NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.

Of 16 series played this season, Omaha has won 5, lost 8 and split 3 ... the Storm Chasers have won 4 of their last 5 games after going 2-7 over the previous 9, dropping back-to-back series before the All-Star Break.

Omaha went 13-12 in April ... with a 13-14 record in May and 10-15 in June, the Chasers had back-to-back losing months for the first time since June/July 2025.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Chasers have 25 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 28 losses this year.

25 comeback wins are tied for 6th-most in the International League, tied 9th in Triple-A ... 28 blown leads are tied 2nd-most in the league, tied 4th in Triple-A.

The Storm Chasers have led at some point in 16 of their last 27 losses, including 4 games where the team led for at least half the game and 2 losses where Omaha had a 6+ run lead at some point in the game.

In the last 59 games (since May 9), Omaha is 27-32 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 18 of 27 wins and led at some point in 18 of 32 losses, meaning 36 of Omaha's last 59 games (61%) have been a comeback win for one of the teams ... in this stretch, 38 of 59 games (64%) have been decided by 3 runs or less.

SUMMER HEAT

A pair of Storm Chasers bats have especially been performing well in recent weeks.

Over his last 20 games (since June 21), **Brett Squires** is slashing .352/.407/.620 (25-for-71) with 15 RBI ... last week, he snapped an on-base streak of 17 straight games, tied for the longest on-base streak among Storm Chasers hitters this year ... Squires hit safely in a career-best 14 straight games (June 16 to July 2).

Since his first game with Omaha on June 4, **Matthew Lugo** has hit .287 (37-for-129) with 8 home runs and 27 RBI in 33 games ... since his arrival, he is 4th in the International League in extra-base hits (20), tied 5th in doubles (11), tied 6th in home runs, 7th in total bases (74) and tied 7th in runs scored (26).

HONEST ABE

Abraham Toro started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May

Since May 12, Toro has a .320 average (55-for-172) ... he ranks 1st in the IL in OPS (.992), 4th in SLG (.605) and tied 8th in AVG (.320) ... his 41 RBI over 46 games since May 12 rank tied as the 6th-most in the league.

From March 27 to May 10, Toro hit .189 (21-for-111) with a .650 OPS and hits in 16 of 33 games ... since May 12, Toro has hits in 34 of 46 games, with 4+ hits in 3 games.

Over his last 13 games (since June 27), Toro is hitting .333 (17-for-51) with 9 extra-base hits and 11 RBI, with a 1.053 OPS.

CROSS ME UP

Gavin Cross had one of the league's slowest start to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.

Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) ... but in his last 47 games (since May 16), he's hitting .302 (51-for-169), with 15 XBH and 21 RBI, with 15 multi-hit games, including 5 of his last 8 games.

HOME COOKING

A pair of Storm Chasers batters have excelled in front of the home crowd at Werner Park so far this season.

While hitting a modest .232 (32-for-138) with a .704 OPS on the road this year, **Abraham Toro** has batted .303 (44-for-145) with a 1.004 OPS at home this year ... 11 of his 15 total home runs have come at Werner Park.

Luca Tresh has also looked better in Papillion, batting .313 (40-for-128) with an .890 OPS at home while hitting just .229 (27-for-118) with a .597 OPS on the road ... 6 of his 8 homers have come at Werner Park, along with 28 of his 38 RBI.

NIGHT OWLS

While some players enjoy the early games, a couple of Storm Chasers have performed better under the lights.

John Rave has hit .287 (50-for-174) with all 12 of his home runs this season coming in night games, posting an OPS nearly .300 points higher at night (.943) than in the day (.658).

Dan Altavilla also appears nocturnal, pitching to a 4.18 ERA (13 ER in 28.0 IP) across 22 night games between St. Paul and Omaha, but posting an 11.57 ERA (15 ER in 11.2 IP) across 12 day games.

- ✓ This is Spence's 6th career start against Lehigh Valley and his 18th game against the Phillies and their affiliates ... he has worked a 2.32 ERA (8 ER in 31.0 IP) and 1.00 WHIP against the IronPigs in his career.

A NEW SPENCE OF PURPOSE

- ✓ **QUALITY CONTROL:** Spence is tied for the team lead in quality starts (3) ... most recently, he allowed just 1 run over 6.0 innings on July 2 against the Indians ... he previously fired back-to-back quality starts on June 7 and June 15 combining to allow 5 runs over 12.2 innings in those games.
- ✓ **HOME HEAT:** Spence has struggled at home throughout the season, largely due to a pair of rough outings in May, but over his last 3 starts at Werner Park has combined to post a 2.13 ERA (3 ER in 12.2 IP) with 9 strikeouts and a 1.18 WHIP, including a quality start in his last performance July 2 vs. Indianapolis.

LAST OUTING: SUNDAY, JULY 12 @ LOUISVILLE

- ✓ Came one out away from his 4th quality start of the season ... worked around a double for a scoreless 1st inning ... navigated a single and walk to keep the Bats off the board in the 2nd ... allowed an RBI fielder's choice in the 3rd ... pitched a perfect 4th ... kept the Bats off the board in the 5th despite a walk ... came out of the game in the 6th after allowing a dropped third strike to reach with two outs.

 - ✓ Spent much of the year in the Major Leagues with the Athletics, splitting time as a starter and reliever ... made the A's Opening Day roster for the second straight year and opened the season as a reliever, making 22 relief appearances with a 4.38 ERA (19 ER in 39.0 IP) and 37 strikeouts before June 2.
 - ✓ Made his first start of the year June 5 and worked a 1.20 ERA (2 ER in 15.0 IP) in his first three games as a starter ... optioned to Triple-A Las Vegas on July 10 and pitched in 8 games (7 starts) before the Athletics recalled him on September 10 for the remainder of the season.
