### NEWS & NOTES

**THE AMAZIN' CONEY ISLAND:** For the first time this season, the Hudson Valley Renegades pay a visit to their closest opponent in the Brooklyn Cyclones. The Cyclones won the first series this year back at Heritage Financial Park in May, taking four of six. Grant Richardson won the series finale for Hudson Valley with a walk off RBI single in the ninth.

**A HALF IS CLINCHED IN BROOKLYN:** With a 1-0 win on Tuesday, the Hudson Valley Renegades clinched the first-half crown in the North Division of the South Atlantic League. For the first time since 2019 the 'Gades secured a playoff spot and will host games 2 and 3 (if necessary) in the first round of the South Atlantic League playoffs.

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Hudson Valley Renegades dropped their third straight contest to the Brooklyn Cyclones, 2-0 on Saturday night. Brooklyn scored both runs in the first inning against **Juan Carela**, who fired a quality start, striking out six in six innings. **Rafael Flores** reached base three times to lead the offense. Flores and **Antonio Gómez** extended their on-base streaks to 12 and 11 games respectively. **Jack Neely** struck out five and retired all six batters he faced.

**HEATING UP:** In the month of June, **Antonio Gómez** has been one of the hottest hitters in the South Atlantic League. In 16 games, the Renegades catcher is hitting .352/.426/.556 with five doubles, two HRs, 5 RBI, and 10 runs. His .360 average is the third-highest among qualified hitters in the SAL and High-A.

**THREE IS THE MAGIC NUMBER:** In their 8-3 victory over the Brooklyn Cyclones on Wednesday night, **Rafael Flores**, **Spencer Jones**, and **Aldenis Sanchez** each recorded a triple. The team's three triples are a single-game high this season for Hudson Valley and are tied for the most in the South Atlantic League this year. The Greensboro Grasshoppers tallied three triples in Winston Salem back on June 1st. Jones and Sanchez are tied for the team lead with four triples, the fourth-most in the SAL as well.

**SUNDAY'S BEST:** RHP **Drew Thorpe** has been the Renegades' Sunday starter for the entire season and he has not disappointed. The former 2nd round pick currently ranks first in wins (6), third in IP (64.2), fourth in strikeouts (79), fifth in ERA (2.64), sixth in WHIP (1.13), and seventh in AVG (.222) in the South Atlantic League. Among Yankees' Minor Leaguers, his ERA ranks third best only trailing Clayton Beeter (SWB--AAA) and fellow teammate Chase Hampton (SOM--AA). The six wins are tied with Beeter for the most.

**JUAN-TASTIC:** RHP **Juan Carela** has been dominant over his last four starts, striking out 36 batters in 25.2 innings. The 21-year-old starter

owns a 2.45 ERA in this span and has held opponents to a .174 average. The 36 strikeouts in the month of June are the second-most in MiLB, with Connor Phillips (CHA--AA) leading the way with 40.

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER:** Hudson Valley's bullpen has been nails during the last 23 games. Renegades relievers combined for a 2.05 ERA (83.1 IP, 46 H, 22 R/19 ER, 28 BB, 106 K). The home run hit by Brandon Parker last Wednesday was the first earned run allowed by the 'Gades bullpen since May 31st. The streak spanned 36.1 innings.

**STARTERS AIN'T TOO SHABBY EITHER:** The last turn through the rotation for Hudson Valley has seen some outstanding pitching. Since May 31st against Aberdeen, Renegades starters have a 1.63 ERA (116.0 IP, 60 H, 28 R, 21 ER, 56 BB, 154 K), the best in Minor League Baseball in that span. The 154 strikeouts are also the most in the MiLB as well. The Renegades also have tossed the fourth-most innings. The 56 hits allowed are the fifth-lowest in the Minors but all four teams below have not thrown more than 83.1 innings in this span.

**BIG WINS AND LOSSES:** The Renegades have already played in an extraordinary number of lopsided games this season, with 26 of the team's 68 games (38.2%) being decided by 5-or-more runs.

✦ Hudson Valley sports a 15-11 (.576) record in game decided by 5+ runs.

✦ The club has already played seven games decided by 11-or-more runs, and has a 4-3 (.500) record in those games.

✦ The 'Gades have also played 19 one-run games, and are 8-11 (.421).

**HOW LOW CAN THEY GO:** Over the course of the month of June, the Hudson Valley Renegades pitching staff has been unhittable. They currently hold a 1.85 ERA, the lowest in MiLB. The Vancouver Canadians (TOR--A+) are a distant second at 2.37. The 'Gades have also struck out 242 batters in 185.0 innings, the second-highest mark as well. The Somerset Patriots (NYY--AA) sit fifth, with 231 K's in 194.0 innings. The Tampa Tarpons (NYY--A) are t-16th with 211 punchouts.

**CLIMBING THE LADDER:** With a hit on Saturday, **Eduardo Torrealba** has tallied 121 career hits with the Renegades, good for third all-time. Angel Perez holds the franchise record with 125.

**HISTORY! (ALMOST):** The Hudson Valley Renegades fell just two outs from tossing their third no-hitter in franchise history on Tuesday night against the Brooklyn Cyclones. This comes after the Renegades no-hit the Rome Braves 6.2 frames last Saturday night.

**CABRERA:** Set a new career high with 5 RBIs on 6/6 @ Jersey Shore --> 2-for-4, R, 2 2B, 5 RBI, BB, 2 K.

**CRISP:** Was hitting .400/.625/.400 in three games (2-for-5) with Double-A Somerset to start the season.

**COWLES:** Picked up his 10th multi-hit game of the season on 6/6 @ Jersey Shore, and his first three-hit game. Walk off RBI 1B on 6/16 vs ROM

**FLORES:** Held hitless in back-to-back games for the first time in his career on 5/2 & 5/3 vs Wilmington.

**GARCIA:** After only playing in only one game (2 AB) since 5/3, went 1-for-3 vs ABD (6/4).

**GÓMEZ:** Hit .151/.200/.233 in May after batting .271/.358/.339 in April.

**HENSON:** Back-to-back-to-back multi-hit games on 5/24, 5/25, and 5/26 at Wilmington -- 9-for-16, 2 2B, HR, 3 RBI

**JONES:** Season-long seven-game hitting streak from 6/10 - 6/18... hit .464/.531/.857 with two 2B, three HR's and 6 RBIs during this span.

**RICHARDSON:** Batted .417/.517/.583 during seven-game hitting streak from May 18-27.

**SÁNCHEZ:** Finished 2nd on the team, 5th in the SAL in SB (32) last year...tied franchise record with two triples vs WIL (5/3).

**TORREALBA:** Picked up his 100th and 101st hits as a Renegade on 5/10 @ Aberdeen.

**VARGAS:** For the 2018 international signing period, was ranked by MLB.com as the No. 8 prospect.

# RENEGADES STARTING PITCHER

## 28 DREW THORPE • RHP • 6'4" • 190 LBS • 22

**LAST TIME OUT:** For the third straight start, Thorpe was magnificent for Hudson Valley, throwing 6.0 innings and allowing no runs on just three hits while picking up his SAL-leading sixth win of the season last Sunday against Rome. He struck out the side two times in the start, while the Braves struggled to generate any offense against him. In his last three starts, Thorpe has turned in 21.0 IP, allowing only 9 H, 4 BB, and 27 K without allowing a run.

**QUALITY STUFF:** Thorpe has fired five quality starts in his last seven outings (QS = at least 6.0 IP, 3-or-fewer ER). He is one of only four pitchers in the South Atlantic League with three quality starts this season, and is joined by Greenville's Isaac Coffey (5) and Hunter Dobbins (4), Wilmington's Dustin Saenz (4), and Greensboro's Anthony Solometo (4).

**YANKEES DIRECTOR OF PITCHING SAM BRIEND ON THORPE:** "The first thing that sticks out in my mind about Thorpe is he's just a competitor. You always want those kinds of guys. New York is a really tough place to play so you want to draft and sign guys that make you a better pitcher than you were. He's going to be able to handle pitching there and Thorpe hands down has that. He's really impressive out there, nothing rattles him. And then on top of that the secondary pitches are great. The changeup was a weapon to both hands in college, he's a high raw spin guy, the slider is disgusting. He throws two kinds of sliders -- he does throw the sweeper one and he has the shorter, tighter one and he just has such command of the zone with those offspeed pitches. It makes it really tough when you've got three different shapes there that are all going in different directions and he can move them around in the zone. As a hitter you can't really sit on anything and it's been awesome to watch."

### 2023 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season on the Renegades Break Camp Roster.
- Allowed a leadoff home run to Greensboro's Mike Jarvis on his first pro pitch on April 9, then struck out 4 of the next 5 batters.
- Struck out 10 batters in 4.2 innings on April 23 at Rome, becoming the first Renegades pitcher to strike out 10+ batters in a single game since T.J. Sikkema on July 16, 2022 against the Greenville Drive. HV tied a franchise record (for 9-inn. game) in that game by striking out 19 Rome batters.
- On June 4 vs Aberdeen threw 8.0 IP, 1H, 0 R, 2 BB, 7 K, becoming the first Renegades pitcher to throw 8.0 shutout innings in a start since Tyree Hayes threw a 9-inn. complete game shutout against the Lowell Spinners on Aug. 17, 2008. He was only the third HV starter to complete 8.0 innings in a start in the Portal Era (2005-Present).
- Named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week for the week of May 29-June 4 after 8.0 shutout innings vs Aberdeen.
- Struck out 12 batters on June 11 at Jersey Shore, setting a new Renegades franchise record for most strikeouts in a game.

### PERSONAL:

- Full name is Andrew Robert Thorpe.
- As a redshirt sophomore at Cal Poly in 2022, went 10-1 with a 2.32 ERA (104.2 IP, 65 H, 31 R/27 ER, 25 BB, 149 K, 5 HR) in 15 starts... His 149 strikeouts ranked second in the nation, trailing only Oregon State's Cooper Hjerpe (161 K), who was selected by St. Louis with the 22<sup>nd</sup> overall selection in 2022 First-Year Player Draft.
- Ranked third in the country in H/9.0IP (5.59), sixth in WHIP (0.86), 10th in wins (10), 13th in K/9.0 IP (12.81) and 17th in ERA... Was named to six All-America First Teams, including Collegiate Baseball, ABCA, Perfect Game, Baseball America, D1Baseball.com and the NCBWA, becoming the first six-time All-American in program history.
- Was named one of five finalists for National Pitcher of the Year, as well as a semifinalist for both the Dick Howser Trophy and Golden Spikes Award.
- Was also named the Big West Conference Pitcher of the Year, becoming the first pitcher in school history to earn the accolade... Prior to the 2022 First-Year Player Draft, was ranked as the No. 61 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline and the No. 62 prospect by Baseball America.
