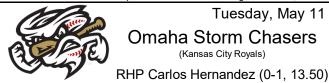

Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send LHP Kirk McCarty to the mound today, as they wrap up the season series with their longtime IL West rivals. Louisville will counter with RHP Ashton Goudeau. The Clippers are 4-1 (.800) against right handers this year. Goudeau has never pitched against the Clippers in his career, having played his only season of Triple-A with Tacoma in 2018.

vs. the Storm Chasers

Columbus has not played Omaha in the regular season since 1991, when they were known as the Royals and played in the American Association. From 1988-91, the two leagues played crossover games with the Clippers winning 11 of 21 against Omaha, including six of nine in Columbus. The Clippers met the Storm Chasers in the 2011 Triple-A National Championship in Albuquerque (W, 8-3).

Explosions

The Clippers scored all of their runs in the 5th (4) and 7th (2) innings on Saturday, following a Friday in which they did the same (6-run 5th, 4-run 7th). On the season, the Clippers are outscoring opponents 10-0 in the 5th and 6-0 in the 7th, as 75% of their runs have come in those frames (additionally, the Clippers had a 5-run 1st in the season opener). Half (4) of their run-scoring innings have seen 4+.

First In Wins

Through the first four games this season, the team that scored first won every game, with Saturday's contest seeing the first lead change of the season (rallied from 3-0 deficit). Dating to 8/24/19, there had been no lead changes in 14 straight regular season games, with the decisive run being scored by the 3rd inning in 10 of those games (10 decided by 4+).

Back at It

Over his last 53G with Columbus, dating to 8/16/18, Oscar Mercado is hitting .295/.390/.455 with 4HR and 23RBI, after having hit .119 (5x42) through his first 14 games as a Clipper. His hot streak includes an 11G hit streak in early 2019 (4/11-4/25) that came immediately after an 0x10 series vs. Louisville (4/8-4/10). He has been successful in 77% of his steal attempts in that time (20 of 26).

Hole in the Heart

The 3-4 spots in the Clipper order went a combined 0x24 through the first three games, then 3x8 with a HR on Friday and followed up with 0x8 on Saturday (Oscar Mercado had a season worst 9LOB). Owen Miller went 0x4 in his only time batting 3rd this season (Thursday), but has a four game hitting streak when batting 5th (.563, 9x16).

Johnson on a Roll

After dipping below .300 with an 0x5 day on 8/8/19 vs. Pawtucket, Daniel Johnson hit safely in nine straight (.424, 14x33 from 8/9-8/18). On 8/22/19, Johnson tied his single game best with 5RBI and kicked off a streak of four straight games with an XBH (XBH in six of last nine as a Clipper). In his last 21G at Triple-A, he is hitting .346/.420/.590 with 3HR and 13RBI.

Struggles Continue

In 45 games since getting optioned on 7/16/19, Bobby Bradley has hit .195/.307/.415 with just 10HR and 24RBI while posting a strikeout in 37% of his PA (71 of 192). Only 9RBI since the option are on non-HR and he has accumulated 73LOB in 45 games. In 43 games immediately prior to getting recalled (5/3-6/21/19), Bradley hit .310/.373/.732 with 21HR and 44RBI (32% strikeout rate, 59K in 185PA).

Quick Feet

The Clippers have swiped a bag in four of the first five games, totalling 5SB against 1CS, putting them on pace for 120SB in this shortened season. In 2019, they hit triple digits in steals (104) for the first time since 2013 (have increased steal total each year since 2016). Unfortunately, only two runners have come around to score after improving their station on the basepaths.

Shutting It Down

The Clipper bullpen has yet to allow a run in the final third of a ballgame, allowing only 13 batters to reach base (6BB, HBP, five singles, double; only two of those batters have made it to third base). In the 9th inning, Blake Parker and DJ Johnson have sent the Bats down in order three times, registering 8K between the two (opposing hitters have 21K and 2GIDP in innings 7-9).

Columbus Clippers Game Information

This Date in Clipper History

The Clippers beat Richmond 3-2 on a 12th-inning, walk-off solo homer from **Andy Cannizaro**. The home run was his 1st of the season and 7th of his career. Cannizaro would go on to win the Clipper of the Year Award in 2006, hitting .276 with a team leading 32 doubles. He also earned his first promotion to the Majors in 2006, collecting a single in his 1st AB on 9/8 at Baltimore and hitting his 1st HR on 9/25 at Tampa Bay.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 years since the move downtown, Huntington Park has ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game, totaling 2.25 per contest (1,763HR, 783 games). Last year, HP averaged over three per game for the first time ever (seventh time averaging over a pair), as the Clippers surrendered a record 127HR and just missed out on triple digits themselves (97HR was second highest team total). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (923 to 894).

Record Destruction

The Clippers broke the established mark for homers in a season (182 in 1983) on 8/7/19 and finished with a total of 213 (most in the IL). From 5/14-6/2, they homered in 20 straight games (44HR total) and they had seven straight multi-HR games from 6/14-6/21 (22HR). On the mound, they broke the record for homers allowed (156 in 1998) on 7/31/19, giving up 198 for the year (2nd most in the IL).

Ain't Over 'Til It's Over

Since the start of the 2014 season, no team has had more come from behind victories than the 210 posted by Columbus (35 last season) and no team has produced a better winning percentage when trailing than the .353 of the Clippers (Scranton/WB ranks 2nd in win percentage at .338 and wins, 192).

Walk-Off Magic

Columbus was 5-2 in walk-off games last season, winning four thanks to the courtesy runner in extra innings (Columbus pitching did not allow a run through first 9.0IP in extras last year). On 6/29/19 at Louisville, they suffered their first walk-off loss of the year, snapping an 81 game streak without (previous loss was 5/31/18 at Buffalo). Additionally, the Clippers ranked 1st in the IL with a 16-8 (.667) record in games decided in the last at bat.

Trending Downward

While ranking in the top three of the IL with a 4.71ERA (3rd), the 2019 Clippers registered their worst mark since the 1998 season (4.85ERA). In 2018, they ranked dead last in the IL with a 4.34ERA, marking the third straight (now fourth) season that the team ERA had gotten worse. From 2011-16, the Clipper staff turned in a sub-4.00ERA five times in six seasons (zero such seasons from 1993-2010), including the best two ERAs of the past 30 years (3.33 in 2015 and 3.65 in 2016).

Doing Damage

In 2019, the Clippers ranked tied for 5th in the IL with 112RBI with the bases loaded, while carrying a .252 average (10th, 36x143, 4HR). In both 2017 and 2018, the Clippers led the IL in RBI with the bases loaded (243RBI total) and paced the circuit in grand slams (16 total, no other team had more than eight).

Free Swingers

After two straight seasons leading the IL in strikeouts, the Clipper lineup was atop the IL again in 2019 (1,392K, 60 more than 2nd place). They obliterated the franchise record (1,297, set in 2017; 2018's total of 1,290 was 2nd worst in franchise history), passing it on 8/22/19 (reduced strikeout rate to 8.3 per game after setting record, 10.1 prior). On the season a Clipper was punched out at least four times in a game on 15 occasions (**Eric Haase** led the team with three golden sombreros).

That's More Like It

In 2019, the Clippers were 50-30 (.625) when playing errorless baseball, while turning in a 31-29 (.517) mark with at least one error. Contrary to logic, in 2018 they actually had a worse winning percentage when playing mistake free (.514), than when committing at least one error (.530). The Clipper defense finished 1st in 2019 (.983) after falling to 6th in the IL in 2018, ending a run of three consecutive seasons ranked among the top three (2015-17 resulted in the three best seasons in franchise history).

One On, No Out Success

When the leadoff batter of an inning reached base in 2019, the Clippers plated him nearly 60% of the time (over 51% only once in the last six seasons, 55% in 2016). Getting more than one base was a specialty of Clipper hitters, as they led the IL with 136XBH to lead off the inning, including 54HR (led the IL, had 28 leadoff homers in 2018). From 4/13-4/20/19, the Clippers hit 16 leadoff doubles over 72 innings, including four straight innings in a win at Louisville on 4/15/19.

Good Baseball

Ernie Clement advanced a runner with a sac bunt on 5/8 at Louisville and the runner came around to score in the win. During 2019, the Clippers struggled in the bunt department (12 successes), but when the advanced runners did score, they were 7-1. During 2018, Columbus was 23-2 in games in which a run was scored after a good bunt attempt (54 successes; won 17 in a row from 4/12-7/31/18).

International Accolades

Bobby Bradley was named International League Player of the Month for May 2019, reaching base in 24 of 25 games during the month while hitting .302/.374/.740 with 12HR (led IL) and 28RBI. **Brandon Barnes, Eric Haase, Josh Smith** and **Asher Wojciechowski** were named to the 2019 IL All-Star Team and Bradley, Barnes and Haase were selected to the postseason squad.

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy makes his Clippers debut in 2021, following Tony Mansolino's championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; Gene Michael-'79, Joe Altobelli-'80, Frank Verdi-'81, Bucky Dent-'87 and Mike Sarbaugh-'10). This season marks Tracy's second year as a manager (first with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 34-47 (.420), 4-1 with Columbus (.800).

Lack of Lefties:

Over the course of 140 games in 2019, the Clippers trotted out a lefty starter just 15 times (**Logan Allen-** 5, **Scott Moss-** 4, **Tanner Tully-** 3, **Sean Brady-** 2 and **Kyle Nelson-** 1), as right handers made 68 consecutive starts from 4/18-6/30. Including the bullpen, lefties accounted for 15.5% of the innings pitched for Columbus in 2019 (191.1IP) and only Louisville had fewer. **Josh Smith** (52.2IP) was the only Clipper with at least 25.0IP.
