went 3-for-4 and **Max Hajcic** allowed just 1 H over 6.0 innings to pick up his 10th win of the season as the Cardinals ran their winning streak to 7 with a 4-1 victory over the Tulsa Drillers on Saturday evening at Hammons Field. **Noah Mendlinger** also had two hits for Springfield who racked up four doubles. **Matt Svanson** pitched out of a bases loaded, one out jam in the top of the 8th and retired the Drillers in order after a leadoff single in the 9th inning for his 23rd save of the season. CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

ON PACE...: With 70 wins through their first 119 games, the Cardinals are on pace for 81 wins in 2024, which would eclipse the franchise record for wins in a season. The current record is 77 wins which as been acheived twice: 2017 (77-63) and the Texas League title year of 2012 (77-61). Springfield has eclipsed the 70-win mark 9 other times in franchise history, and has done it in consecutive seasons for the first time since 2009-10. The Cards went 72-66 last season.

LONG, HOT SUMMER: Since the beginning of July, no team in Double-A has won as many games than the Springfield Cardinals. The Cards are 31-13 since July 1, the best record in Double-A during that time. Springfield since the calendar flipped to July is 5-1-2 in series and has the best batting average below Triple-A at .278. The Cardinals have an ERA during that time of 3.85, which is 3rd-best in the Texas League. Through the end of June Springfield sported a

CARDIAC CARDS: Over their last 11 games, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Despite trailing in the 7th inning or later in 6 of their last 11 games, Springfield is 9-1 during that time. The Cards scored 33 of their 70 (47%) runs in the 7th inning or later, and have outscored their opponents 27-8 in the 8th inning or later. The Cardinals have walked off on the Drillers in 3 of the first 5 games of the series this week at Hammons Field.

POWER SURGE: After getting off to a slow start in the power category to start the 2024 season, the Cardinals have already eclipsed their home run total from the first half. With 47 longballs in 50 games, Springfield is on pace to hit 65 HR in the 2nd half after hitting just 37 in the 1st half. Springfield has the highest OBP (.352) and OPS (.764) in the Texas League and has scored 21 more runs (267) than any other club in all of Double-A in the 2nd half (since June 24). The Birds ranked 6th in SLG (.361) and 5th in OPS (.712) in the Texas League in the 1st half

FOR STARTERS: The Cardinals starting rotation has been up and down this season but has been lights out in the month of August. Springfield's starters since August 1 have the 2nd-best ERA in the Texas League at 2.31, trailing only Midland (2.19). Opposing hitters are batting just .222 against Cardinal starters since the calendar flipped. Through the first 5 games of their series against the Drillers, Cardinals starters are 2-0 with a league-best 0.87 ERA and a .196 BAA.

TORRES BRINGS HOME TLPOW HONORS: For his performance last week in Frisco, Cardinals INF/OF Bryan Torres was named Texas League Player of the Week for the first time this season. Torres is the 2nd Cardinal to win the award this season; Nathan Church was named Texas League Player of the Week for the week of April 15-21. Cooper Hjerpe earned Texas League Pitcher of the Week for June 17-23. Torres had himself a week, batting .609 (14-for-23) with 2 2B, 4 RBIs and 8 runs scored against the RoughRiders. He added 3 BB and 2 SB and had a .654 OBP.

During the month of August, Torres is batting .434 (33-for-76) with 5 2B, a home run and 11 RBIs. He has notched multiple hits in 9 of his last 12 games and is batting a scorching-hot .509 (27-for-53).

2nd HALF OF CROOKS: Over his last 42 games dating back to June 23, the final day of the 1st half, Cardinals catcher Jimmy Crooks has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the Euless, TX native leads all qualified hitters in the circuit with a .359 average, 10 HR and 39 RBIs and is slugging .621 and with a league-high 1.040 OPS. Over 18 games in August he is batting .382 (26-for-68) with 4 HR and a leauge-best 20 RBIs. In his first 44 games of the season, Crooks batted .282 with 1 HR and a .786

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer Matt Svanson has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. Svanson is a perfect 23-for-23 and his 46 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 23 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 23.2 IP (0.38 ERA) and is 13-for-13 in save opportunities. Svanson has allowed just one unearned run over his last 18 appearances, allowing just 12 H with 19 K over 22.2 IP. The Cardinals are 50-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.
