FRIDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 1-0, to snap a season-long eight-game losing streak. **Jacob Bresnahan** started and threw seven scoreless innings, the longest scoreless start of his pro career, to pick up his first Double-A win. **Mitch White** worked a scoreless eighth and **Tyler Vogel** closed his league-leading 16th save in the ninth. The game's only run scored on a solo homer by **Gavin Kilen** in the bottom of the sixth. Saturday's game was canceled due to rain.

POSTSEASON BOUND: The June 12 win clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division title for the Flying Squirrels, locking in a postseason berth. The Flying Squirrels will play the second-half Southwest champion Erie SeaWolves in the Division Series. Game 1 will be in Erie on Tues., Sept. 15. Game 2 and, if necessary, Game 3 will be at CarMax Park on Thurs., Sept. 17 and Sat., Sept. 18. If Richmond advances to the EL Championship Series, Game 1 will be at CarMax Park on Sun., Sept. 20. This year marks the fifth postseason appearance in franchise history and the first since 2023.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels are on the verge of leading the Eastern League and all 30 Double-A MiLB clubs in total and average attendance for the fifth consecutive year. Among the 120 MiLB clubs, the Flying Squirrels rank fifth in average attendance (7,088) in 2026. The Flying Squirrels are 3,208 fans shy of surpassing the highest total attendance in franchise history (463,942 in 2010). Richmond is also on pace to break the team record for the highest average attendance in franchise history, which was set in 2025 (6,768).

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Chesapeake Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, in the finale of a rain-shortened, five-game series to close the regular season. This is the Baysox first trip to CarMax Park. Richmond went 2-4 in Bowie from June 16-21 for their first series loss of the year opening the second half. The Flying Squirrels won four-of-six in Bowie from August 18-23.

RECORD YEAR: The Flying Squirrels' 10-game win streak from April 4-15 was the longest in franchise history, surpassing an eight-game win streak from May 5-13, 2021, also beginning with the second game of the season. The 74-60 record is tied for the best in team history through 134 games, even with 2014. Richmond has won eight series, split 10 and lost six this year. After opening the season with a 2-7 record through May 13, the Flying Squirrels are 47-53 in their last 100 games since.

RELENTLESS: In their 74 wins this year, the Flying Squirrels have come from behind in 37 of them. In 26 of the wins, Richmond has taken the lead in the eighth inning or later. The Flying Squirrels have 12 walk-off wins at CarMax Park this season, including at least one in all but one home series. **Diego Velasquez** has three walk-off hits this year, all in 10th innings. **Drew Cavanaugh**, **Parks Harber** and **Dayson Croes** each have two walk-off winners this year. Richmond has five wins after trailing by five-or-more runs this season. The Flying Squirrels are batting .277 in the ninth inning this year, which leads the EL and is fifth in MiLB. The Flying Squirrels have won 32 one-run decisions this year, the most in the EL and a franchise record. They are 11-2 in extra innings.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS won the Southwest Division first-half title by seven games over second-place Erie. For the year, Richmond is third among all 30 Double-A teams in batting average (.264), second in sacrifice flies (53) and have the fewest strikeouts (1,069). The team has combined for 122 homers this year, surpassing 12 of the franchise's previous 15 season totals. On Aug. 18 at Chesapeake, the Flying Squirrels set new single-season record for stolen bases, passing 168 in 2014. On August 26, the Flying Squirrels recorded their 50th sacrifice fly of the season off the bat of **Lisbel Diaz**, passing 49 in 2012 for a new team record. With an RBI single by **Zane Zielinski** in the seventh inning on August 29, the Flying Squirrels set the single-season RBIs record (previously 604, 2023). Diaz hit a three-run homer in the first inning on August 30 to pass the single-season team runs record (previously 538, 2023). The Flying Squirrels are on pace to set offensive single-season franchise records for batting average, total bases, OBP, SLG and OPS. Richmond's No. 9 batters have combined to hit .300 this year, which leads the minors. The Flying Squirrels have scored 10-or-more runs 13 times this year, passing 2023 (11) for the most in a season in franchise history. The Richmond pitching staff has thrown 11 shutouts this season, which is tied for first in the Eastern League and tied for sixth in MiLB.

THE BAYSOX were eliminated from postseason contention last Sunday. The Baysox roster features nine players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list, including RHP Anthony Eyanson (No. 1), LHP Joseph Dzierwa (No. 3), LHP Caden Hunter (No. 4), RHP JT Quinn (No. 13), SS Wehiwa Aloy (No. 15), C Ethan Anderson (No. 23), LHP Sebastian Gondora (No. 24), 2B/OF Aron Estrada (No. 25) and RHP Brock Moore (No. 28). There are seven Baysox players featured in MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list, including Eyanson (No. 2), Dzierwa (No. 3), Hunter (No. 4), Aloy (No. 8), Estrada (No. 13), Quinn (No. 14) and Anderson (No. 16).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Greg Farone** makes his 25th Double-A start and his fifth against the Baysox. In his last start last Sunday at Akron, he worked into the second inning but finished his outing with six runs (three earned) allowed and recorded three outs. Farone was Richmond's Opening Day starter on April 4 at Erie in his Double-A debut and allowed one run over 4.2 innings. He had eight strikeouts, tying the franchise record for the most strikeouts on Opening Day. He pitched his first professional season in 2025 and split the year between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene. He made 12 starts for San Jose, going 2-1 with a 3.73 ERA. At the time of his promotion in June, he ranked third in the California League in strikeouts (73). Farone closed the year with 11 starts at High-A, going 4-2 with a 4.25 ERA. Farone began his college career at Herkimer College in New York, where he led the team to the program's first NJCAA national title in 2022, going 7-0 with a 1.65 ERA and was named the NJCAA Division III Player of the Year and MVP of the World Series. He transferred to the University of Louisville for the 2023 season and pitched at the University of Alabama in 2024 before being selected by the Giants in the seventh round of that year's MLB Draft. **For more on Farone, see page two.**

FOR CHESAPEAKE: Right-hander Patrick Reilly makes his eighth Double-A start this year and the third of his career against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he threw seven innings and allowed two runs with eight strikeouts last Saturday against the Sea Dogs in a no-decision. He first faced Richmond on April 19, 2025, at The Diamond and threw a scoreless inning before leaving the game and missing the rest of the season after undergoing Tommy John surgery. Reilly returned to the field this June on a rehab assignment and joined the Baysox in late-July. On August 21, he held the Flying Squirrels to one run over five innings in a no-decision in Bowie. Reilly was selected by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the fifth round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Vanderbilt. He was traded to the Orioles on July 30, 2024, for OF Billy Cook.

CROES CONTROL: **Dayson Croes** is batting .347 (35-for-101) with 28 singles, six doubles, a homer, 12 RBIs and eight walks over his last 25 games since August 13, raising his season batting average at Double-A from .237 to .277. Croes has picked up multiple hits seven times in his last 19 games since August 21, including three three-hit games and two four-hit games. On Wednesday, he went 4-for-5, tying his career high for hits and RBIs (4). He also hit three doubles, tying the Flying Squirrels single-game record.

NICE GOIN', COHEN: **Trevor Cohen** is batting .375 (21-for-56) with two doubles, a homer and six RBIs over his last 13 games since August 27. He has picked up at least one hit in 12-of-13 games and has multiple hits eight times, including a three-hit game on August 30 against Portland, in that stretch. For the season, Cohen leads all Giants minor leaguers in runs (106) and stolen bases (46).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 334 wins in his career, which is a franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23, 2025. From 2011-2013, Dave Machemer won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Of Richmond managers since 1954, Pelfrey is second in wins behind Eddie Haas (1968, 1981-84), who had 351 wins.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Sabin Ceballos** is tied for fifth in walks (72). **Maui Ahuna** is tied for eighth in stolen bases (31). **Jonah Cox** is tied for first in triples (5). **Tyler Vogel** is first in saves (16), tied for third in wins (9) and tied for fifth in games (44). **Trystan Vrieling** is first in shutouts (1) and tied for first in complete games (1). **Greg Farone** is tied for third in games starts (25).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features five players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Jacob Bresnahan** (No. 6), **Dakota Jordan** (No. 9), **Gavin Kilen** (No. 10), **Trevor Cohen** (No. 12) and RHP **Miguel Mendez** (No. 20). Jordan is rated as the organization's best athlete. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features seven Richmond players, including Kilen (No. 6), Jordan (No. 7), Bresnahan (No. 9), Cohen (No. 14), Mendez (No. 16), **Jancel Villarroel** (No. 18) and **Lisbel Diaz** (No. 29).

MISC NOTES: **Tyler Vogel** is the first Eastern League reliever to reach 16 saves in a season since Portland's Luis Guerrero (18) in 2023. He now has the fifth-most saves in a season in franchise history, with Heath Hembre's 17 saves in 2011 next on the list. Vogel is also tied for fifth in franchise history in career saves with 22, even with Josh Osich (2013-2016) and Tyler Myrick (2023-2025) and one behind Rafael Cova (23, 2010). His nine wins this season are the second-most as a reliever in team history, trailing Edwin Quiarte (11, 2014). // **Lisbel Diaz** hit his second Double-A homer on Aug. 30 and his 26th overall this season between Low-A San Jose, High-A Eugene and Richmond, which is second-most in the Giants organization this year. // **Ryan Vanderhei** is 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA (5 ER/30.0 IP) in his last 21 outings since June 20, allowing five earned runs and seven total runs in that stretch with 32 strikeouts and a .176 BAA. // **Sabin Ceballos** has 72 walks this season, the second-most in a season in franchise and trailing only Jacob Heyward (80, 2019). In his career, Ceballos has worked 119 walks, which is fourth-most in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He is four walks behind Velasquez (123, 2024-26) for a tie for third on the all-time franchise list. // **Maui Ahuna** has 31 stolen bases this season, sixth-most in a season in franchise history behind Gary Brown (33, 2012). He also has the highest (min. 25 att.) stolen base percentage (.886, 31-for-35) in a season in team history. // There have been 51 Flying Squirrels alumni who have played in the majors this year (plus Donovan Walton, who had previous MLB experience before playing in Richmond), including 29 with the Giants.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1978: The Richmond Braves beat the Pawtucket Red Sox, 2-1, at McCoy Stadium to take a 3-1 lead in the Governors' Cup finals. Hank Small hit an RBI double in the first inning. Larry Whisenton brought in a second run with a groundout in the third. Frank LaCorte allowed two runs and struck out six over 5 2/3 innings. **1994:** The Richmond Braves beat the Syracuse Chiefs, 3-0, at The Diamond to cap a three-game sweep in the Governors' Cup finals. Jose Oliva hit a solo homer in the fourth to open the scoring. Richmond added a second run in the sixth on an error. With the bases loaded in the eighth, Eddie Perez hit a grounder to first base and Mike Kelly beat the throw home to open a 3-0 lead. Brad Woodall threw seven scoreless innings and allowed three hits. Terry Clark worked the eighth. Brad Clontz closed out his third save of the playoffs with a scoreless ninth. **2011:** The Flying Squirrels beat the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 10-9, in Game 1 of the Eastern League Championship Series in Manchester. Trailing, 9-8, entering the top of the ninth, Skyler Stromsmoe hit a go-ahead, two-run homer. Jackson Williams went 4-for-4 with two RBIs.
