Last Game: The Delmarva Shorebirds ended last week with a fifth straight loss to the Fredericksburg Nationals. The Fred Nats jumped out to a 4-0 lead in the second inning, using five hits to score four runs. The Shorebirds' offense struggled against Fredericksburg starter **Carson Fischer**, who threw six shutout innings, struck out seven, and allowed only two hits. A home run by **Jacob Walsh** and an RBI fielder's choice put the Fred Nats on top 6-0 after six. Delmarva attempted to rally in the final two innings, with **Jose Perez** making it a 6-2 game with a two-run triple in the eighth. In the ninth, the Shorebirds loaded the bases and brought the tying run to the plate with two outs, but **Raylin Ramos** lined out to first to end the game, giving Fredericksburg a 6-2 victory.

Can't Stop Nolaya: **Andres Nolaya** has emerged as one of Delmarva's top bats this season and is enjoying his best stretch. Since May 9, Nolaya has the best batting average in the Carolina League at .382 (21-for-55). During this run, he has 13 RBIs, 5 extra-base hits, and 6 multi-hit games, four of which came in a row. His 11 multi-hit games for the season are the most on the Shorebirds, and his .298 batting average for the season is the tenth-best mark in the Carolina League among qualified hitters.

Hitaker: **Braylon Whitaker** has become one of Delmarva's most consistent hitters. He is second on the team in batting average (.270) and third in hits (34). Among qualified Shorebirds hitters, he has the team's lowest strikeout rate at 14% and the best walk rate at 19%, and he is second on the team with 31 walks. Since becoming Delmarva's primary leadoff hitter on May 6, Whitaker has 14 hits and 19 walks, for a team-best on-base percentage of .442 in that span, which is the sixth-best mark in the league.

Play the Hits, DJ: In his first season in Delmarva, **DJ Layton** has established himself as one of the premier bats in the batting order. Layton leads the team with 39 hits and is batting .404 on balls in play. He is also the team leader in extra-base hits (14), walks (36), and runs scored (29). His stellar play has landed him on Baseball America's Top-30 prospect list for the Orioles, with Layton ranked No. 25.

Triples Galore: Despite being at the bottom of the league in home runs, the Shorebirds lead the league with 24 triples. **Jose Perez** & **Juan Ortega** leads the team with four triples, tied for the second-most in the league.

C-Rod's Dominance: In his debut season, **Christian Rodriguez** has emerged as Delmarva's most dependable starting pitcher. Over his last seven starts, he has struck out 45 batters in 36 innings, including a career-high nine on May 26 against Fredericksburg. C-Rod's 56 strikeouts this season rank third in the Carolina League.

Two Out Hitting: The Shorebirds are second in the Carolina League in hits (134) and are third in batting average (.243) with two outs. Additionally, with runners in scoring position and two outs, Delmarva has the most hits (70) and the highest batting average (.303).

Andres Nolaya has been the Shorebirds' best hitter in two-out situations, batting .341 with 14 RBI and 6 extra-base hits.

About the GreenJackets: For the first time since 2022, the Delmarva Shorebirds will play the Augusta GreenJackets at SRP Park in North Augusta. The GreenJackets' offense is one of the most talented units in the league, featuring four Top-30 prospects for the Atlanta Braves, including last year's first-round pick, **Tate Southisene**. SRP Park has been a hitter's haven this season, as 58 homers have left the park, the most of any stadium in the league.
