### Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Ryan Webb** to the mound today, looking to improve to 6-1 on Tuesdays (three straight series opening win). St. Paul will counter with RHP **John Klein**. Columbus is 16-8 (.667) versus right handers this year. Klein has pitched against the Clippers once in his career, taking the loss on 9/10/25 in St. Paul (4.0IP, 2H, 3R, 3ER, 5BB, 4K).

### vs. the Saints

Columbus went 4-2 against the Saints in Minnesota last year, on the way to a 9-7 series record, and has won 45 of the last 71 overall opposing the Saints (384-297 run differential; 13 of 26 losses by a single run, only eight losses by more than two runs). Individually, **Stuart Fairchild** is the only Clipper hitting over .300 in his career against the Saints (.353, 6x17, in 5G).

### Time to Get One

Tonight kicks off the eighth series of the season for the Clippers and they have yet to homer in a series opener (246; opponents have 7HR in 232AB), but they have averaged 6.0 runs per game, going 5-2 (5.9 runs on 1.5 homers in all other games, 15-17). On the road, the Clippers have hit 22HR in 21G, with 17HR coming in the back half of the series (3HR in first half, 2HR in only midpoint game).

### Crazy Eighthths

Columbus has scored in the 8th inning in each of the last 7G (12 runs in total), while plating runs in the 9th of each of the last 3G (eight total). On the season, the Clippers have scored 70 runs from the 8th inning on (23 more than 2nd place), crafting a collective .958OPS (116 points ahead of 2nd). All those late runs have led to an IL-best 15 comeback victories, including four when trailing after the 7th.

### Watch Out for Watson

**Kahlil Watson** is hitting .333/.467/.639 with 11XBH in his last 20G (1XBH in first 12G), having reached base in each of his last 11G (.463OBP since 4/23). Watson drew his 30th walk of the season Saturday and his 40th strikeout on Sunday (one of three in the IL with at least 30 of each) and, with his 6HR, he owns a three true outcome rate of 50.7% (7th highest among 101 IL hitters with at least 120PA).

### Since the Option

**Juan Brito** is hitting .267/.377/.600 with 4HR and 14RBI in 11G since getting optioned on 4/28 (current 9G hit streak: .316, 12x38). **George Valera** is hitting just .189 (7x37) with 2RBI in 8G since his option on 4/30 (.294, 10x34 with 12RBI in 8G rehab last month). Since the start of 2021, there have been 10 Clippers to hit 40 doubles (Brito has most, 55 and Valera is 9th, 41; **Nolan Jones** has 39).

### Eye is for Ingle

**Cooper Ingle** has drawn 22BB in his first 77PA (29%) this season, following 21BB in 107PA (20%) last season. Though Ingle has hit only .272 (34x136) in his Columbus career, he has a beefy .457OBP and a +13 differential in the walk to strikeout department (43 to 30). Since his Triple-A debut on 8/13/25, his 43BB are tied for 7th most (**Travis Bazzana** is 3rd, 47, and **Kahlil Watson** is 4th, 46).

### Always On

**Stuart Fairchild** is one of six Clippers with an on base streak stretching back over a week, coming into tonight at 7G (.514OBP since 5/2; **Kody Huff** has a .622OBP over his 8G streak since 5/1). Fairchild has drawn 9BB in 39PA this month (23%) and his .442OBP for the year ranks 2nd in the IL (**Travis Bazzana** is 7th, **Kahlil Watson** is 9th and Huff is 15th; no other team has more than two in top 15).

### Hot Huff

**Kody Huff** rebounded from a pair of hitless games to end April with hits in each of his first 8G this month (.517, 15x29, six multi-hit, 10RBI). His XBH streak was snapped at 5G on Friday, but he still owns 11XBH in his last 20G (.600SLG since 4/16). Huff is sitting at 24 runs and 29RBI through 33G (one of 19 in the IL with 20+ of both; had 31 runs and a career high 47RBI in 101G last year).

### POW Hangover

Since being named the IL's Batter of the Week for 4/14-4/19 vs. Iowa (10x20, 4HR, 10RBI), **Milan Tolentino** is hitting .179/.303/.250 with 0HR and 4RBI in 15G (RBI in each of last 3G). Of 33 IL batters with at least 20HR since the start of last season, Tolentino is one of two that has not homered off LHP (107AB; 27HR in 411AB vs. RHP), but he is hitting .370 (10x27) off lefties this year (.138 in '25).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

Tuesday, May 12

## This Date in Clipper History

5/12/1984

After having the previous night's game suspended in a 6-6 tie after the 9th inning due to rain, the Clippers and Rochester resumed the game on 5/12. **Joe Cowley** earned the win by pitching a scoreless 10th inning in the suspended game and then, in the regularly scheduled game, Cowley picked up his second win of the day, starting and tossing 7.0 innings.

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,423 to 1,372).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers are 49-55 (.471) in pitch reviews, with batters going 31-40 (.437) and pitchers/catchers going 18-15 (.545). They have run out of challenges in 23G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

## Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

## Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

## Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

## Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 11th in the IL this year (.977), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 21G this season (12-9, .571), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

## Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

## Good Baseball

**Juan Brito** moved a runner into scoring position with a sac bunt on 5/7 at lowa and that runner came around to score in a 2-run win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 85-23 (.787) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 2-2 mark this season (.500, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 406-425 (.489), 376-379 with Columbus (.498).

### Unfinished Business:

Webb was relieved mid-inning in 11 of his 21GS last season, bequeathing 20 runners to the bullpen (nine scored, 45%). Including his starts with a completed final inning, he was accountable for 22ER (26R) in the last inning that he began (15.2IP), posting a 12.64ERA (82.0IP, 14ER prior; 1.54ERA). Out of the bullpen, he was relieved mid-inning four out of seven times, turning in an 11.25ERA (4.0IP, 5ER) of the last inning he began. So far in 2026, he has been removed mid-inning in 5GS (3.2IP, 8ER).

### Out of Control:

Entering tonight's start, Webb has walked the 2nd most batters in the IL (26 of 139BF, 19%), including a career high 6BB on 4/10 at Worcester (second time, first since 8/25/22 with Lynchburg). He has thrown the 7th most balls in the IL (243), hitting the strikezone only 54.7% of the time (5th worst among pitchers with at least 300 thrown). He struggled in the first four months of last season too (42.5% ball; walking 47 of 326BF, 14.4% of batters). Once the calendar flipped to August, Webb saw strikes on 62.5% of his offerings, cutting the walk rate in half (7.2%, 14BB to 195BF).

### Ending on a High Note:

Webb ended 2025 by going 3-0 with a 1.54ERA in 4GS in September (23.1IP, 13H, 5R, 4ER, 6BB, 25K), including taking a no-hitter into the 7th on 9/16 vs. Omaha (lost with one out, **Bobby Dalbec** single). Webb's September ERA was 6th best in the IL, while he logged the 3rd most innings and strikeouts. The .159 average against for the month was 2nd best and helped propel him to a season average of .227 (6th best in franchise history).

### In Relief:

Webb's relief outing on 5/31/25 at Rochester established a new career high for appearances out of the bullpen, as he piggybacked **Vince Velasquez** twice (4/6/25 vs. St. Paul, 4.1IP, 0ER; 4/13/25 at Worcester, 3.0IP, 4ER) and **Parker Messick** once (blown save on 5/31/25 at Rochester, 3.0IP, 7ER). All together, Webb had a 7.61ERA (23.2IP, 20ER) out of the bullpen last year (7G). In his career, Webb has 10 relief appearances, but all of them have come on starter's rest and gone at least 3.0IP.

### 2026 Spring Training:

Webb pitched three times for Cleveland during spring training, going 1-0 with a 6.00ERA (3.0IP, 4H, 2R, 2ER, 1BB, 4K). After a 26-pitch outing on 3/2 at Texas, he was reassigned to minor league camp on 3/8.
