SEASON FINALE: The Sounds will play their final game of the 2026 season Sunday evening at First Horizon Park looking to avoid a season-long five-game slide to end the year. The Sounds enter the final game of the year with a record of 46-27 at First Horizon Park and tied with Syracuse for the most home wins in Triple-A this year. Syracuse is on a five-game winning streak to move into a tie with the Sounds after dropping four straight to Memphis this week. Nashville has finished a season with the most home wins in Triple-A just twice over the last 20 seasons. The 2022 Sounds led Triple-A with a record of 48-27 and also ended the 2007 season with 48 wins to lead all clubs. The Sounds ended the 2014 season tied with Rochester after both clubs finished the year with 45 home wins.

WHO'S GOING TO MEMPHIS: The Redbirds enter the final regular season game of the year still awaiting their opponent in the International League Championship Series. Rochester earned a win on Saturday night and currently own a 0.5 game lead over the red hot Syracuse Mets after Syracuse took down Lehigh Valley for their fifth straight win in the final week of the season. Indianapolis dropped their second straight in Gwinnett on Saturday night and sit 1.0 GB Rochester entering play on Sunday. Rochester has a 11:05 a.m CT first pitch scheduled on Sunday in Buffalo and will be the first of the three to get underway with Syracuse and Indianapolis both scheduled to get started at 12:05 p.m. CT. The Sounds and Memphis have the latest first pitch of all 30 Triple-A clubs on the final day of the regular season with Memphis knowing who they will play for the IL crown well ahead of the time they get underway in Nashville.

ENDS AT SEVEN: With Saturday night's loss, the Sounds fell to 36-37 in the second half of the season, ending a bid to join Oklahoma City as the only other team to finish all eight halves with a winning record since Triple-A moved to the split-season format ahead of the 2023 season. The Dodgers top farm club cruised have cruised to a 47-27 record in the second half of the year with a +114 run differential in the second half. The next closest Pacific Coast League team is Round Rock who own a +64 run differential entering the final game of the year. **Over the last four years, the Sounds have the second-most wins in all Triple-A over the span, entering Sunday sitting at 180-113 overall.** Only Tacoma has more wins than Nashville since the start of the 2023 season with a record of 181-25. Nashville could match the Rainiers with a win on Sunday over Memphis and a loss from Tacoma in Round Rock.

AWARD SZN: Prior to last night's game, the Sounds honored the 2026 Sounds Player Awards winners with a pre-game celebration. **INF Ethan Murray was named the 2026 Nashville Sounds MVP** by his teammates while **RHP Blake Holub was named the club's Pitcher of the Year.** **INF Brock Wilken was voted as the Fan Favorite** and **RHP Garrett Stallings was named Community Player of the Year.**

OVER THE RIDGE: Brandon Lockridge clubbed his second homer with Nashville in 24 games played this season. His first-inning two-run blast was his lone hit of the night, finishing Saturday 1-for-3 with two RBI, and a run scored. It ended a streak of 29 straight games overall without a home run including 10 games for the Brewers since his last home run on July 29 vs. Charlotte. Lockridge now sits at 49 career minor league home runs over his professional career. Saturday night was his first multi-RBI game since September 3 vs. Louisville and third overall in his 24 games with Nashville.

LAS IS MORE: Jonathan Ornelas tallied his second consecutive multi-hit game, finishing Saturday night 2-for-4 with a double, RBI, and run scored. It's the seventh time Ornelas has collected two or more hits in at least two straight games this year. He collected his first double with the Sounds Saturday and it was the 16th overall this season between Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, Las Vegas and Nashville, which is the fifth-most in a season of his professional career.

YOU AND THE 6: Eduardo Garcia extended his hit and on-base streak to six consecutive games, going 1-for-3 on Saturday night. His six-game hitting streak is the longest of his 2026 season after posting a five-game streak earlier this season with Double-A Biloxi. Over his last six games since September 11, he is hitting .316 (6-for-19) with a home run and two RBI. Over the final month of the regular season, Garcia leads the club in OBP (.340) and is T-1st in HR (2). He ranks 2nd in SLG (.405) and OPS (.745) and currently sits 4th in AVG (.262) and hits (11).
