**PAPILLION, NEB.** – In a back-and-forth affair, the Storm Chasers stole game three of this week's series on a walk-off against the Indians, winning 5-4 Thursday at Werner Park.

- Indianapolis opened up with a lead from the start, as Ji Hwan Bae led off the game with a home run to left field to put the Indians up 1-0 just five pitches into the game.
- Omaha tied things in the bottom of the 2nd inning, as Tyler Gentry drove in his first of two runs on the night with an infield single to third base, beating out the throw to first to plate Logan Porter and tie the game up 1-1.
- The Indians punched in the bottom of the 3rd inning with another home run, this time off the bat of Jake Lamb for a 2-1 lead ... That was the final run Storm Chasers starter Luis Cessa allowed, as he worked through a season-high four innings and struck out one, before handing the ball off to Walter Pennington for the 5th inning.
- Pennington led the staff with four strikeouts as he worked two scoreless innings, to keep Omaha in the game through the middle innings.
- Gentry re-tired the game in the bottom of the 6th inning, with a two-out single to right field that plated CJ Alexander and move the score to 2-2.
- Dan Altavilla took over in the 7th inning and pitched into the 8th, retiring all five batters he faced in 1.2 perfect innings, with two strikeouts.
- Sam Long came on for the final out of the 8th inning, before returning to the mound for the 9th ... One out away from sending the game to the bottom of the ninth, Indianapolis re-took the lead on an RBI triple from Matt Gorski past the dive of Nate Eaton, then Gorski scored a run of insurance, crossing on an Omaha error.
- Down by two going into the bottom of the ninth, Nick Loftin opened the inning with a single, then Logan Porter drew a one-out walk to bring the winning run to the plate ... Alexander singled in a Loftin to move pinch-runner Drew Waters to third, then Devin Mann laid down a sacrifice bunt that scored Waters from third to tie the game at 4-4.
- With two outs, Gentry collected his third hit of the game with a single to the left side, but a fielding error from Indianapolis shortstop Liover Peguero allowed Alexander to round third and score, winning the game for Omaha 5-4.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### RAIN, RAIN, GO AWAY!

Omaha's last FOUR (4) games have been rained out ... today marks Omaha's first game in SIX (6) days, the team last played on Thursday, April 25, what was the third game of a series against Indianapolis.

- Last night's game in Iowa was rained out, as were the last 3 games of last week's series against Indianapolis ... a doubleheader is being played today to make up yesterday's rainout, but dates have not been set for last week's games, though any games made up will likely be when Omaha travels to Victory Field May 27 to June 2.
- 5 rainouts already this season nearly matches last season's total ... in 2023, Omaha had 5 games cancelled, with an additional game rained out and made up.
- This was the first time since 2005 that the Triple-A Omaha franchise has had 4 straight games postponed/cancelled ... since 2005, Omaha have had 3 instances where a game was postponed, then a makeup doubleheader was not played ... 6 times since 2005, Omaha has had back-to-back games rained out, but never more than 2.

#### DOUBLE TROUBLE

Today will be the second doubleheader Omaha has played in 2024 ... the team played just one doubleheader last year, on July 2 vs. Iowa and split it (1-1 Win & 6-2 Loss).

- The Storm Chasers split a doubleheader with Columbus on April 4, losing Game 1 3-0 before bouncing back in Game 2 with a 5-4 win.
- Omaha has won or split its last 12 doubleheaders, dating back to May 2019 ... the Chasers have won or split their last 7 road doubleheaders ... the last time the Storm Chasers were swept in a doubleheader was May 22, 2019 vs. Iowa, 5-3 and 6-3 losses at Werner Park ... the last time Omaha was swept in a road doubleheader was August 8, 2017 @ Memphis, 3-1 and 4-2 losses.

#### RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.

- Omaha's 3.78 ERA (48 ER in 114.1 IP) ranks 3rd out of the 20-team International League and 4th among the 30 Triple-A teams ... The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a .200 average (83-for-416), which is also the 3rd-best mark among Triple-A teams, as does a .650 OPS against Omaha's relievers.
- Will Klein was called up last Thursday by the Royals and made his MLB debut Sunday ... he opened the year with 11.0 innings without allowing an earned run.
- Walter Pennington leads the bullpen with a 7.0-inning scoreless streak currently over his last 4 games since April 16 ... Dan Altavilla and Evan Sisk have each recorded back-to-back scoreless games.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 140 to 114 this season, a +26 run differential.

- A +26 run differential ranks as the 3rd-best in the International League and 6th in Triple-A ... Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (NYY) leads the IL at +36 while Sugar Land (HOU) leads the Triple-A level with a +46 run differential.
