#### FROM THE CROWS NEST

WELCOME TO THE STRETCH RUN: Bradenton is off to a 14-16 start in the second half, currently 1.5 games back of Fort Myers for the FSL West's final playoff spot. With 37 games to go, the Marauders are eyeing their first postseason appearance since 2021 when they won their second FSL title. The two enter Wednesday even during their season series at 8-8. With a series win, Bradenton can clinch the tiebreaker against the Mussels in the even they finished tied for the final postseason spot at the end of the regular season. If the two split the next two games and finish their season mark tied, the second tie breaker will be based off both clubs' overall winning percentage over the season's last 20 games.

TEJADA TOES THE RUBBER: Right hander Clevari Tejada will toe to rubber for the Marauders in game two of the series for his team-leading 18th start. Over 66 innings this season, Tejada has pitched to a 4.09 ERA and completed five innings or more five times. If he completes more than 2.1 innings today, he will surpass a career high, passing last year's mark (68.1 IP). Last Wednesday at Clearwater, Tejada tossed three frames of two-run ball before his start was cut short due to a weather delay. Over four outings in July, Tejada has been dominant, allowing just two earned runs over 15 innings of work (1.20 ERA). Before last week, he has tossed 12 innings without allowing a run to begin the month. Tejada's fastball saw a major uptick in velocity in July, as he hasaveraged 94.9 miles per hour and topped out at 96.9 - good for his hardest pitch of the season. Nine of his ten hardest thrown pitches this year have come during his last four outings. Tejada's slider has been a plus offering to both left-and-right-handed hitters, as opposing batters at just 4-for-36 against it (.111). His splitter has also surrendered just six hits this season (.182) and has generated a 41.8 percent whiff rate.

MARAUDERS MASHERS: The Bradenton Marauders return from the All-Star Break as one of the best home-run hitting teams in all of Class-A. Their 78 longballs this season are the most in the Florida State League and second for the most in Class-A (79, San Jose - California League). 121 of their 447 total runs have been generated via the long ball (27.0%). They're 27-23 when leaving the yard at least once, and 17-28 when not homering at all. They've seen three players launch 9+home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (A. Plaz, Y. De Los Santos, K. Griffin)

**BURNING THE BASE PATHS: Yordany De Los Santos** stole his 40th stolen base of the season on Friday, adding to a career-best mark (34 between FCL/Single-A in 2024). In the process, he passed **Jesus Castillo** (2023), for the most single-season stolen bases by a Marauder in franchise history. He ranks first in the Florida State League and seventh in Single-A. Moreover, he sits only behind **Konnor Griffin** (44) for the most swipes in the Pittsburgh Pirates system. They are the ninth and tenth 40+ stolen-base seasons in Pirates-MilB history. The two are approaching **Rich Thompson** for the most in a season by a Pirates minor leaguer when he stole 58 in 2005 between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis.

WELCOME TONY: Pirates No. 21 prospect (MLB Pipeline) Tony Blanco Jr. was activated and assigned to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, July 19 at Jupiter and collected his first Single-A hit and RBI on a first-inning single and fourth-inning sacrfice fly. Blanco began the season on the injured list and just completed a two-game rehab assignment with the FCL Pirates where he went 1-for-6 with a home run. In 30 FCL games last year, Blanco Jr. batted .305 and slugged .505 with four homers. His father Tony Blanco played 62 big-league games for the Washington Nationals in 2005 and spent eight seasons in the Nippon Professional Baseball League in Japan.

**ELECTRIC EDWARD:** Newly-named Pirates No. 6 prospect **Edward Florentino** (prev. No. 23) enters the week scorching hot, having homered in three consecutive games. Despite not homering in game one versus FTM, he drove in two, giving him RBI in four straight games. The outfielder was named Florida State League Player of the Week on 7/7 for his dominant stretch from June 30 - July 6 vs the Mussels. He became the first Marauders player to be honored this season by Minor League Baseball. Florentino finished the week 8-for-23 (.348), with three home runs, six runs batted in, three doubles and three stolen bases. Florentino was promoted to Single-A Bradenton on June 21. In 29 games with the Florida Complex League Pirates, he powered six home runs and drove in 23 runs. His .642 slugging percentage and 1.084 OPS led the FCL before his promotion.

MARAUDERS ON THE MEND: In this year's draft the Pittsburgh Pirates selected RHP Seth Hernandez sixth overall in the first round of the 2025 MLB Draft and signed with the organization on Tuesday for 7.25 million dollars, the largest bonus ever for a prep pitcher. Hernandez was recently named 2025 Gatorade National High School Player of the Year and spent the 2025 season as a senior at Corona High School in California (0.39 ERA/53.1IP, 105 K). He was committed to Vanderbilt University. At 19 years old, he was touted as the best prep arm in the draft, and the No. 3 overall prospect in the draft class via MLB Pipeline. His fastball reached 100 miles per hour, paired with an esteemed changeup, curveball and slider. Other notable selections included C Easton Carmichael (3rd Rd., Oklahoma), SS Gustavo Melendez (4th Rd., HS) and 1B Jared Jones (9th Rd., LSU) among others.

CLEVARI TEJADA'S HIGHS

Right hander **Clevari Tejada** will toe to rubber for the Marauders in game two of the series for his team-leading 18th start. Over 66 innings this season, Tejada has pitched to a 4.09 ERA and completed five innings or more five times. If he completes more than 2.1 innings today, he will surpass a career high, passing last year's mark (68.1 IP). Last Wednesday at Clearwater, Tejada tossed three frames of two-run ball before his start was cut short due to a weather delay. Over four outings in July, Tejada has been dominant, allowing just two earned runs over 15 innings of work (1.20 ERA). Before last week, he has tossed 12 innings without allowing a run to begin the month. Tejada's fastball saw a major uptick in velocity in July, as he hasaveraged 94.9 miles per hour and topped out at 96.9 - good for his hardest pitch of the season. Nine of his ten hardest thrown pitches this year have come during his last four outings. Tejada's slider has been a plus offering to both left-and-right-handed hitters, as opposing batters at just 4-for-36 against it (.111). His splitter has also surrendered just six hits this season (.182)and has generated a 41.8 percent whiff rate.
