CARDINALS RIDE HIT PARADE TO WIN IN SERIES FINALE: The Cardinals collected a season-high 15 hits and scored seven unanswered runs to finish the game as Springfield defeated the Midland RockHounds 12-6 in the series finale on Sunday afternoon at Hammons Field. Matt Lloyd had 3 hits and came a triple shy of the cycle, and was one of three Cardinals to drive in 3 runs, joining Nathan Church and Luis Rodriguez. Seven different Cardinals had multi-hit efforts, led by Lloyd's three hits. Springfield has won back-to-back games after snapping a six-game skid.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Kendall Williams** makes his 8th start of the season in the series opener for the Drillers...Last pitched on Wednesday, May 15 against the Wichita at ONEOK Field and surrendered 6 ER on 6 H with 3 BB and one strikeout in 3.1 IP...In 3 starts in May is 0-3 with a 12.71 ERA... Started against the Cardinals on May 3 at ONEOK Field and took the loss allowing 6 R (3 ER) on 7 H in just 3.0 IP...Best start of the season came the start before when he allowed just one unearned run on 4 H over 5.0 IP on April 26 against NW Arkansas...Spent the 2023 season between 4 levels (all but Low-A) and went 4-7 with a 3.73 ERA over 17 appearances (16 starts)...Spent the 2022 season between Low-A Rancho Cucamonga and High-A Great Lakes going a combined 3-6 with a 4.32 ERA in 27 appearances (24 starts)...Acquired by the Dodgers in September 2020 from the Blue Jays in exchange for RHP Ross Stripling...Selected by the Blue Jays in the 2nd round (52nd overall) of the 2019 draft out of IMG Academy in Florida...23 years old

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

FRANCHISE-RECORD TYING SKID HALTED: Noah Mendlinger's walk-off single in the bottom of the 9th inning on Saturday night brought the Cardinals' 8-game losing streak at Hammons Field to an end with a 3-2 win over Midland, ensuring the Cardinals would not set the new franchise record for longest home losing streak. The Cards' skid matched the franchise-record 8-game losing streak from May 23-June 6, 2013.

SUNDAY OUTBURST LIFTS CARDS TO TOP OF PACK: Following their 15-hit attack in Sunday's 12-6 win over Midland, the Cardinals reclaimed the top spot for batting average in all of Double-A with a mark of .268. The Cards are also tied with the Wichita Wind Surge for the top OBP in Double-A (.355), and are 2nd in hits, runs and RBIs, trailing the Midland RockHounds in each category.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cards have struck out just 279 times in 38 games, the 3rd-fewest in all of full-season Minor League Baseball. In the Texas League, Springfield trails the Frisco RoughRiders (269 K's in 38 games, fewest in the Minor Leagues) for 2nd-fewest in the circuit. The Birds are averaging just 7.3 K's per game.

CARDS PLAGUED BY BIG INNINGS: So far in 2024, the Cardinals have had a hard time limiting the big inning. Springfield has surrendered 31 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 31 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 119 of the 213 total runs scored by the opposition. In summation, the Cards have allowed 55.9% of the runs scored against them in 2024 in just 9.4% of their innings pitched. In the other 296.2 IP Springfield has allowed 91 runs, which comes out to 2.76 runs per 9 innings.

HE GETS ON BASE: With his 3-for-4 performance on Sunday afternoon, **Matt Lloyd** extended his on-base streak to 17 straight games, third longest for the Cardinals this season and the fifth-longest active streak currently in the Texas League. **Bryan Torres** had a 23-game streak from April 5-May 9 and **Jeremy Rivas** had a 20-gamer from April 14-May 12. **Lloyd** has walked a team-high 22 times and is tied for the team lead with 6 HR. He finished a triple shy of the cycle in the series finale against Midland on Sunday.

WELCOME BACK TO SPRINGY: Since returning to Springfield on April 25 after beginning the season with Triple-A Memphis, Cardinals OF **Mike Antico** has picked up where he left off in 2023. In 15 games in the month of May since returning to the Springfield regular lineup, **Antico** is batting a team-high .368 (21-for-57) with 2 2B, a triple, 2 HR and 11 RBIs, most on the club during that time. He has hit safely in 8 straight games. Among qualified hitters in the Texas League, **Antico** is 2nd in the Texas League in hitting in May trailing only **Gavin Cross** of the Northwest Arkansas Naturals.

The former Texas Longhorn led the Cardinals in hits (126) and stolen bases (52) last season.

TABLE SETTERS: The hitters that occupy the top two spots in the Cardinal lineup on the most regular basis, **Bryan Torres** and **Nathan Church**, have been the fuel to Springfield's league-leading offense. Combined, **Torres** and **Church** are batting .309 (84-for-271) with 45 R, 14 2B, 24 SB, 4 CS and have struck out a combined 37 times compared to 30 walks.

Springfield leadoff hitters are batting .291 which is good for 3rd in the Texas League, and .300 out of the 2-hole, the top mark in the circuit. Combined, the Cardinals batting .296 between the two spots in the lineup, the top mark in the circuit.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 17 straight games wihtout a home run.




