TODAY'S GAMES: Sugar Land continues their six-game set with the Round Rock Express trailing the series 3-1 This is Game 11 of 12 in a row for the Space Cowboys heading into the Major League All-Star Break
ABOUT FRIDAY NIGHT: Justin Foscue hit a solo homer in the 1st and a three-run shot in the 2nd to open a 4-0 Express lead... Sugar Land was limited to just four hits, all singles, and scored their lone run in the 5th on a wild pitch that brought home Rylan Bannon... Round Rock added on additional runs in the 4th, 5th and 7th in a 9-1 win over the Space Cowboys.
ROSTER MOVES: 7/8-RHP Joel Kuhnel recalled by Houston... C Korey Lee placed on the IL, retro to 7/7.. RHP Ronel Blanco optioned to Sugar Land... 7/7-RHP Joe Record placed on the IL, retro to 7/6... 7/6-RHP Jimmy Endersby reinstated from the Dev. List... OF Alex McKenna reinstated from the Dev. List... RHP Ronel Blanco recalled by Houston... INF David Hensley recalled by Houston.
HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's active roster has 11 players drafted by the Astros and 7 international signings

PROSPECTING: The Space Cowboys active roster boasts six of the Astros' Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline. They include OF Pedro León (\#6), RHP Spencer Arrighetti (\#9), RHP Misael Tamarez (\#11), INF Joe Perez (\#14), OF Quincy Hamilton (\#22) \& RHP Shawn Dubin (\#23)
SERIES-OUSLY SPEAKING: Sugar Land is 4-8-0 in six-game series this year, 0-1 in seven-game series and 1-0 in three-game series... The Space Cowboys have gone $2-2-0$ in their last four home series and 2-4-0 overall at Constellation Field.
RIDE THE BIKE, PEDROI: On 6/24, Pedro León hit for the cycle in reverse order, homering in the 3rd, tripling in the 5th, doubling in the 7th and singling in the 8th... It is the first cycle in Space Cowboys history and the first for León at any level in his career... The La Habana native also reached on a walk and a hit by pitch and scored all six times he reached, setting a new single-game record for runs scored in Space Cowboys history.

In the month of June, León was 2nd in the PCL in Runs Scored (25), 4th in OPS (1.095) \& 5th in SIg (.658)
THREE-BY-THREE: Marty Costes tripled in each of his first two at bats on Wednesday night... It was the first three-bagger for Costes since August 26, 2021 and the first game where he has recorded two triples in his career, professionally or collegiately... It's the second time this season and second time in franchise history a Space Cowboys' hitter has recorded two triples in a game after JJ Matijevic had a pair of three-sackers on May 2 at Albuquerque.
BEGINNING AND END-ERSBY: Over his last 7 appearances, RHP Jimmy Endersby has allowed just 3 runs in 14.0 innings of work, striking out 10 in that stretch while recording a 1.93 ERA... The righty has thrown more than 1.0 inning in six of those seven and gone at least 2.0 innings in five of his last seven outings.

## Upcoming Probable Pitchers.

WHIT-BOMB: Shay Whitcomb has brought his power to the Space Cowboys, launching nine home runs in his first 25 contests at Triple-A in which he has batted, including a three-run homer on Wednesday night... The three-run homer was his fourth three-run homer with the Space Cowboys, along with a pair of two-run homers and just three solo shots.

Whitcomb has 21 home runs between Double-A and Triple-A, tied for the third most home runs in Minor League Baseball.

The Space Cowboys infielder is also leading the way in the Astros' organization in home runs, RBI (57), Extra-Base Hits (33), Total Bases (153) \& Runs (53) \& 2nd in Hits (78)
WHAT'S YOUR NAME, MAN?: In his Triple-A debut on 6/7, Quincy Hamilton homered in each of his first two times up, launching an opposite-field homer to left in the 2nd and a solo home run to right in the 4th... Hamilton provided an encore on $6 / 8$, hitting a solo home run in the 7 th inning, and homered for a third straight game on 6/10 with a solo shot in the 8th.

Hamilton had his 11-game hitting streak snapped on Sunday night, but has still reached in 18 of his 19 games with Sugar Land this season.
ON THE RECORD: RHP Joe Record locked down his 10th save on $6 / 20$, throwing a 1-2-3 ninth... Record is tied for fourth in MiLB in saves with 10, and since he logged his first save on May 4, Record's 10 saves are tied for the lead in Minor League Baseball... In 25 of his 31 appearances, Record has not allowed an earned run...His 10 saves are the second most in the PCL, and Record is tied for the Pacific Coast League lead with 31 appearances and tied for sixth in Minor League Baseball in appearances.
SINGLETON AND THE 'STROS: INF Jon Singleton was signed to a Minor League contract by Houston on 6/24 and made his Space Cowboys debut that night... It was the first game Singleton has played in the Astros' organization since $9 / 4 / 17$... As the designated hitter, Singleton reached five times, knocking an RBI double and a two-run homer with three walks and three runs scored... In his first 11 games, Singleton 13 -for- 36 with 2 doubles, 4 home runs, 12 RBI, 9 runs scored and 11 walks, reaching safely in all 11 games with the Space Cowboys.
STREAK SNAPPED: By not recording an extra-base hit on 6/28, the Space Cowboys had their 68 game streak snapped with at least one extra-base hit... It was the second-longest streak in MiLB this season... Since their streak was snagged, Sugar Land has been held without an extra-base hit on two other occasions, Monday night vs. OKC and Friday night.

WHAT A WEEK: The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from 5/2-5/7, hitting . 395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. Here is how their offensive output ranked compared to every other single-week high among full season MiLB teams.

RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ: On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a 24-8 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30
- Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
- Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Korey Lee - 6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate.... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) \& at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, $5 / 4$.

GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN: Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on $5 / 4$ against ABQ, going 4 -for- 5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: In the seventh inning on $5 / 5$ @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on 5/13 \& 5/17 (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

MATIJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT: On 5/2 @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5 -for- 6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on $5 / 7$, Korey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as "Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV. Garrett Greene begins his first year as the 'Voice of the Space Cowboys' and will be on the call for all game, home and away. He'll be joined by longtime Houston area broadcaster Gerald Sanchez for home games.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in ' 16 and ' 18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its ' 13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.


LAST TIME OUT: Turned in a quality outing on Monday night against Oklahoma City, hurling a season-high 7.0 innings, giving up three earned runs, four total... Struck out the side in the first and retired the first five in a row before giving up a solo home run... Gave up one run in the 4th on a passed ball and allowed his only other two runs in the top of the 6th... Threw 103 pitches, 67 strikes, for a $65 \%$ strike percentage... Did not receive any run support in a 5-2 Space Cowboys defeat... McGowin's 7.0 innings is the longest outing by any Sugar Land pitcher this year.

AGAINST ROUND ROCK: Making his second start of the season against the Express... In his only other outing on June 3, gave up seven runs, six earned, recording just one out... Had one inherited runner score in the Express' 11run first inning.

WELCOME TO THE 'STROS: Signed by the Astros as a free agent on May 8 and assigned to Sugar Land... Had elected free agency following the 2021 season, did not pitch in 2022.

QUITE AN IMPRESSION: Was the opening day starter for the Staten Island FerryHawks of the independent Atlantic League on April 28, 2023 against the Charleston Dirty Birds... Threw 5.0 hitless innings, allowing just one base runner on a hit-by-pitch.... Struck out 11 on 67 pitches, 49 strikes.

IN THE CARDS: Owner of "World Champion Sports Cards." Helped organize the first ever Palm Beach Card Show at the Palm Beach Convention Center in January of 2023.

WITH THE NATIONALS: Has made 48 career appearances, two starts, at the Major League level... Amassed a career ERA of 5.98 with two holds and two save in two save chances... Across 64.2 innings with Washington, walked 28 and struck out 77, holding opponents to a .231 batting average against.

DEBUT SZN: Made his Major League debut with the Nationals on September 5, 2018... Appeared in five games, one start, going 0-0, 5.87 ERA in 7.2 innings.

MR. McGOWIN GOES TO WASHINGTON: Traded from the Angels to the Nationals, along with RHP Austin Adams, in exchange for 2B Danny Espinosa on 12/10/2016... At the time of the trade, was rated as the \#20 prospect in the Angels organization by MLB.com

PCL PRIOR EXPERIENCE: Made 22 starts with the Salt Lake Bees in 2016, going 6-12 with a 6.11 ERA, hurling 116.1 innings.... Also made 11 starts for Triple-A Fresno in 2019, going 7-2 with a 3.86 ERA.
