The Nuts are 8-11 against West Michigan this season, 3-4 at LMCU Ballpark, with all 24 of the scheduled matchups taking place in the second half. The Nuts have lost their last four games, including dropping the series opener in extra innings last night.

Last Game: West Michigan Whitecaps 5, Lansing Lugnuts 4 (11 innings). Lansing southpaw Will Johnston fired six strong innings, setting a new career high, and Jonny Butler homered, but the Whitecaps erased a 4-1 lead with three runs in the bottom of the ninth and won the game on a Luke Gold RBI single in the 11th inning.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Whitecaps through Sunday, closing out their 28th season in the Midwest League. Lansing's next home game arrives April 1 in the 2025 Crosstown Showdown vs. Michigan State, followed by Midwest League Opening Day vs. Great Lakes.

Streaking: 1B Danny Bautista, Jr. enters today on a nine-game hitting streak; only Euribiel Ángeles has put together a double-digit hitting streak for the Lugnuts this season with separate 12- and 10-game streaks (with Nate Nankil's nine-game hitting streak ending yesterday).

A's Dominate Weekly Honors: Lugnuts lefty Will Johnston was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week for August 26-September 1, blanking Fort Wayne over five two-hit innings with eight strikeouts (on 58 pitches, 45 strikes) in Game 2 of a doubleheader win last Wednesday. Additionally, former Lugnut David Leal was named the Texas League Pitcher of the Week, picking up a pair of wins with 6 1/3 combined hitless innings for Midland, Las Vegas infielder Logan Davidson was named the Pacific Coast League's Player of the Week after slashing .524/.524/1.000 with two doubles, one triple, two homers and 10 RBIs on 10 hits, hitting for the cycle on August 30, and former Lugnut Lawrence Butler was named American League Player of the Week, going 14-for-28 with six home runs, his second time winning the weekly award. Butler homered on the first pitch of the bottom of the 1st inning yesterday, his 21st HR of the year.

Alumni Watch: 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. ranks 2nd in the Major Leagues in batting average (.328) and base hits (174); 3rd in on-base percentage (.401), 4th in doubles (39), 5th in extra-base hits (68) and total bases (299); 6th in OPS (.965), and 8th in slugging percentage (.564).

Challenging the Hit Man: In 2017, Lugnuts outfielder Nick Sinay was hit by 38 pitches (in 79 games) to set the Midwest League single season record. That record has been tied this season by Wisconsin infielder Luke Adams (in 98 games), who needs to get bruised once more in the final six games of 2024 to have the record all to himself.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: In front of a Fan Appreciation Day crowd of 9,972 in the home finale, the Lugnuts scored three runs in the bottom of the 8th on a Balbino Fuenmayor RBI double and an A.J. Jimenez two-run double to beat West Michigan, 4-3. Jimenez's double was the Lugnuts' only hit with runners in scoring position; they finished 1-for-14.

2016: Juan Kelly's on-base streak ended at 34 games in an 0-for-4 night, as the Lugnuts lost 3-0 at Lake County. Jake Henson's RBI single in the bottom of the 9th earlier in the day had given the Great Lakes Loons a 1-0 win over West Michigan, eliminating the Lugnuts from playoff contention. T.J. Zeuch suffered the loss, striking out seven batters in five innings while allowing three hits and three runs..

2022: Jorge Juan (4 IP) combined with Jack Owen (2 1/3), Shohei Tomioka (2/3) and Osvaldo Berrios (2 IP) to complete the third no-hitter in franchise history, 2-1 at South Bend. Lawrence Butler's home run in the first and Max Muncy's RBI double in the eighth supplied the Nuts' runs; the Cubs drew seven walks and scored their only run on a Berrios throwing error in the eighth.

History: On June 13, relieved Jake Garland beginning in the 6th inning and tossed 2 2/3 hitless innings, walking one and striking out three, as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since 2003.

Family of Athletes: Father, Rob, played college baseball at Central College of Iowa, located in his hometown of Pella, as did both of his brothers, Jordan and Blake; his mother, Shannon, played golf in college.

At Pella High School: 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the Big Ten ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player in 2017, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

International Stage: With Iowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.


Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands thus all root for Boston-area teams.

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Path to Lansing: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings... opened 2023 pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win.
