LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox split a doubleheader on Saturday with the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Bowie took the first of two seven-inning games 1-0, before dropping the second game, 6-4. Left-hander Cade Povich dominated the front end of the double-header. The Southpaw threw five shutout innings, allowing only one hit and two walks, striking out a Double-A career-best 10 batters. Bowie's lone run of the game was driven in via a Donta' Williams sacrifice fly, as right-handers Mychal Givens and Jensen Elliot combined with Povich on the one-hit shutout. In game two, Bowie got out to another 1-0 lead via a John Rhodes RBI single. However, Richmond struck for four runs in the third, before taking on another in each of the fourth and sixth innings, as Ismael Munquia led the way with three RBI. Heston Kjerstad would score on an error in Bowie's half of the fourth, and Zach Watson blasted a two-run home run in the sixth, but the Baysox would get no closer in the game two defeat. Sunday's scheduled series finale between Bowie and Richmond was postponed due to rain.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Erie SeaWolves enter the series with a record of 8-13. The SeaWolves have lost their last five games entering this six-game set with Bowie and sit just a game above the Baysox, 5.5 out of first place in the Southwest division standings. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, Erie is coming off a second-half Southwest division title in 2022, when they advanced to the Eastern League Championship Series, before falling to the Somerset Patriots. So far in 2023, The SeaWolves' 20 home runs are the second-highest total in the Eastern League, as infielder Trei Cruz leads the way with four long balls. Fellow infielder Colt Keith has solidified himself as one of the most consistent bats in the Eastern League, with 24 hits (2nd) and 39 total bases (4th) also ranking towards the top of the leaderboards. Erie's main struggles thus far in 2023 stem from the mound, where its 5.77 team ERA is ranked bottom of the league. SeaWolves' pitchers have allowed the most hits (202 - 38 more than the second-highest total), earned runs (123 - 44 more than the second-highest total) and home runs (25) of any side in the Eastern League. Erie welcomes back Gabe Alvarez for his second season as the team's manager, alongside a mostly new staff. The SeaWolves' roster consists of nine of the Tigers' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline. Position players include the aforementioned Keith (No. 4 DET/ No. 94 overall), along with fellow infielders Wenceel Perez (No. 8 DET) and Gage Workman (No. 29 DET). C Dillon Dingler (No. 14 DET) is the only other position player, with right-handers Wilmer Flores (No. 3 DET/ No. 85 overall), Ty Madden (No. 5 DET), Dylan Smith (No. 15 DET), and Elvis Alvarado (No. 23 DET), alongside left-hander Brant Hurter (No. 21 DET) also featuring on the mound.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Erie looks to open the series by starting left-hander Brant Hurter on the mound. Currently ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the Tigers' system, per MLB Pipeline, Hurter has dazzled for a struggling SeaWolves staff thus far in 2023. Through four starts, the southpaw has only allowed a single earned run in 16 innings - good for a 0.56 ERA. Hurter has allowed 10 hits and eight walks, but has struck out 18 batters on the season, including six in four shutout innings against Portland in his most recent start last Wednesday. All of Hurter's starts this season have gone exactly four innings, and he has yet to reach the 70-pitch plateau in 2023. Hurter quickly progressed through the Tigers' system in his first professional season last year. It took him just 93 innings to advance through Single-A Lakeland and High-A West Michigan, posting a 3.10 ERA with 119 strikeouts to just 17 walks between the two levels on his way to Erie. Upon joining the SeaWolves in 2022, Hurter struggled, as he allowed 12 earned runs in 13.2 innings off 21 hits, including a start against Bowie on 8/31 where he allowed six runs (five earned) on 8 hits in just two innings. Hurter's season ended being tagged for three runs through 1.2 innings in a postseason relief outing in game one of the Eastern League Championship Series against Somerset. In total, opponents hit over .350 against Hurter at the Double-A level in 2022.

HAIL CÉSAR

Cesar Prieto has been on a tear at the plate to start the season. The No. 17 prospect in the O's system leads the Eastern League, and is second in Double-A, with 27 hits. Prieto also leads the Eastern League with a .355 average, among qualified players. Among Baysox, Prieto leads the way in hits, average, and on-base percentage. He's also third on the team in OPS. Prieto's 27 hits are tied for second-most in the Orioles' system in

HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. Kjerstad launched his sixth Double-A home run in just his 15th game, and his six long balls lead the Eastern League and are the second most at the Double-A level. Beyond the home runs, the Orioles' No. 5 prospect has also demonstrated consistency across the Eastern League leaderboards - ranking third in OPS (1.004), second in slugging percentage (.612) and tops in total bases (41). Kjerstad has the second-most home runs throughout the Orioles' system, while his OPS and slugging percentage sit at third

MOUND REBOUND

The pitching staff as a whole has bounced back nicely for Bowie so far in 2023. After posting a 4.42 staff ERA last season, Bowie has the thirdbest team ERA in the Eastern League, and the fourth-best in all of Double-A, through 19 games at 3.43. Baysox starters have been effective throughout the early portion of the season in particular, with a 2.60 staff ERA amongst starters, including six outings of at least five shutout innings. Two Baysox pitchers currently sit top-five in the league in ERA, among qualifiers, with Justin Armbruester third (1.40) and Chayce McDermott fourth (1.65). Bowie arms have limited the free passes, with the second fewest number of HBP (5) and fewest walks (73) in the Eastern League.

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful learns throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A belianzy to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebit was remared MiLB Somh Alfantic Menager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial ecord sist at 254-216 (5-50) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Reys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madliyn and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief sith in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Fitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Hermann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Herrmann also worked with current Orioles left-hander John Means at 73 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll
