About the Last One: Altoona took their first lead of the series in Thursday night's game, jumping out to a 71-46 3-0 lead in the first three innings. In the second, it was a two-run home run that put the Curve in front, before Oneil Cruz hit a solo home run in the third. Altoona has scored 13 runs in this series, and 12 of them have come off homers. The three runs would prove to be all that Altoona would need, as Bowie scored one in the ninth and one in the eighth but left the tying run on base in the ninth.

Hired Gun: Infielder Gunnar Henderson, the No. 4 prospect in the Orioles organization according to MLB Pipeline has been promoted to Double-A Bowie. Henderson began 2021 with Low-A Delmarva, where he hit .312 with eight home runs in 35 games with the Shorebirds. From there, he was promoted to High-A Aberdeen, where he hit .230 with nine home runs in 65 games with the IronBirds. Combined with his time in Aberdeen, Henderson has reached base in his last 22 games.

12-7 Playoff Push: The top two teams in the Double-A Northeast League by winning percentage, regardless of 14-7 division, will compete in a best-of-five playoff series beginning Tuesday, September 21st. The first two games 57-39 14-7 of the series on Tuesday and Wednesday will be at the No. 2 seed, with a day off Thursday. Then, Friday-57-39 Sunday will be held at the home of the No. 1 seed. Should Bowie win two of their final three games, they 62-9 6-34 would ensure themselves a spot in the playoffs. With two games remaining in the season after today, Bowie 3-3 is 0.5 games behind both Somerset and Akron, who are in a six-game series against each other this week. 47-4

Drew's the Dude: Looking to start a new winning streak into the end of the regular season, the Baysox will start left-hander Drew Rom on Friday night. Rom has not allowed a run over his last two outings, including five scoreless frames, with only three hits, no walks, and seven strikeouts against Harrisburg last week. Rom was selected by the Baltimore Orioles out of high school in the fourth round of the 2018 draft. For more information on Rom, see page two.

In the Other Corner: Altoona will try to win their second game in a row on Friday behind righty Jeff Passantino. He has spent the entire 2021 season with Double-A Altoona, and this will be his 15th start in his 18th appearance. Passantino faced the Baysox on Opening Night, throwing two scoreless innings in relief, allowing just one hit with a walk and four strikeouts. Passantino was originally drafted by the Chicago Cubs in 2017, before he was claimed off waivers in December of 2020 by the Pittsburgh Pirates organization.
