

### LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped a tight affair with the Altoona Curve by a 2-1 final Thursday night. Bowie starter Justin Armbruester and Altoona's Jared Jones matched each other with four scoreless innings to open. The Baysox broke the deadlock in the fifth with three-consecutive hits from the top of their order, as Cesar Prieto singled home Heston Kjerstad to give Bowie a 1-0 lead. Armbruester went on to pitch 5-1 scoreless innings, with southpaw Easton Lucas helping him out of a jam in the sixth. However, in the seventh, the wheels fell off for Bowie. The Baysox committed two errors in the frame via pitcher Conner Loeprich and catcher Ramon Rodriguez, which led to a pair of unearned runs for the Curve, and a 2-1 Altoona lead. Despite totaling nine hits on the evening, the Baysox could not generate much offensively and went down quietly for the remainder of the evening.

### **TODAY'S OPPONENT**

The Altoona Curve are off to a 3-6 start and currently bottom of the Southwest division, albeit only two games out of first place. The Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, Altoona currently roster six of the organization's top-30 prospects, via MLB Pipeline. Headlining the roster is C Henry Davis (No. 3 PIT/ No. 57 overall), who is hitting .226 entering the series with a pair of home runs, six runs batted in and an OBP of .385. Other top prospects include INF Liover Peguero (No. 6 PIT), RHPs Jared Jones (No. 11 PIT) and Kyle Nicolas (No. 20 PIT), along with OF Matt Gorski (No. 17 PIT) and Matt Frazier (No. 23 PIT). Notable standouts through the first nine games include Frazier, who's hitting a team-high .313 and slugging a team-best. 594. His 10 hits and five extra-base hits are both fourth-most in the Eastern League. As a team, the Curve enter the series tied atop the Eastern League with 12 home runs and second with a .730 OPS. However, Altoona also enters tied for the most errors in the league with 13, along with the second-worst team fielding percentage at .960. The Curve are led by first-year manager Callix Crabbe, who managed in the Pirates' system in High-A Greensboro last season.

# TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

The Curve look to start right-hander Sean Sullivan for tonight's contest. Sullivan's Double-A career is a short one thus far, as he made his debut at the level in Erie this past Saturday, firing 2.1 shutout innings for Altoona in the start. Sullivan only allowed two hits and one walk with three strikeouts, but threw just 54 pitches. A 8th round draft pick of the Pirates in 2021 from the University of California, Berkeley, Sullivan pitched well in his debut pro-season for High-A Greensboro in 2022. Working primarily as a starter, Sullivan pitched to a 4.68 ERA through 75 innings, allowing 75 hits and 27 walks while striking out 84 batters. Sullivan held left-handed batters to a .234 average, versus a .274 average for right-handers. He did deal with multiple stints on the injured list towards the back-half of last season, including 7/9-7/27, being placed back on 8/21 through the end of the season. The right-hander features a low-90s tailing fastball, alongside a mid-80s changeup and slider.

# HAIL CÉSAR

INF César Prieto has had a phenomenal start at the plate to begin the 2023 season. Prieto leads the Eastern League with 17 hits. Yesterday's two-hit performance was his the fifth multi-hit game of his Dobule-A career-best 10-game hitting streak. That streak is also the longest across the Eastern League thus far in 2023. Prieto's previous Double-A best was an 8-game hitting streak for Bowie last season that spanned from 5/28-6/7, including a 8-for-22 (.364) series in Altoona. Prieto's longest hit-streak in Minor League Baseball is 12 games, with 10 of those contests coming at the High-A level with Aberdeen before he was initially called up to Bowie on 5/24/22 for the final two games of that streak. Prieto is batting .415 during his current hot stretch.

# **MOUND REBOUND**

The pitching staff as a whole has bounced back nicely for Bowie so far in 2023. After posting a 4.42 staff ERA last season, Bowie has the second-best team ERA in the Eastern League, and the third-best in all of Double-A, through 11 games at 2.80. Bowie arms have limited the free passes, with the second fewest number of HBP (3) and walks (44) in the league. The Baysox have also held the opposition to a .216 average with runners in scoring positon.

# **GETTING STARTED ON THE RIGHT FOOT**

The Baysox have gotten off to stellar starts throughout the early phase of the 2023 season. Bowie has scored first in 10 of its first 11 games - the only Eastern League team to have done so. Out of those nine opening scores, seven of them have crossed the plate in the first two innings. The Baysox 14 runs across the first two innings are second-most in the Eastern League. Only Altoona has scored more often in the first two frames, with 17 runs. Bowie starting pitching has also done it's part. Baysox starters have a collective 2.22 ERA on the season, along with four outings of at least five shutout innings. Bowie's +12 run differential in the first two frames is by far its best two-inning window in 2023. The second best window of consecutive innings for the Baysox is the sixth and seventh innings, with a +6 run differential.

#### **COACHING STAFF**

#### Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 14-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles sys-tem. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlanic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.
