Sacramento River Cats (29-20) at Reno Aces (24-27)

SPACED OUT: The River Cats lost Sunday's series finale vs. the Space Cowboys, 3-12, settling for a 4-2 win on the series...they allowed seven runs in the seventh inning, marking a new single-frame season high...John Michael Bertrand was the starter and was dealt his first loss of the season... allowed five runs (4 earned) on seven hits, with one walk and a Triple-A career-high-tying six strikeouts...picked off Riley Unroe at first, the second pickoff of his Triple-A career (also, September 27, 2025)...Turner Hill went 2-for-3, with an RBI double...was his 11th multi-hit game...he is batting .381 (16-for-42) with five doubles, one triple, 10 RBI, 13 walks, five stolen bases, a .507 on-base percentage and a 1.016 OPS in 20 games at home this season between Richmond and Sacramento.

- ▶ Buddy Kennedy (1-for-3) knocked his team-leading seventh home run of the season, a 373-foot, solo shot to left field...was his second time homering in back-to-back games (also, May 7-8 vs. Reno)...he is the only River Cat to do so this season.
- ▶ The Kitties were the final Triple-A team to hit 20 losses, and today they look to become the first PCL team to record 30 wins.

IT'S NOT ROCKET SCIENCE: The Sacramento River Cats won Saturday's game, 6-0, clinching the series victory, their fourth of the season and third at home...Spencer Bivens was the starter but did not factor into the decision...threw 4.1 scoreless innings, allowing three hits with two walks and three strikeouts...was his second scoreless start of the year (also, May 12 at Round Rock)...Buddy Kennedy (2-for-3) knocked his team-leading sixth home run of the season, 365-foot, solo shot to left field...also knocked a double in the third, marking his fourth multi-extra-base-hit game of the season...was his team-leading 17th multi-hit game.

- ▶ Marked their fourth shutout victory of the year...was the Cats' third shutout victory over the Space Cowboys in franchise history (also, June 8, 2025 and April 7, 2022).

HEY THAT KID'S PRETTY GOOD: Drew Cavanaugh went 3-for-4 with two doubles, his third multi-extra-base-hit game of the season and second with Sacramento...also was his third three-hit game of the season and second with Sacramento...he is batting .400 (12-for-30) with six doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, three walks, one stolen base, an .800 slugging percentage and a 1.272 OPS in eight games with the River Cats this season...threw out Tommy Sacco Jr. attempting to swipe second, his fourth catcher-caught-stealing of the season and first with the River Cats.

BUDDY SYSTEM: Infielder Buddy Kennedy has been phenomenal in his debut with the River Cats this season...has the second-highest batting average among current River Cats players (min. 10 games) at .331, behind Turner Hill (.337), and he is also ranked seventh in the PCL in batting average among qualified players...he leads the team and is T-9th in the Pacific Coast League in doubles (13)...leads the team in home runs (7) and total hits (54)...is tied with Osleivis Basabe for team-lead in RBI (30)...he leads the team in OBP (.429), SLG (.552) and OPS (.981).

- ▶ His 17 extra-base-hits since April 19 are T-3rd most in the PCL and T-7th most in Triple-A...since that date, he is batting .343 (37-for-108) with nine doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 22 RBI, 17 walks, a .639 slugging percentage and a 1.089 OPS in 28 games.

ACE UP OUR SLEEVES: Southpaw Carson Whisenhunt is set to take the mound today for the series opener against the Reno Aces...last pitched on May 20 vs. SUG where he earned his fourth win of the season and second consecutive in Sacramento's 13-1 victory...threw 6.0 scoreless, quality innings, allowing four hits, two walks and fanning three batters...through 10 appearances this season (9 starts), Carson has posted a 3.35 ERA (48.1 8 ER) with 21 walks, 49 strikeouts and a .229 opponent batting average.

- ▶ Leads the PCL in ERA and opponent batting average...ranks third in strikeouts and fourth in WHIP (1.28).
- ▶ In 2025, Whisenhunt started 21 games for Sac...posted a 4.43 ERA (107.2 IP, 53 ER) with 35 walks, 95 strikeouts and a .273 opponent batting average...also made his MLB debut in 2025...started five games for the Giants; had a 5.01 ERA (23.1 IP, 13 ER) with 12 walks, 16 strikeouts and a .267 opponent batting average.

BOYS IN THE BIGS: Outfielder Victor Bericoto had his contract selected by San Francisco and made his major league debut on May 22...six total Cats batters are currently playing on the major league roster, here is a look at their stats so far this season:

LAST GAME: Carson last pitched on May 20 vs. Sugar Land where he earned his fourth win of the season and second consecutive in Sacramento's 13-1 victory...threw 6.0 scoreless, quality innings, allowing four hits, two walks and fanning three batters...marked his third quality start.

ON THE HUNT (FOR MORE Ks): His 49 total strikeouts are third-most in the PCL, behind Gage Jump (56) and Josh Stephan (50), and T-10th in Triple-A...he is one of two PCL pitchers to recorded eight-or-more strikeouts in three games this season (also, Gage Jump, 4 games).

WHIZ AND WHIFFS: Recorded 20 total whiffs in his start on May 8, the most by any Triple-A pitcher that day...was his most whiffs in a game this season, and third most in a game in his career...20 is T-7th most by a Triple-A pitcher in a game this season...Carson has racked up 127 whiffs, the most second-most by any Triple-A pitcher this year, behind only the Rochester Red Wings' Riley Cornelio (128).

BASES LOADED: In his minor league career, has allowed a .417 opponent batting average when the bases are loaded, going 10-for-24 with three doubles, three home runs, 27 RBI and eight strikeouts.

ACE VS. ACES: Whiz is 2-1 in six career starts against the Aces...has posted a 4.18 ERA (32.1 IP, 15 ER) with six home runs, nine walks and 33 strikeouts...last faced Reno on May 8 where he did not factor into the decision of Sacramento's 1-2 defeat...allowed one run on four hits with two walks and a season-high-tying eight strikeouts.

• Last pitched at Greater Nevada Field on July 5 last season where he earned the win in the River Cats' 8-4 victory...allowed two runs on a Triple-A career-high-tying nine hits with three walks and three strikeouts.

LEAGUE LEADER: Alongside ranking third in the PCL in strikeouts, Whiz leads the PCL in ERA and opponent batting average...also ranks fourth in WHIP (1.28) and sixth in innings pitched (48.1)

IT'S GONNA BE MAY: Whisenhunt has his lowest career ERA in the month of May at 2.79 (103.1 IP, 32 ER) with 10 home runs, 33 walks, 116 strikeouts and a .199 opponent batting average.

TERRIBLE TUES: On the flip side, he holds his second-highest ERA on Tuesdays (5.06)...has pitched 53.1 innings, allowing 30 earned runs, five home runs, 21 walks, 71 strikeouts and a .256 opponent batting average...is behind just Fridays (5.44 ERA).
