HISTORIC HITTING: This season, Coby Morales (81 RBI) and DJ Gladney (85 RBI) became the only two Patriots in the affiliated era to surpass 80 RBI. They both eclipsed the previous mark of 78 RBI in a single season, held by Oswaldo Cabrera (2021) and Spencer Jones (2024). Morales' 132 hits this season surpassed the previous Somerset single-season franchise record of 125 held by Spencer Jones (2024), while his 85 R outfield Jasson Dominguez (83 R - 2023) for the single-season franchise record. Morales ends the season having played in a new franchise record 130 games for the Patriots.

BE LIKE MIKE: On the final day of the regular season, Michael Arias will become the 20th different pitcher this season to start a game for the Somerset Patriots. This total includes three MLB rehabbers and three primary relievers who were used as openers. Over Arias' last eight appearances, he's tallied a 0.73 ERA, 0.97 WHIP and .190 BAA with 11 K to 4 BB in 12.1 IP.

ONE HIT STORY: On Thursday night, Rory Fox, Tony Rossi and Chris Veach combined on the eighth nine-inning no-hitter in Somerset franchise history (12th total) and the first since 4/15/25 @ALT. The shutout win was Somerset's seventh this season and first since Game 2 on 8/21 @HFD. It was Somerset's first nine-inning shutout win since 6/10 vs. BNG. Rory Fox's 7.2 IP were the most in a game by a Patriots starter since Bailey Dees worked 7.2 IP on 5/30/24 vs. BOW. Fox joined former Patriots starter Trystan Vrieling as the only two pitchers in Somerset Double-A history to toss 7+ innings with one or fewer hit allowed. Across his final three outings, Fox posted a 1.89 ERA, 0.89 WHIP and .172 BAA with 17 K to 6 BB in 19.0 IP.

CLUB 20: Four members of the 2026 Somerset Patriots have reached 20 home runs this season: DJ Gladney (23), Garrett Martin (21), Coby Morales (21) and Jace Avina (21). Somerset entered 2026 with four total individual 20 HR seasons in Double-A franchise history and no more than two in one year (2021: Dermis Garcia and Oswaldo Cabrera).

BRIDGEWATER BOMBERS: The Somerset Patriots enter the final day of the regular season with 190 home runs, ranking 2nd in Double-A and T-10th in MiLB. In 2026, the Patriots set a Double-A franchise record with 57 multi-home run games, going 41-16 in those games. Patriots batters have amassed 17 individual multi-home run games, accompanied by 13 different batters. Somerset has had 16 multi-home run innings in 2026. Core Jackson's grand slam on Saturday 9/12 made it so that in September, the Patriots are now 7-0 in games when they've homered vs. 0-4 in games without a home run.

IN GRAND FASHION: Core Jackson's grand slam on Saturday extended Somerset's single-season franchise record of grand slams to 11 on the year, breaking the previous record of nine (2023). The outburst comes one year after the Patriots hit zero grand slams in 2025. Josh Moylan and Connor McGinnis are the only Patriots to hit two grand slams this season. Somerset's 11 grand slams are tied with the Nashville Sounds (Brewers Triple-A) for the most in MiLB this year.

PINSTRIPE PEDIGREE: The Somerset Patriots have secured their sixth straight winning season since becoming the Yankees' Double-A affiliate in 2021, as well as the best overall record in the Eastern League's Northeast division for the fourth time in six years (2021-23). Somerset's 74 wins entering today are the 4th-most they've had in a single season as the Yankees' Double-A affiliate, one shy of their 75 wins in 2024, which would tie for the third-most in franchise history. Over the six seasons, Somerset (460-343) leads all Double-A clubs in wins, while ranking 6th in MiLB. The Patriots pitching staff's 3.85 ERA in the affiliated era of the franchise is the tied for 3rd in MiLB over the six years, while their 1,044 HR lead all Double-A teams.

SOMETHING IN THE [BRIDGEWATER]: There have been 15 different Patriots batters this year that set or tied their career-high in home runs. Last Saturday, Connor McGinnis clubbed his 10th Double-A homer, becoming the ninth Patriot to hit 10+ home runs for Somerset this season. Nine batters with double-digit home runs this season are the most the Patriots had 10 batters with double-digit homers in 2023.

STORYBOOK ENDING: Saturday's 11-6 win for the Patriots featured two separate innings in which they batted around, by sending nine batters to the plate. The occurrence marked the second time this season that the Patriots have sent nine batters to the plate twice in the same game, with the other occurrence taking place on Opening Day, 4/3 vs. POR. The Somerset Patriots have batted around 31 times in 2026.

HOME RUN KING: Josh Moylan clubbed his career-high 29th HR of the season on Thursday. With eight HR in his last 20 games and 12 HR in his last 37 games, Moylan's 29 HR in 121 games this season lead all NYY minor leaguers and surpass his 17 career HR in his first 239 career games from 2023-25. Moylan's 8 HR since August 21 are T-2nd in MiLB, trailing only Andrew Fischer (BLX). During a season-best 10-game on-base streak, Moylan is 12-for-30 (.400/.455/.867) with 4 HR, 13 RBI and 6 XBH.

AREN'T YOU GLADNEY: On Thursday, DJ Gladney recorded his ninth three-hit game and 30th multi-hit game this season, joining Coby Morales as the only two Patriots with 30+ multi-hit games. With Gladney's stolen base in the second inning, he picked up his 20th SB of the season, before swiping second base in the fourth inning for his 21st SB of the year. With 23 HR and 21 SB, Gladney joins Coby Morales as the second Patriot this season to record 20 homers and 20 stolen bases and third Patriot all-time to record a 20/20 season with Somerset (Oswaldo Cabrera - 2023 - 24 HR, 20 SB).

CORE SPEED: On Friday, Core Jackson picked up his 41st SB across all levels, tying Jackson Lovich for the fifth-most among Yankees minor leaguers. Jackson is one of 26 minor leaguers with 13+ HR and 40+ SB across all levels this season.

MCGINNIS BUSINESS: Connor McGinnis led the way for Somerset on Saturday with a four-hit, four-RBI night, marking his fourth 3+ hit game of the season and his 14th total multi-hit game of the season. McGinnis is the only Patriot with multiple four-hit games this season. He joins Ben Rice, Agustin Ramirez, Oswaldo Peraza, Spencer Jones, Tyler Hardman, Jasson Dominguez and Chad Bell as the ninth batter to record multiple four hit games with Somerset in Double-A franchise history. McGinnis improved his slash line to .368/.478/.500 with a HR, 8 RBI and 3 XBH in 14 games against the Yard Goats this season.

BULLPEN BUSINESS: Over Tony Rossi's last 19 games, he has a 1.82 ERA, 5-0 record, 0.81 WHIP and .153 BAA with 29 K to 7 BB in 24.2 IP. Over Chris Veach's last nine outings with Somerset, he's posted a 0.87 ERA, 1-0 record, 0.87 WHIP and .143 BAA with 3 SV in 10.1 IP. Since 6/7, Kelly Austin has a 2.65 ERA, 0.94 WHIP and .157 BAA with 36 K to 13 BB in 34.0 IP across 25 games.

2026 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

JAMES COOPER: Manager (1st year)

James Cooper enters his first season as manager of the Somerset Patriots, his fifth overall year in the Yankees organization and his fourth consecutive as a minor league manager. He spent the 2025 season as the manager of the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades, after serving as manager of the Single-A Tampa Tarpons in 2024 and beginning his minor league managerial career with the FCL Yankees in 2023. Under Cooper's leadership in 2025, Hudson Valley finished with a franchise-record 79 wins (79-50), being eliminated from playoff contention on the final day of the regular season. During the season, the Renegades finished second in AVG (.235), H (970), OBP (.336), SLG (.363), OPS (.699), third in R (598) and HR (547). In 2024 at the helm for Tampa, the Tarpons led the FSL in SB, while ranking second in AVG, H and 2B, and fourth in OPS. During Cooper's first assignment with the Yankees organization in 2022, he served as defensive coach for the FCL Yankees, where he helped the team with the 2022 FCL Championship. The following season, Cooper made his managerial debut with the FCL Yankees and was named the Florida Complex League Manager of the Year in 2023, when his team led the FCL in runs, hits, triples, RBIs, AVG, OBP, SLG and OPS.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (2nd year)

Mike Fransoso enters his second season as a coach in Somerset and within the Yankees organization. Under Fransoso's leadership during the 2025 season, the Patriots' offense ranked among the Eastern League leaders with 129 HR (2nd), a .691 OPS (4th) and 600 R (5th). Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots (2018-2019) during the team's run as an independent team and also the Pittsburgh Pirates organization (2013-2015). He previously coached in the Seattle Mariners organization (2021-2024), serving as the hitting coach and interim manager for the Double-A Arkansas Travelers in 2024, when he helped manage the team to a Southern League Championship.

DEMETRE KOKORIS: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Demetre Kokoris enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees. He served as the pitching coach in Hudson Valley in 2025 and guided the team to a league-best 2.82 ERA and 20 shutouts. Prior to joining the Yankees, Kokoris coached in the Texas Rangers (2022-2024) and Toronto Blue Jays (2019-2021) organizations. He spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons as the bullpen coach for the Triple-A Round Rock Express, and was the pitching coach for the Single-A Down East Wood Ducks in 2022. Prior to joining the Rangers, he was the pitching coach for the Short-Season Class-A Vancouver Canadians (2019-20) and was a rehab pitching coach (2021) with the Blue Jays. Before entering the professional coaching ranks, Kokoris was a college pitching coach at Chemeketa Community College, Point Loma Nazarene University, and Santa Barbara City College. He has also served as the pitching coach for the Greek National Team since 2021.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (2nd year)

Uziel Viloria enters his second consecutive season as a defensive coach in Somerset and his second season with the Yankees organization. Under his leadership in 2025, the Patriots posted a franchise record .983 fielding percentage. Viloria began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), reaching High-A Jersey Shore in 2022 and 2023.

CALEB HAMILTON: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Caleb Hamilton enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees organization. After a playing career that included MLB experience with the Minnesota Twins (2022) and Boston Red Sox (2023), Hamilton completed his first year in coaching as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley in 2025. During his final season playing in 2024, Hamilton saw time in 39 games for the Rocket City Trash Pandas, the Double-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. He was drafted by Minnesota in the 23rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Oregon State University, where he was an All-Pac-12 performer for the Beavers. Despite not catching in college, Hamilton made 323 of his 574 professional appearances as a catcher, and he played at least one game at all nine positions.
