YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Senators, 5-2, for their fourth straight win. John Michael Bertrand threw six scoreless innings, his league-leading eighth scoreless start of the year. The Flying Squirrels broke a scoreless tie with five runs in the fifth inning. Andy Thomas opened the scoring with an RBI single, Alerick Soularie brought in a run with a sacrifice fly, Luis Toribio hit an RBI single, Andrew Kachel singled in a run for his first Double-A hit and Will Wilson capped the five-run frame with an RBI single. The Senators broke the shutout with a run scoring on an error and Onix Vega added a sacrifice fly. Eric Silva closed out his second save of the year, striking out the side in order in the ninth.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, in the fourth of a six-game series. The series marks the Senators' only trip to The Diamond this year. The Flying Squirrels played a six-game series in Harrisburg from April 16-21, going 3-3. Richmond returns to Harrisburg for six games from August 13-18.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won four consecutive games. They went 3-3 last week against the Baysox. They dropped four straight games to open the second half the previous week after going 7-2 in their previous nine games and 8-4 on their last 12-game road trip to New Hampshire and Portland. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .228 and averaging 3.91 runs per game (164 runs/42 games) at home compared to a .237 batting average and 4.93 runs per game on the road (202 runs/42 games). Richmond is 5-11 in its last 16 home games dating back to June 6, but has won four straight since Saturday.

**THE SENATORS** are 3-12 to open the second half after finishing second in the Southwest Division in the first half, one game behind Erie. Harrisburg has lost seven straight games and has gone 4-16 over its last 20 games since June 19. On the season, the Senators offense ranks last in the Eastern League in batting average (.219), OBP (.301), SLG (.325) and OPS (.626). Harrisburg's pitching staff ranks third in the league in ERA (3.43). Harrisburg's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF Daylen Lile (No. 10), RHP Andy Lara (No. 14), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 18), RHP Zach Bryzykcy (No. 19) and SS Kevin Made (No. 23). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospect list includes even Harrisburg players, including Lile (No. 6), Pinckney (No. 16), Brzykcy (No. 17), Made (No. 18), C Israel Pineda (No. 21), Lara (No. 27) and RHP Marquis Grissom (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Nick Sinacola makes his seventh Double-A start. Last time out, he pitched five innings and allowed one run on Thursday against the Baysox on Independence Day at The Diamond. After allowing five runs in his Double-A debut on June 6, he has gone 3-0 with a 1.33 ERA (4 ER/270 IP) in his last five starts dating back to June 12. Sinacola leads all full-season Giants minor league pitchers in ERA (2.64) and WHIP (0.93). He is also tied for first in wins (7), second in BAA (.206), ninth in innings pitched (71.2) and tied for ninth in strikeouts (74). He began the season with High-A Eugene and went 4-1 with a 2.68 ERA in 10 outings, including two starts. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Sinacola ranked second among Northwest League pitchers (min. 40 IP) in WHIP (0.79), third in BB/9 (1.56), third in BAA (190), ninth in ERA (2.68), and 10th in K/9 (8.48). He spent the entire 2023 season with the Emeralds and went 2-5 with a 4.58 ERA over 23 outings (20 starts). Sinacola was selected by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine, where he was the America East Pitcher of the Year that season as a senior. FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Andry Lara makes his 10th Double-A start and his first against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Thursday at Altoona and allowed one run over six innings but got charged with a loss. He began the season with High-A Wilmington and went 2-4 with a 2.35 ERA in six starts before being promoted to Double-A on May 14. Lara signed with the Nationals as an international free agent in 2019. He spent all of last year in the South Atlantic League with Wilmington and went 6-8 with a 4.58 ERA in 23 starts.

**BLANK SPACE:** On Wednesday, the Flying Squirrels pitched their 10th shutout of the season, beating the Senators, 5-0. The 10 shutouts are the second-most in the Eastern League, trailing only 11 by Akron. Erie and Harrisburg each have nine. It is also the most shutouts in a season for the Flying Squirrels since they had 12 in 2016.

**CARTER'S CRUISING:** Dating back to June 13 in 20 games, **Carter Howell** is batting .313 (26-for-83) with eight doubles, two triples and 16 RBIs. In that stretch, he has picked up three hits three times and he has two hits in three-of-his-last-eight games. His four triples are tied for the second-most in the Eastern League this season. He is also tied for third in doubles (19) and tied for 10th in hits (74).

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 27 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .363 (41-for-113) with three homers, seven doubles, seven walks and 15 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland. In his last 37 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .338 (49-for-145) with six homers, eight doubles, 13 walks and 24 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 11-of-19 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .385 (30-for-78) in that stretch. He is currently riding a 10-game hit streak since June 29, the third-longest active streak in the league. Earlier this season, his 11-game hit streak was the longest on the team this year.

**TO THE MUNGUIA:** Since being assigned to Richmond on June 19, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .317 (19-for-60) and has added four stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 12 of his 14 games played, including a three-hit game and five two-hit games. Last Monday at Bowie, he hit his first Richmond homer of the year, a two-run shot. He played 50 games with Triple-A Sacramento to open the year and batted .250 (36-for-144) in the Pacific Coast League. Munguia played 75 games for the Flying Squirrels last year and hit .282 (83-for-294), which led the team (min. 200 PA).

**POMARES POWER:** Jairo Pomares homered three times over a five-game stretch from June 28-July 3. On the year, he leads the Flying Squirrels and ranks fourth in the Giants system in homers (10). Pomares missed the start of the season with an injury and joined the Flying Squirrels for his Double-A debut on May 5. Since then, his 10 homers are tied for fourth in the Eastern League, trailing only 12 homers by Binghamton's Ryan Clifford and 11 home runs by Erie's Hao-Yu Lee and Chris Meyers. For Pomares, his 18.5 PA/HR is the third-best in a season in franchise history (min. 150 PA), trailing only **Sean Roby** (14.12) in 2022 when he set the single-season franchise record with 25 home runs in his 89 games and **Will Wilson** (18.25) that same year.

SCORELESS WORK FROM SILVA: Reliever Eric Silva has thrown seven consecutive appearances dating back to June 19 without allowing a run, spanning 9.2 innings. He has 13 strikeouts in that time frame. That span has lowered his season ERA from 6.41 to 4.71. Since throwing an immaculate inning on June 9 against the Curve, Silva has gone 3-0 with a 1.35 ERA (2 ER/13.1 IP) with 18 strikeouts and four walks. Earlier this season, Silva threw six consecutive scoreless outings from May 1-21, spanning 9.2 innings with 10 strikeouts. Over his next six outings prior to his current scoreless streak, he posted a 10.38 ERA (10 ER/8.2 IP) from May 26-June 14. On Thursday night against the Senators, he closed his second save of the year, striking out the side in order in the ninth.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked seventh among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,789), outpacing the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 10), RHP Trevor McDonald (No. 18), RHP Eric Silva (No. 20), C Adrián Sugastey (No. 23) and RHP José Cruz (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including McDonald (No. 12), Brown (No. 15), OF Victor Bericoto (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

SHINING STARS: Major League Baseball announced the full 2024 All-Star Game rosters on Sunday night and two former Flying Squirrels, outfielder Heliot Ramos and pitcher Logan Webb, were both selected for the first time in their careers. Webb, who pitched 14 games for Richmond in 2018 and 2019, became the first former Flying Squirrels pitcher to be selected as an MLB All-Star. With Richmond, Webb went 2-6 with a 2.88 ERA in his two seasons and was the team's Opening Day starter in 2019. Ramos, who joined the Flying Squirrels at age 19 in 2019, then the youngest player in franchise history, went on to play 87 games with Richmond across the 2019 and 2021 seasons, batting .239 with 13 homers and 41 RBIs. The pair marked the first former Flying Squirrels to be selected as MLB All-Stars since 2021. They became the fifth and sixth Flying Squirrels alumni to earn MLB All-Star selections, joining Brandon Crawford (2015, 2018, 2021), Joe Panik (2015), Brandon Belt (2016) and Adam Duvall 2016). The 2024 MLB All-Star Game will next Tuesday at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas at 8 p.m.
