#### LAST TIME OUT...

**MOOSIC, Pa. (June 18, 2021)** – For the third time in four games, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders came from behind late to defeat the Syracuse Mets 7-5 on Friday night at PNC Field. SWB has won the first four games of the series with Syracuse, and has won six straight overall.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre took a 1-0 lead in the bottom of the second when Derek Dietrich blasted a towering opposite-field home run into the bullpen in left. Dietrich finished the game 1-for-2 with a home run and was hit by a pitch twice.

In the bottom of the fourth, the RailRiders tacked on two more on a two-run single by Rob Brantly to take a 3-0 lead. Meanwhile, Nick Nelson was strong, working around five hits in 4.1 innings in his second start of the season for the RailRiders. He struck out four and did not issue a walk. Syracuse struck back in the top of the fifth, however, taking a 4-3 lead when Travis Blankenhorn connected for a grand slam off Adam Warren. The slam came on the first pitch following a 22-minute rain delay.

The RailRiders evened the ledger in the bottom of the sixth when Brantly blasted a solo home run off Bradley Roney to tie the game at 4-4. The round-tripper was Brantly's fourth of the season, and his second in the last three days. In the top of the seventh the Mets regained the lead on a solo home run from MLB rehabber Jeff McNeil off Braden Bristo. That represented the first run allowed by Bristo (4-0) this season in 19.0 innings of work.

However, with two outs in the bottom of the seventh, Greg Allen slammed a two-run home run to right field off Roney (0-2) to put the RailRiders back in front. Trey Amburgey added an RBI double in the frame and SWB took a 7-5 advantage.

Albert Abreu threw 2.0 scoreless innings of relief to close out the win and earn his first save of the season. The right-hander fanned five straight Mets at one point, before coaxing a fly out for the final out of the contest.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**FOR MY NEXT (DIE)TRICH:** When play began on June 6, SWB infielder **Derek Dietrich** was hitting only .119/.316/.237, and had endured an 0-for-27 skid to end the month of May. However, beginning with a 1-for-2 performance against Lehigh Valley that night, Dietrich has found success at the plate in his last 10 games, batting .320/.469/.600 (8-for-25) with 6 R, 1 2B, 2 HR, and 8 RBIs. The run of success at the bat has improved his season batting line to .179/.361/.345, a 153-point leap in OPS.

**ALL ABOARD THE TREY TRAIN:** RailRiders outfielder **Trey Amburgey** had his 18-game hitting streak snapped on Tuesday night, when he went 0-for-2 with a walk and two RBIs against the Mets. The 18-game streak is the longest for any one player in Triple-A East this season, and was actually a 20-game streak dating back to the final two games of the 2019 season. Despite the hit streak ending, Amburgey extended his on-base streak to an impressive 29 consecutive games dating back to August 26, 2019. He is hitting .379/.445/.680 (39-for-103) in that span. The SWB franchise record for longest on-base streak belongs to **Brandon Drury**, who reached base in 32 straight games in the 2018 season.

**OTHER STREAKS OF NOTE:** In addition to Trey Amburgey's impressive run, the RailRiders offense features two other players with double-digit on-base streaks. Outfielder **Greg Allen** is riding a season-long 16-game on-base streak into play on Sunday afternoon, and infielder **Hoy Park** has reached base safely in 17 consecutive games. Allen has also played in two other games this season in which he did not record an official plate appearance, therefore not jeopardizing his streak and spent time on the injured list in the middle of his streak. Park sports an absurd .562 OBP during his streak, which has propelled him to the Triple-A East lead in OBP (.514) and OPS (1.156), and is second in the league in AVG (.358) and SLG (.642). The infielder also ranks 3rd in Triple-A East in walks (25), trailing only Nolan Jones of Columbus and Worcester's Marcus Wilson (27).

**OH WHAT A RELIEF IT IS!:** Since **Kyle Barraclough** relieved **Albert Abreu** in the sixth inning of the RailRiders game at Buffalo on Friday, June 11, the SWB bullpen has performed at an amazing clip. In the last eight days, the bullpen has combined for a 1.78 ERA (7 ER/35.1 IP), while allowing just 23 hits, 10 walks and 41 strikeouts. The current stretch has lowered SWB's bullpen ERA to 3.10 on the season, the 11th-best in all of minor league baseball, and fourth-best in Triple-A East (Buffalo, 2.46). RailRiders closer **Luis García** leads all minor leaguers with 11 saves on the season.

**MEET THE METS:** For the first time since the opening series of the season, the RailRiders take on the Syracuse Mets in a six-game series at PNC Field this week. After losing on opening night, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre reeled off five straight wins to close the series at NBT Bank Stadium in an impressive offensive showing. The Baby Bombers hit .306 AVG/.426 OBP/.578 SLG in that series, slugging 15 home runs and scoring at least 10 runs in a game twice. The RailRiders and Mets also played the longest game in SWB franchise history in a 4-hour, 9-minute marathon on May 6, a 17-11 final. Unbelievably, that was the first of two four-hour games in that series (also May 9) and one of four four-hour games that SWB has played this season.

**BEAT THE METS:** PNC Field is quickly turning into a house of horrors for the Syracuse Mets. Before Thursday's wire-to-wire win for the RailRiders, the team had erased multi-run deficits to defeat Syracuse in each of the last three games the Mets played here (Game 141 of the 2019 regular season and the first two games of this series). The Syracuse bullpen was particularly battered in those contests, pitching to the tune of a 19.17 ERA (25 R, 22 ER/10.1 IP), on 22 H, 11 BB, and 8 K. In the current series, the Mets bullpen has blown three saves in four games. Under the Mets affiliation (2019 - Present), Syracuse is just 2-11 at PNC Field, and has lost 10 straight to SWB in Moosic.

**COMEBACK KIDS:** The RailRiders erased multi-run deficits four times en route to victory in their last 10 games. On Tuesday, they trailed 5-0 and eventually won 7-5, with a two-run single from **Derek Dietrich** in the top of the eighth putting SWB ahead for good. Then on Saturday, the RailRiders erased an early 4-0 advantage to win 6-4 in 10 innings. **Andrew Velazquez** put the RailRiders on top in the 10th inning when he scampered home on a wild pitch. On Tuesday at PNC Field, the RailRiders overcame an early 5-0 deficit to win 12-6 and Wednesday trailed 5-2 in the fifth before a 10-inning walk-off win. Overall, the RailRiders have 13 come-from-behind wins this season, with five of those comebacks being completed in the seventh-inning or later.

**2021 PRESEASON PROSPECT RANKINGS:** Baseball America - NYY #2, MLB #47 (NYY #3, MLB #82 in mid-season update); MLB Pipeline - NYY #3, MLB #90; FanGraphs - NYY #2, MLB #60

**LAST TIME OUT:** On Tuesday, Deivi García had the shortest start of his professional career, lasting only 0.1 innings against the Syracuse Mets. The right-hander walked four and allowed five runs on two hits, including a Travis Blankenhorn home run. It was the third time this season with the RailRiders and the second straight outing in which the right-hander allowed five earned runs. The start on Tuesday also marked the first time in Deivi's career that he failed to complete at least one inning in a start.

**RECORD SETTING ROOKIE:** Deivi García made his big-league debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader on 8/30/2020 against the New York Mets (6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 0 BB, 6 K). He became just the 10th Yankee since 1935 and the first since 1992 to throw at least 6.0 IP and not allow an earned run in his MLB debut. García went on to become just the second pitcher in Yankees history with at least 6 K and no more than 2 BB in each of his first four big league appearances (Masahiro Tanaka, 2014). He did this while being the youngest pitcher (21 year, 103 days) to start a game for the Yankees since Phil Hughes (21 years, 95 days in 2007), and the second-youngest player to start a game in the majors in 2020 (Luis Patiño, SD; 20 years, 329 days). The right-hander capped off the season by starting Game 2 of the ALDS against Tampa Bay, and became the youngest pitcher (21 years, 140 days) ever to start a postseason game for the Yankees (previous: Whitey Ford, 1950 World Series Game 4; 21 years, 351 days).

**2021 HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Began the season at the Yankees Alternate Training Site, recalled by Yankees for a spot start on 4/26.
- Optioned to the Yankees Alternate Training Site on 4/27 and assigned to RailRiders Opening Day roster on 4/30.
- Named Triple-A East Pitcher of the Week for 5/10-16 (1-0, 10.0 IP, 5.0 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 16 K), the first weekly award for an SWB pitcher since Jonathan Holder in 2016 (8/22-28).

**PERSONAL:**

- Launched a new Instagram account dedicated to showcasing his artwork "@drawings\_deivi83".
- Full name is Deivi Anderson García.
- Watches the same 5-minute clip of his idol Pedro Martinez from the 1999 All-Star Game before each of his starts.
- Credits his Father for a lot of his success, he was the first one to teach him a curveball and made countless sacrifices for him to attend tryouts. His mother was a doctor who gave up her career to focus on raising her children.
- Grew up wanting to play shortstop, began pitching when he went to tryouts as a 15-year-old and scouts had him work out on the mound.
- Younger brother, Andres Garcia, is a prospect in the Toronto Blue Jays organization. He most recently played for the DSL Blue Jays in 2019.
- Pitched in the 2019 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Progressive Field in Cleveland, and was promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre for the first time after the game.
