the bases loaded in the top half, before Rhodes laced an infield single to plate the winning run in the bottom half to clinch the series win for Bowie.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Harrisburg Senators enter this week with an overall record of 38-45 - just one half-game ahead of Bowie overall. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, Harrisburg is 7-8 in the second half, even with Bowie and 2.5 games back of first-place Erie in the second half Southwest division standings. The Senators have the third-lowest team average (.231) and fewest home runs (61) in the Eastern League, but have committed the fewest errors (50) defensively. The Senators' roster is highlighted by seven of the Nationals' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - OF James Wood (No. 1 WSH/ No. 4 overall), OF Robert Hassell III (No. 5 WSH / No. 93 overall), RHP Cole Henry (No. 12 WSH), RHP Zach Brzykcy (No. 17 WSH), IF Trey Lipscomb (No. 18 WSH), LHP Mitchell Parker (No. 22 WSH), RHP Gerardo Carrillo (No. 26 WSH).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander Alemao Hernandez is set to get the ball for Harrisburg tonight. Hernandez has pitched to a lot of contact in Double-A, allowing 59 hits across 54 innings. However, despite opponents hitting .280 against him, he has maintained a very solid 3.33 ERA. The home run ball has been a bit of an issue at times, with seven allowed in a Senators' uniform, but the southpaw has walked only 10 batters all season with Harrisburg. Hernandez has started twice against Bowie this season, including his Double-A debut back on 5/13, when he allowed just one run - a solo home run to Noelberth Romero - across four innings, while also posting a season-high six shutout innings and six strikeouts at the end of May at Prince George's Stadium. Hernandez began the season in High-A after signing with the Nationals in March following a stint pitching professionally in Mexico. Hernandez is originally an international free agent signed by the Dodgers in 2016, pitching in the system for three seasons - through 2019.

HAPPY HOLLIDAY

Jackson Holliday has already made a splash in Double-A, going 6-for-12 with a double and a pair of walks this past weekend in his first three contests. Baseball's top prospect ranks top five in the Orioles' system with a .338 average (2nd), .471 on-base percentage (1st), .526 slugging percentage (5th), .997 OPS (2nd), six triples (1st), and 66 walks (1st). Holliday on-base percentage also leads all of Minor League Baseball, while he sits with the third-most walks. He is the second No. 1 overall prospect to don a Baysox uniform in quick succession, as Adley Rutschman (2021-22) also topped the prospect rankings during his time in Bowie. Holliday is also the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday. He is the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

STRUGGLING WITH THE SENS

The Baysox have outlived the Senators in 10 of the 12 contests between the teams this season, and by a 108-90 total. However, Bowie has won just three games against Harrisburg in 2023. In total this season, the Baysox are 30-18 in games where they outlive their opponent.

ALL RHODES LEAD TO HOME

John Rhodes had a sensational weekend at the plate for Bowie. The No. 19 Orioles' prospect, per MLB Pipeline, went 5-for-14 with five RBI. Rhodes' weekend included a three home-run contest on Friday - the first multi-home run game of his career and just the seventh three home run game in Baysox franchise history, along with a game-tying and walk-off RBI single on Sunday. Rhodes currently ranks second among active Baysox in RBI (38), first in on-base percentage (.342), second in slugging (.442), and second in OPS (.784) among qualifiers.

LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook has enjoyed a breakout at the Double-A level in the summer months. Cook has hit .317 since the calendar flipped to June - third-highest average in the Eastern League among players with at least 100 at-bats. Cook's 17 extra-base hits in that stretch (nine doubles, six home runs) are also fifth-most in the league, while his 12 stolen bases in as many attempts are second-most. Following last night, Cook currently has five extra-base hits and 13 RBI in his last seven games, including home runs in three-straight and a leadoff homer in each of the last two games. Cook currently leads active Baysox hitters in home runs (11), RBI (46), and stolen bases (17).

- Named South Atlantic League pitcher of the Week on May 15, after twirling six shutout innings with eight strikeouts against Hudson Valley. Part of a month where he pitched to a 1.64 ERA and held opponents to a .116 average.
- Spent all three seasons in Aberdeen, but due to the reclassification of minor league baseball, advanced to High-A from Single-A short season in between 2019 and 2021.
- Spent three seasons starting games for VCU. Was first-team all-conference as a senior, posting a 2.50 ERA through 20 starts and 86.1 innings. His 118 strikeouts in 2019 are fourth-most in program history.

He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen Iron-Birds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series.
