JACKSONVILLE TAKES FINALE WITH 3-2 WIN

Brian Miller hit a single, double and triple, coming up just shy of the cycle, in the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp's 9-5 series-opening loss to the Charlotte Knights Tuesday evening. Down 1-0, the Knights (22-24) touched Jumbo Shrimp (21-23) starter Devin Smeltzer (0-2) for four runs in the second inning and added three more in the third to take a 7-1 lead. Jordan Groshans snuck a two-run home run over the right field wall to bring Jacksonville to within four, 7-3 and never looked back.

'PEN PALS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. However, in the 22 games since, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 44 runs, 37 earned, on 85 hits (6.7 H/9) in 113.2 innings for a 2.93 ERA. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has combined for 126 strikeouts (10.0 K/9) against 66 walks (5.2 BB/9) during this recent run.

WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late; Jacksonville has registered 178 free passes over the last 36 games since April 11, a figure that ranks tied for fifth in the International League. During this stretch, the club has walked in 12.5 percent of their plate appearances. In comparison, the Jumbo Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games of 2023.

AUSTIN POWERS

Jacksonville catcher Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 16 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 18-for-54 (.333/.410/.759/1.169) at the plate with five doubles, six home runs, 11 RBIs, seven walks and 12 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances in 2022, Allen has whiffed just 18.3 percent of the time this season. His .167 BABIP is the second-lowest of the 173 IL players with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023.

KING CHARLES

Over an eight-game stretch from April 14-27, Charles Leblanc went just 1-for-26 (.038) at the plate. The native of Laval in Canada has been absurdly hot since then. Over the last 22 games dating back to April 28, Leblanc is a scorching 22-for-72 (.306/.468/.458/.926) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, seven RBIs and a remarkable 22 walks. On the entirety of the 2023 campaign, the 26-year-old has walked (34) nearly as much he has struck out (37). Leblanc ranks fourth in the International League in walk percentage (21.1 percent) and tied for sixth in total walks (34). His swinging-strike rate of 8.2 percent is 30th-lowest out of the IL's 173 qualified hitters.

THE MAYOR OF STARKVILLE

An offseason trade acquisition from the New York Mets, Jacksonville outfielder Jake Mangum has had an outstanding start to the 2023 season. The former Mississippi State Bulldog is 44-for-138 (.319/.353/.457/.810) with 10 doubles, three triples, one home run, 18 RBIs, six walks and 13 runs scored to start the campaign. Among the 173 qualified players in the IL, Mangum is tied for the fifth-highest line drive rate (32.4 percent) and sixth-highest opposite-field rate (42.7 percent). Those figures were at 28.2 and 32.2 percent, respectively, while playing for Triple-A Syracuse in 2022.

NOT THIS WAY

Jacksonville starting pitching seemed to find their footing in the middle part of April into May. From April 13-May 5, Jacksonville starters yielded 42 runs, 35 earned on 90 hits (8.2 H/9) in 98.2 innings for a strong 3.19 ERA. However, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have struggled mightily of late. Over their last 16 games, they've combined to surrender 65 runs, 62 earned, on 74 hits (13.1 H/9) in 50.2 innings for a 11.01 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville starters have walked 42 (7.5 BB/9) against only 37 strikeouts (6.6 K/9).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville split their last series with Charlotte back in April. They outscored the Knights 19-8 in the first three games before falling in the final three in games all determined by three runs or fewer... Four of the six games were within three runs.

ABOUT RONALD

-Before coming to the United States, Bolaños played for Mayabeque of the Cuban National Series. He signed with the San Diego Padres as an International free agent on August 11, 2016.

-The Padres selected Bolaños' contract and promoted him to the major leagues for the first time on September 2, 2019. He made his major leagues debut on September 3rd vs. the Arizona Diamondbacks, allowing two runs over six innings pitched.

-On July 16, 2020, Bolaños and outfielder Francy Cordero were traded to the Kansas City Royals in exchange for LHP Tim Hill.

-On April 16, 2023, Bolaños signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins.

-Entering the 2023 season, Bolaños has pitched in 18 major league games, including five starts with Kansas City and San Diego. In those games, he is 0-4 with a 5.25 ERA. Over 48.0 innings, he has yielded 49 hits and struck out 43 against 29 walks.

-When he was signed by San Diego, the then-19-year-old was ranked by MLB.com as the No. 20 international prospect in the 2016 class and ranked by Baseball America as the fourth-best Cuban pitcher available.

-In 2014, he played in the COPABE 18U Pan American Championship in Mexico.

-The Cuban-native came up as an outfielder before converting to a pitcher.

-With Triple-A Omaha, went 0-1 with a 3.52 ERA in four starts. Over 15.1 innings, yielding 17 hits and struck out 16 against four walks.
