### TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express look to get their first win at Constellation Field on Friday night against the Sugar Land Skeeters. Express LHP Wade LeBlanc is set to get the start against Skeeters RHP Joianse Torres. Tonight's first pitch is set for 7:05 p.m.

### ABOUT LAST NIGHT

The Round Rock Express dropped its first ever contest at Constellation Field by a final score of 2-1 to the Sugar Land Skeeters in Thursday's series opener. The two teams combined for just seven hits in the low-scoring contest. The Express scored its solo run in the top of the first inning when CF Leody Taveras found himself in scoring position after hitting a double. Taveras then came home for the 1-0 lead on an RBI single from DH John Hicks. Sugar Land tied the contest at 1-1 in the fourth when CF Bryan De La Cruz hit a solo home run to lead off the inning. The Skeeters took a 2-1 lead in the eighth when LF Ronnie Dawson and 3B Abraham Toro drew consecutive walks before De La Cruz earned his second RBI of the night with a single to score Dawson for the go-ahead run. Express starter LHP Brock Burke struck out seven Skeeters in his 5.0 innings on the mound, allowing three total hits, one run and two walks. Express relievers LHP James Jones and RHP Nick Vincent each threw a scoreless inning, including a three up. three down seventh inning for Vincent.

### LEBLANC GETS THE START

Express LHP Wade LeBlanc is set to get the start in Friday's matchup. In his two starts for Round Rock, the lefty is 1-0 with a 4.09 ERA (5 ER/11.0 IP). He has tallied 11 strikeouts, including eight in his 5.0-inning outing on June 1 in Salt Lake. The veteran has earned a 4.35 ERA (179 ER/370.2 IP) over 96 career Triple-A appearances on the road.

### **BEST OF THE BEST**

Round Rock INF Yonny Hernandez made his first E-Train appearance since May 24 last night after spending time with the Venezuelan National Baseball Team. Despite missing Round Rock's last 13 contests, the shortstop still holds top-five spots in the Triple-A West League rankings in both walks (4th, 18) and stolen bases (T-1st, 9).

### COOLING OFF

Round Rock recorded only three hits against Sugar Land on Friday, marking just the third time this season that the E-Train has tallied three or fewer knocks in a single contest. In the first inning, CF Leody Taveras recorded his fifth double of the season and DH John Hicks earned his 13th RBI with a single. Round Rock's third hit came from LF Delino DeShields in the eighth.

### **CRACKING THE TOP 10**

Express OF Delino DeShields now owns the 10thbest batting average in the Triple-A West League at .327 (32-98) after recording one of Round Rock's three hits on Thursday night. The Maryland native's 19-game hitting streak from May 6-June 1 is tied for the longest among all Triple-A hitters alongside Tacoma's Cal Raleigh, whose 19-game streak began on May 15 and is currently ongoing.

### **BEST OF THE BEST**

Tonight's contest features a battle between the two teams with the lowest ERAs in the Triple-A West League. Sugar Land hurlers currently lead the 10-team circuit with a 3.38 mark (95 ER/253.1 IP) while Round Rock's pitching staff isn't far behind with a 4.68 ERA (140 ER/269.0 IP). The Express also rank second in the league in strikeouts with 322, just nine behind Sacramento's 331.

### TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS

The Round Rock Express announced a pair of roster moves prior to tonight's contest against Sugar Land. C Jack Kruger has joined the Texas Rangers Taxi Squad for the team's road series against the Los Angeles Dodgers. Additionally, OF Flier Hernandez has been added to Round Rock's roster from the Double-A Frisco RoughRiders.

### ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Thirteen members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021: RHP Jason Bahr, OF Carl Chester, RHP Demarcus Evans, C Blake Grant-Parks, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, C Jack Kruger, INF Charles Leblanc, RHP Ryder Ryan, OF Leody Taveras, INF Anderson Tejeda, INF Curtis Terry and RHP Collin Wiles. Interestingly enough, Evans, Taveras and Tejeda all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level. C Jack Kruger also suited up for the Los Angeles Angels in 2021 before making his Triple-A debut with Round Rock in May.

### STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 14 different states: California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Louisiana, Maryland, Nevada, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, Texas, Utah and Virginia. RHP Jake Lemoine is the Ione Texan on the roster, hailing from Bridge City. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

### AROUND THE WORLD

Six different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 22 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, INF Andy Ibáñez was born in Cuba, OF Elier Hernandez and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

### EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and



also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.

An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.


