Worcester Red Sox RHP Brian Van Belle (0-1, 7.27) vs. Toledo Mud Hens LHP Brant Hunter (0-1, 4.50)

One Game at a Time – The Worcester Red Sox and the Toledo Mud Hens (AAA-Detroit) play game three of their 6-game series tonight at 6:35 pm at Fifth Third Field in downtown Toledo (on NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network). After having the series-opener on Tuesday rained out, the clubs played a make-up doubleheader yesterday with the Mud Hens sweeping both games by scores of 5-3 and 3-2.

Double Whammy - For the WooSox, yesterday's two losses marked the second time in five days they were swept in a doubleheader following Saturday's twin bill sweep at home at the hands of the Durham Bulls (12-2 and 4-3 defeats). Worcester had gone almost a full year – and 10 consecutive doubleheaders - without suffering a doubleheader sweep (since April 23 of last year at Lehigh Valley) until being dealt double dips twice now in less than a week. The Sox hope to not have another doubleheader until they play a makeup pair on May 8 in Buffalo (from an April 4th postponement at Polar Park).

Holy Toledo! - Toledo and Worcester have played 13 times since first meeting on May 3, 2022 and the Mud Hens have won 9 of those 13 games including a 5-2 mark here at Fifth Third Field. This is Worcester's second-ever trip to Toledo (and to Ohio for that matter) with the other coming almost two years ago when the Sox dropped 4 of 6 to the Hens here at Fifth Third Field from May 3-8, 2022. These two teams (in name only) also met for another 6-game series during the 2022 season – that coming from June 14-19, 2022 with Toledo again taking 4 of 6 from the WooSox.

Homefield Advantage – The Mud Hens own one of the best home records in the league this season going 9-2 at Fifth Third Field in Toledo. The WooSox are 4-7 on the road thus far. Worcester is 5-6 at home at Polar Park.

This Series – This 6-game series features different start times each day or night. Tonight at 6:35 pm, tomorrow is at 7:05 pm, Saturday at 5:05 pm, and Sunday at 2:05 pm. After Sunday's game the WooSox will fly back to Boston, take Monday off, and then start a 6-game series and homestand at Polar Park vs. Lehigh Valley from Tuesday, April 30 – Sunday, May 5.

Night Moves – Tonight's 6:35 pm start time is just the ninth night game for the WooSox this season. They are 2-6 in the evening compared to 7-7 in day games thus far.

Ten Four – Worcester is 5-5 in their last 10 games. They had a season-high 4-game winning streak (from Game 2 on April 14 – April 19) that came immediately on the heels of a 4-game losing skid (April 10 – Game 1 on April 14).

Series Math – Worcester – down 0-2 in this 6-game set here in Toledo - is 2-2-0 in their first four series of 2024. They finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The WooSox went 8-3-2 in their 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

Hit Me With Your Best Shot – Sox batters are 2nd in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 20 times this season. Jacksonville leads with 21 HBP on the season.

Rankings – Worcester is 17th in the IL in team batting while Toledo is 12th at .251. On the pitching side, the Sox are 14th in team ERA (5.31) while the Mud Hens are 5th with a 4.32 ERA.

A Winning Tradition – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

Finish Line – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7th-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1st half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2nd half. This season, for the second time ever, the IL will again invoke a split season with the first half starting tonight and ending on June 23 while the second half will run from June 25 – September 22.

Month to Month – Worcester went 12-14 last March/April, 13-14 in May, then had three straight winning months going 16-9 in June, 13-10 in July, and 16-11 in August, before finishing 9-10 in September.

Seven Days a Week – The WooSox were 0-1 on Monday last season, went 9-12 on Tuesdays, 11-11 on Wednesdays, 12-13 on Thursdays, 14-12 on Fridays, 20-6 on Saturdays, and 14-13 on Sundays in 2023.

We Interrupt This Program – Worcester had a total of 14 games either postponed (11) or canceled (3) last year due to weather. They have had five postponements thus far this season (three at home and two on the road).

You Need a Scorecard – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS UPDATE – The Portland Sea Dogs (10-5) won for the 10th time in their last 12 games with a 7-4 victory at Hartford last night. Marcelo Mayer fell a triple shy of the cycle as he hit a solo HR (#2) in the 2nd-inning, singled and scored in the 3rd, and doubled and scored in the 4th-inning. Nick Yorke crushed a 3-run HR (#2) and Nick Decker drilled a solo shot (#2). Wyatt Olds was the winner with 2 scoreless innings of relief while Felix Cepeda worked the final two scoreless for his 4th save of the season.

RED SOX REHABBER WITH WOOSOX - Vaughn Grissom, who has been on the Boston Red Sox injured list since March 25 after suffering a left hamstring strain earlier during spring training, began a 20-day injury rehab assignment with the WooSox on April 12. In 6 games (3 as the DH and 3 at 2B) he is 4-for-18 with a double, 3 walks, a HBP, and 2 stolen bases thus far. Grissom, 23, was acquired from Atlanta on December 30, 2023, in exchange for LHP Chris Sale. Vaughn has played in 64 career Major League games with the Atlanta Braves (2022-23), batting .287 with 5 HR and a .746 OPS while making 41 starts at 2B and 19 at SS. Last season in 102 games with Triple-A Gwinnett (70 at SS and 31 at 2B), he batted .330 (8th best in all of the minor leagues) with a .419 on-base percentage, .501 slugging percentage, 8 HR, and 13 stolen bases in 15 attempts. He also led the Stripers with 36 doubles and had a 45-game on-base streak from June 28 – September 19.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – None today as of mid-afternoon.

The WooSox have already sent nine players to Boston in the four weeks since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, and Zack Kelly. Those nine do not include OF Rob Refsnyder who was an injury rehab recall from Worcester to Boston. Gonzalez is currently on Boston's injured list and Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona, but the rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
