INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: A pair of two-run shots off the bats of Henry Davis and Malcom Nuñez and a duo of multirun long balls from Matt Gorski helped lead the Indianapolis Indians to a dominant 18-6 victory over the Iowa Cubs on Tuesday night at Principal Park. The Indians got off to a hot start, plating runs in each of the first five frames to mount a 12-3 lead. In the first, Canaan Smith-Njigba hit a leadoff single and scored on a Davis double and fielding error by left fielder Alexander Canario. Liover Peguero later tallied an RBI single. In the next frame, Davis and Nuñez each homered to extend the Indians' advantage. Iowa then committed its fourth and fifth errors of the night on one play in the third, allowing Matt Fraizer to score. The I-Cubs got on the board in the bottom of the third inning with a solo shot by Pete Crow-Armstrong and sacrifice fly by Matt Mervis, but Indy quickly countered in the next half-inning. A sac fly by Peguero and Gorski's first home run of the night, a three-run shot to right field, pushed the Indians' run total to double digits. In the fifth, a walk issued to Nuñez and a single by Peguero loaded the bases, and Fraizer then worked a bases-loaded walk. Iowa got one back in the sixth with a David Bote home run, but Indianapolis countered once more with Gorski's second long ball of the night, a two-run shot to right-center field. The Indians ended the night with a bang, posting a four-run ninth inning highlighted by a Gilberto Celestino run-scoring single.

ABOUT THE SEASON HIGHS, PART II: The Indians set new seasons highs in runs (18) and walks (12), while tying their season high in homers (4, set on Saturday vs. Toledo) in last night's 18-6 victory over the I-Cubs. The Indians previously also set season-highs in hits (18) in Saturday's 16-10 win over the Mud Hens.

ABOUT THE HOME RUNS, PART III: Last night's four-homer output by the Indians offense tied their season-high set on Saturday vs. Toledo. The Indians had two four-homer games during the 2023 season, on May 24 at Columbus and July 14 at Omaha. The four home runs last night, launched by Matt Gorski (2x), Henry Davis and Malcom Nuñez, was Indy's most at Principal Park since launching five home runs on Aug. 7, 2021. That five-homer game came one day after the Indians hit six homers, totalling 11 homers in two games from Aug. 6-7, 2021.

GORSKI GOING OFF: Matt Gorski continued his torrid stretch of home runs last night, launching a pair at Principal Park for his fifth career two-homer game and first since July 4, 2023 with Double-A Altoona vs. Erie. He hit a three-run homer in the fourth inning and a two-run shot in the fifth, totalling a career-high five RBI first set on Saturday vs. Toledo when he launched the longest homer by an Indians batter since Statcast data began being tracked in 2022 and the longest homer in the International League this season (478 ft). Gorski has now homered in three consecutive games since Saturday, his longest home run streak since homering in a career-high four games from May 15-19, 2022, with High-A Greensboro (6), and the longest streak by an Indians batter since Aaron Shackelford homered in three consecutive games from May 25-27, 2023. He has also homered five times in his past six games since May 16 (1).

HENRY HOMERS: Henry Davis launched his fourth home run in his past six games last night at Iowa, going 2-for-5 with a career-high four runs, double, homer, three RBI, two walks and a stolen base. He recorded the first multi-homer performance by an Indians batter on Saturday while driving in a career-high four RBI. Davis has now reached base safely in 11 of his 12 games with Indianapolis since May 7 with the third-most home runs among team leaders (trailing Matt Gorski's 6 and Malcom Nuñez's 5).

MALCOM MASHES: Malcom Nuñez launched his fifth home run of the season last night while going 2-for-3 with three runs, two RBI and three walks at Principal Park. After having his 16-game on-base streak snapped in Game 1 of Sunday's doubleheader, Nuñez has hit safely in his last two games. He now has the second-most home runs among Indians batters, trailing Matt Gorski's six. In 39 games this season, Nuñez is over halfway to his 2023 season total of eight home runs (78 games between FCL Pirates, Single-A Bradenton, High-A Greensboro and Indianapolis).

CELESTINO STAYS HOT: Gilberto Celestino went 2-for-6 with a run and RBI in last night's victory, marking his second consecutive multi-hit game and his fifth such performance in 12 games since May 3. In that time, he owns a .357 batting average (15-for-42) with eight runs, two doubles, three RBI and three stolen bases. He has reached base safely in 12 of 13 games in May this season and is now hitting .280 (35-for-125) in 36 games with Indianapolis this season.

JAKE ON BASE: Jake Lamb extended his current on-base streak to 22 games since April 18 with a single and two runs scored last night at Iowa. During that streak – which narrowly bests Nick Gonzales' 21-game streak as the longest by an Indians batter this season and is tied for the third-longest in the International League this season – he is hitting .329 (26-for-79) with 14 runs, nine doubles, one home run, 17 RBI, .412 on-base percentage and .893 OPS. He has now reached base safely in 32 of 33 games this season with a .331 batting average (39-for-118), 18 runs, 10 doubles, three homers, 23 RBI and 20 walks.

TODAY: The Indians continue their six-game series against the I-Cubs – their first of three this season – today at 1:08 PM ET at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa after an offensive outpouring in the series opener. The Indians went 10-14 against Iowa last season, logging a 3-9 record in two series on the road. Continuing the series for Indianapolis today in the afternoon contests will be LHP Cam Aildred (1-3, 6.82), making his 12th career appearance (fourth start) against Iowa in his career. Countering for the I-Cubs is RHP Cade Horton (1-1, 8.25) in his first career start against Indianapolis.

THIS DATE IN 1977: Paul Moskau pitched 7.0 innings of one-hit ball while scattering four walks with five strikeouts in a 3-0 win over Omaha at Bush Stadium. Reliever Joe Henderson finished up the game with 2.0 hitless innings. Ron Dester gave Indy the lead with a solo home run in the second inning, and Arturo DeFreites clubbed a two-run shot in the fifth to cap the scoring.

TODAY'S PITCHER

Cam Aldred: Southpaw Cam Aldred is set to make his ninth start of the season today at Iowa.

Last Outing: Aldred took the bump on May 16 (1) vs. Toledo and allowed three runs over 4.1 innings to take a no-decision. He also fanned a season-high seven batters.

Against the I-Cubs: Aldred has made 11 career appearances (three starts) against Iowa dating back to 2022, going 1-3 with a 4.26 ERA (12er/25.1ip) and 25 strikeouts.

Cam is the Man: Cam Aldred spent the 2023 season as the Indians' ultimate go-to man, making 17 starts and 14 appearances out of the bullpen. He recorded his first career quality start on 6/16 at Iowa (6.0ip, 2r) to kick off a stretch of three consecutive such starts and four total on the season. He went 3-7 with a 4.44 ERA (39er/79.0ip) and 74 strikeouts as a starter and 5-1 with a 7.43 ERA (22er/26.2ip) and 24 strikeouts in relief.

Miscellaneous: Selected by Pittsburgh in the 24th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft ... Fanned a career-high eight batters for the first time at Louisville on 6/29/23 ... Made his major league debut on 5/12/22 vs. Cincinnati.
