CARDINALS STUN RIDERS IN OPENER:

Thomas Saggese tied his career high with four hits and Luisangel Acuña laced three extra base hits but the Springfield Cardinals rallied in the ninth inning for a 10-7 win on Tuesday at Riders Field. The Cardinals (32-32) did not take a lead until the ninth inning. Down to their last strike and trailing 7-6, Pedro Pagés' fly ball just cleared the left field fence for a go-ahead two-run homer. Jacob Buchberger added two-run home run of his own later in the inning. Nick Starr (3-3) gave up the runs in the ninth for the loss. Chris Roycroft (2-1) garnered the win having logged a scoreless eighth inning. Andre Granillo pitched a clean ninth inning for the save. Frisco (28-35) scored the first five runs of the game. Acuña doubled to lead off the first inning and Saggese scored him on a single. Acuña came back for a solo home run in the second inning, followed by Saggeses's single and stolen base. Saggese scored on Trevor Hauver's line drive single to make it 5-0. Nick Krauth allowed five runs the next inning to tie the game, but he came back in the fourth and fifth innings to keep the score tied at 5-5. Aidan Anderson went 1-2-3 in the sixth inning before encountering trouble in the seventh. He allowed one run before Antoine Kelly entered with one out and retired both batters he faced to strand runners on the corners. Michael Brever kept Springfield off the board in the eighth inning. Scott Kapers recorded a sac fly and a double, while Kellen Strahm and Hauver chipped in with a single, walk and RBI each.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has been hot lately, hitting safely in 10-straight games while batting .366 (15-for-41)/.435/.463/.898 with one double, one home run, five RBIs, six runs, five walks and a steal. Over the last 10 games, he has raised his average from .200 to .233 and his OPS from .612 to .667.

RISP-ECT THIS:

This season, the Riders are just eighth in the 10-team Texas League in batting average with runners in scoring position, hitting .252, though Frisco is fourth with 250 RBIs with RISP. Over the last six games (2-4 record), Frisco is hitting just .234 (15-for-64) in those situations.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over a nine-game hitting streak, Saggese is hitting .436 (17-for-39)/.489/.769/1.258 with a double, four home runs, 11 RBIs, four walks, nine runs scored and a steal. Among those who have played at least 50 games, Saggese is second on the team with a .299 batting average and .827 OPS.

THE SPEAS THAT PLEASES:

Reliever **Alex Speas** now has an ERA under 1.00 at 0.72 over 21 appearances. In 25.0 innings, he has struck out 42 to 12 walks. Opponents are hitting just .138 against him and he has not allowed an earned run over his last 12 outings. During that span, he has struck out 27 to five walks over 14.2 innings. On the season, righties are just hitting .125 (8-for-64) against him on the season with a .385 OPS.

POWER SURGE:

After only hitting two home runs over a two-week span, the RoughRiders have hit 15 long balls over their last 13 games. In the 13 games, Frisco is hitting .259/.361/.420/.781 with 26 doubles, 15 home runs and averaging 6.0 runs per game. **Thomas Saggese** led the way, batting .345 (19-for-55)/.406/.636/1.042 and has hit five home runs, the second most in the league over that span (Jorge Bonifacio with Northwest Arkansas, sty)

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, tied for first in the Texas League with a .600 average (12-for-20) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.619 OPS on the first pitch after homering on the first pitch on Saturday, which is second in the league. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .465 (20-for-43) on the initial offering while his 20 hits on the first pitch lead the league.

SPEED KILLS

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 29 and is on pace for a career-best 63 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 96 bases in 111 attempts (86 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)).

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .307 (73-for-238)/.374/.458/.832 through the first 55 games. Over his last 51 games, he is batting .318/.389/.482/.871. Acuña is riding an 13-game on-base streak, batting .350 (21-for-60). When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (121).

WALK THIS WAY

On the season, Frisco's 317 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .354 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Dustin Harris** is first in the league with 44 walks.
