THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On May 13, 1993, Drew Denson became the first Sound to record 7 RBI in a game. Since then, seven other Sounds hitters have finished with 7 RBI, including Keston Hiura last night.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp play game four of a six-game series tonight. The Sounds ran away with a 10-1 victory in last night's game. Right-hander Dylan File starts for Nashville. Right-hander Edward Cabrera will start for Jacksonville.

Dylan File: 25-year-old Dylan File makes his seventh appearance and sixth start of the year. The right-hander from Lake Havasu, Ariz. native is 2-0 with a 3.95 ERA (27.1 IP/12 ER). File did not allow a run in his last outing on May 7, pitching 5.0 innings in the no decision. Norfolk managed three hits and two walks against File. He struck out three and threw 90 pitches (58 strikes). A current Phoenix resident, File went 2-4 with a 5.27 ERA (42.2 IP/25 ER) in nine starts with Nashville last season. He also made two starts with High-A Wisconsin (0-1, 7.20 ERA) and pitched 2.2 innings with the ACL Brewers. File underwent surgery on February 4, 2021, to repair a stress fracture in his right elbow. MLB Pipeline rated File as the No. 25 prospect in the Brewers system to start the season, and *Baseball America* placed him at No. 28 in the same category. File was selected by Milwaukee in the 21st round of the 2017 MLB First Year Player Draft out of Dixie State University in St. George, Utah.

Bryan Hoeing: 25-year-old Bryan Hoeing starts for Jacksonville tonight. The right-hander is 1-0 with a 5.14 ERA (7.0 IP/4 ER) in one previous start for the Jumbo Shrimp in 2022. Hoeing also made four starts for Double-A Pensacola, going 2-1 with a 0.35 ERA (25.2 IP/1 ER) in four starts. The Batesville, Ind. native picked up the win in his Triple-A debut on May 7. He pitched 7.0 innings, allowing four hits and four runs (all earned). Hoeing walked three batters and struck out seven at Memphis. In 2021, Hoeing went 7-6 with a 4.83 ERA (121.0 IP/65 ER) in 22 starts for High-A Beloit. He was honored as the High-A Central Pitcher of the Month in August of last season. Currently, Hoeing is rated as the No. 30 prospect in the Marlins system by MLB Pipeline. He was selected by the Marlins in the seventh round of the 2019 MLB First Year Player Draft out of the University of Louisville.

2022 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2022: First: 18, Second: 11, Third: 3, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

Have a Night Hiura: Second baseman Keston Hiura had a career game at the plate last night, going 3-for-4 with two homers and seven RBI. His seven RBI is a professional career high and is the ninth Sound to have 7+ RBI in a game. It was Hiura's sixth multi-homer game at the Triple-A level and his third for Nashville.

Mashing Mathias: Third baseman Mark Mathias had a season high three hits in last night's win. His nine multi-hit games are tied for the most on the team (with Brice Turang).

Strikeout Small: Ethan Small struck out a season-high nine batters over 5.0 innings for his third win of the year. His 46 strikeouts are tied for the most in Triple-A with Memphis' Matthew Liberatore and Norfolk's Grayson Rodriguez. Also, his 1.95 ERA is tied for second best in Triple-A.

Friday the 13th: The Sounds are just 2-8 in their last 10 games on Friday the 13th. Last season, Dylan File took a 10-0 loss at Louisville on August 13. Nashville's last win on Friday the 13th was on July 13, 2018, taking an 8-3 win in game one of a doubleheader at Iowa.

It's Sweet Climbing the Ranks: Nashville Manager Rick Sweet recorded career win number 2,123 last night and is now in eighth on the all-time minor league managerial win list. He is five wins away from matching Larry Gilbert for seventh all-time.

Five Straight Series Wins: The Sounds have won every series they have played this year. It's the first time since at least 1987 the team has won its first five series in a season (team records date back to 1988).

Earn It: Nashville's team ERA sits at 2.75 (281.0 IP/86 ER) after yesterday's 10-1 win. The 2.75 ERA is the best in Triple-A and the third best in Minor League Baseball.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.
