#### LRST TIME OUT...

**MOOSIC, Pa. (September 3, 2021)** – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders struck out a season-high 17 batters on Friday night at PNC Field, but fell 1-0 to the Buffalo Bisons.

Luis Gil ran into some immediate trouble in the first inning, loading the bases with only one out. From that point, he was utterly dominant, retiring the next 14 Bisons hitters in the remainder of his outing. Gil struck out nine Buffalo batters and allowed only two hits and one walk in 5.0 shutout innings.

MLB rehabber Michael King followed Gil and turned in 2.0 scoreless innings of relief. He worked around a one-out double by Otto Lopez in the sixth and struck out four in his second rehab appearance.

In the top of the eighth, Buffalo broke the scoreless tie against Braden Bristo (5-3). Back-to-back walks started the frame, and Lopez chased home former RailRider Kellin Deglan with the game's lone run.

The RailRiders had their best chance in the bottom of the eighth when Max Burt led off with a double and Jonathan Davis walked to put runners on first and second with one out. However, Dany Jimenez was able to strike out Greg Allen and Donny Sands to escape the jam.

Burt had a standout game at the plate for SWB, finishing 2-for-3 with two doubles.

In the ninth, Adam Warren struck out two in a 1-2-3 inning, but the RailRiders went down in order in the bottom of the frame to close out the game. SWB has lost a season-worst six straight games and fallen 2.0 games behind Buffalo in Triple-A East Northeast Division with 15 games remaining.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders and Buffalo Bisons play their second doubleheader of the week today, with the Bisons having swept Tuesday's by scores of 5-1 and 3-0. That marked the first time in six twin bills that the RailRiders had been swept by their opponent this season. In fact, SWB had split each of their first five doubleheaders this season. The RailRiders are 3-3 in openers, while posting a 2-4 mark in nightcaps.

**SIX IS ENOUGH:** With losses in the final two games of the series at Lehigh Valley and in the first four games of the Buffalo series, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders enter play on Saturday night riding a six-game losing streak for the first time all season. Remarkably, the RailRiders have only suffered three other losing streaks of three straight throughout the season. In 2019, SWB had three four-game losing streaks, a five-game losing streak and one six-game losing streak. There was also one stretch where the team lost 11-of-12 games played from 8/6-17. Since the beginning of August, the RailRiders have posted an 11-17 record, and have fallen a season-worst 2.0 games out of first place.

**CERTIFIED STRIKEOUT BOYS:** RailRiders pitchers struck out a season-high 17 batters on Friday night in a 1-0 loss against the Buffalo Bisons. That was the highest strikeout total of the year for SWB, surpassing the 15 K mark accomplished three times, most recently on August 8 against Worcester. The 17 strikeouts recorded by the RailRiders on Friday was the most since the staff struck out 18 on May 5, 2019 against the Syracuse Mets. That contest was also notable for SWB scoring 14 runs (10 earned) against Mets starter Mickey Jannis, and a 7 RBI performance from Kyle Higashioka.

**CLOSE CALLS & BLOWOUTS:** The RailRiders have played an extraordinary number of close games this season, with 52 of SWB's 102 games being decided by one or two runs (50.98%). Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has performed perfectly average in these close contests, going 15-15 (.500) in one-run games and 11-11 (.500) in two-run games. However, the RailRiders have also participated in their fair share of extreme blowout games, decided by eight-or-more runs. In 12 such contests, SWB is 10-2 (.833) on the season, and is part of the reason why the team is +123 in run differential this season, second-best in Triple-A East.

**ONE OF THE BEST:** Throughout the 2021 season, the RailRiders bullpen has been the backbone of the pitching staff, posting a 2.99 ERA as a unit and racking up 42 of SWB's 59 wins. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has the third-best bullpen ERA in full season baseball (minors and majors), trailing only Buffalo (2.82) and Somerset (2.85). The bullpen is posting impressive rates of 10.82 K/9, 4.04 BB/9, and has limited opposing batters to just a .204 batting average this season.

**KEEPING IT 🔥:** Despite the recent swoon and an overall disappointing month of August (11-15 record), the RailRiders hit the 100-game mark of the season with one of the best records in team history through that benchmark game. At 59-41, the RailRiders have the third-best 100-game record in the RailRiders Era (2013-Present), trailing the 2017 squad (63-37) and the 2016 National Championship team (62-38). The 2021 RailRiders own the best mark through 50 games (34-16), but sat exactly at the .500 mark in their next 50 games.

**ALLEN STARTED THE FIRE!:** RailRiders OF Greg Allen has been on a tear in 20 games since being returned to the team from the Yankees. The switch-hitter is batting .383 (23-for-60) with 11 R, 4 2B, 3B, 3 HR, 11 RBI, 4 BB, 10 K, and 5 HBP. Allen had a 12-game on-base streak snapped on Saturday with an 0-for-3 performance, but during the streak his season batting line improved from .263/.402/.343 to .321/.440/.460, a 155-point jump in his OPS.

**SWEET ESCAPE:** Despite two consecutive losses to Lehigh Valley to end the road trip, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders are 33-19 (.634) on the road this season, the second-best mark of any team in Triple-A this season. Only Jacksonville (33-21) can claim as many wins away from home in Triple-A East, and in the Northeast Division, Worcester (29-22) has the second-best road record. In Triple-A baseball, only Reno (35-19) has more wins on the road than Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Sears had an up-and-down start in his last outing against the Lehigh Valley IronPigs, allowing two runs in the first inning, but settling down after as the RailRiders jumped out to an 8-2 lead. However, in the fifth with driving rain coming down, the IronPigs rallied for two more runs after defensive miscues by SWB extended the inning. The RailRiders eventually won the game 11-4, giving Sears his second Triple-A win. It was also the last game won by SWB before their current six-game losing streak.

**SEARS ON SEARS:** Sears was featured along with Somerset lefty **Ken Waldichuk** in a July 2 article on FanGraphs. Here is what he told David Laurila about how he has changed since being acquired by New York: "It's been a while — it's been four years — so I'm definitely different, and that's in a good way. I still have an above-average fastball with ride, and all that, but I've learned to pitch better. My secondary stuff is better, and I also spent all of 2020 cleaning up my delivery." On what he looks for in analytics: "I don't look at spin rate as much as I look at my break-z and my z-deception. Those numbers went down in 2018 and 2019, and they're starting to come back up in 2021." - <https://blogs.fangraphs.com/lets-hear-from-a-pair-of-yankees-prospects/>

**MISTAKEN IDENTITY:** RailRiders pitcher JP Sears is not to be confused with YouTube personality and comedian JP Sears, despite the other dominating the front page of a Google search for "JP Sears". It is easy to tell the two apart by sight, as the other Sears sports both long hair and a beard, neither of which are allowed by the New York Yankees.

- In three seasons at The Citadel (S.C.), had a 17-15 record and 3.98 ERA (253.0IP, 232H, 125R/112ER, 87BB, 317K) in 46 career appearances (42 starts)...as a junior in 2017, was named the Southern Conference Pitcher of the Year and a Golden Spikes Award semifinalist after going 7-3 with a 2.64 ERA (95.1IP, 69H, 28ER, 27BB, 142K) in 14 starts.
- Ranked fifth in the nation in strikeouts and third in K/9.0IP ratio (13.41).
- Earned 2017 All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball (second team), Baseball America (third team), the ABCA (third team), the NCBWA (third team) and D1Baseball.com (third team)...on 3/24/17 vs. VMI, tied a school record with 20K in a two-hit shutout.

**LAST TIME OUT:** García struggled last Saturday night against the Lehigh Valley IronPigs, allowing four runs in 2.3 innings, striking out two and walking five. He gave up two in the first after SWB gave him a 3-0 lead, then allowed a two-run double to Alec Bohm to tie the game in the bottom of the fourth, before being removed. The RailRiders eventually lost the game 9-8 in 12 innings on a walk-off sacrifice fly by Nick Maton, starting a six-game losing streak entering play on Saturday.

**TROUBLE WITH THE HOMER:** In 77.0 innings this season, García has already surrendered a career-high 18 home runs with the RailRiders. That equates to a shocking 2.10 HR/9.0 IP and an equally-shocking 18.4% HR/FB rate. The right-hander has the sixth-highest HR/9 among pitchers in all of Triple-A with at least 70.0 innings pitched, and also 14th-highest in all of MiLB. García's HR/FB rate is 14th-highest in Triple-A with the same qualifier. That said, García has greatly improved at keeping the ball in the park in August, having given up just one HR in 22.1 innings of work.

**RECORD SETTING ROOKIE:** Deivi García made his big-league debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader on 8/30/2020 against the New York Mets (6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 0 BB, 6 K). He became just the 10th Yankee since 1935 and the first since 1992 to throw at least 6.0 IP and not allow an earned run in his MLB debut. García went on to become just the second pitcher in Yankees history with at least 6 K and no more than 2 BB in each of his first four big league appearances (Masahiro Tanaka, 2014). He did this while being the youngest pitcher (21 year, 103 days) to start a game for the Yankees since Phil Hughes (21 years, 95 days in 2007), and the second-youngest player to start a game in the majors in 2020 (Luis Patiño, SD; 20 years, 329 days). The right-hander capped off the season by starting Game 2 of the ALDS against Tampa Bay, and became the youngest pitcher (21 years, 140 days) ever to start a postseason game for the Yankees (previous: Whitey Ford, 1950 World Series Game 4; 21 years, 351 days).

- Younger brother, Andres García, is a prospect in the Toronto Blue Jays organization. He most recently played for the DSL Blue Jays in 2019.
- Pitched in the 2019 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Progressive Field in Cleveland, and was promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre for the first time after the game.
