RIDERS DROPPED BY WIND SURGE:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Wichita Wind Surge 5-2 on Thursday night from Riders Field. Wichita (15-9) clipped five runs off four homers in the first two innings. Tanner Schobel led off the game with a homer to put the Wind Surge in front 1-0. In the top of the second, Schobel, Tyler Dearden and Ricardo Olivarez slugged solo home runs to extend the lead to 5-0. The RoughRiders (14-10) broke through in the bottom of the seventh when **Tucker Mitchell** plated two runs on a fielder's choice and throwing error to pull Frisco within a 5-2 deficit. Wichita reliever John Klein (3-2) earned the victory while John Stankiewicz garnered the save with a scoreless ninth inning. Frisco starter **Josh Stephan** (2-1) picked up the loss, pitching three innings while allowing five runs. The RoughRiders bullpen spun six-straight scoreless innings. **Ryan Lobus**, **Gerardo Carillo**, **Janser Lara** and **Skylar Hales** allowed just three combined hits while punching out four batters.

THE ROAD IS WHERE MY HEART IS:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on the road this season, going 8-4 away from Riders Field. **Alejandro Osuna** (17), **Josh Hatcher** (16) and **Keyber Rodriguez** (15) are first, second and third, respectively, in road hits in the Texas League. Hatcher has hit all of his four home runs on the road. The Riders have averaging 5.7 runs per game on the road vs. 4.2 runs per game at home.

BROKEN BATS:

Frisco has faltered on offense recently. In their last 15 games, Frisco is just hitting .215/.302/.318/.620 while scoring 3.9 runs per game (7th in the league). This series against Wichita, Frisco has scored just six runs over three games, batting .175/.216/.237/.453. Of their 17 hits, just three of them have been for extra bases with **Alejandro Osuna** collecting two of them (triple and home run).

STRIKING UP STRIKEOUTS:

This week at Corpus Christi, Frisco's pitching staff has whiffed 107 batters through nine games (11.8 per game). That is the best in the Texas League and third in Minor League Baseball among teams' last nine games. Over the last nine games, the Riders 3.53 ERA is fourth in the Texas League.

SCORE, SCORE, SCORE SOME MORE:

Outfielder **Alejandro Osuna** is off to a great start scoring runs in 2025. Osuna's 21 runs scored are tied for the most in franchise history through 24 games played (**Ryan Cordell**, 2016). Osuna's 21 runs scored are also the most in the Texas League this season. The outfielder is currently on an 14-game hitting streak, batting .370 (20-for-54)/.429/.537/.966 with 11 runs scored in the 14 games with five walks to five strikeouts. His hitting streak is the longest active streak in Double-A and the fourth-longest among Minor League Baseball.

KEYBERRRRR, IT'S COLD IN HERE:

Keyber Rodriguez has been fantastic at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over his 18 games this season, he is hitting .313 (20-for-64)/.376/.381/.769. In his last 10 games, he is slashing .351 (13-for-37)/.400/.459/.859 with one double, a home run, six RBIs, two runs scored, three walks and four stolen bases. Over the season, he has four multi-hit games.

I GOT THE POWER:

The RoughRiders have shown off their punch to begin the season and have been great on offense during their first 24 games. Frisco's 22 home runs through 24 games are fourth in the Texas League.

HATCHIN' HITTIN':

Josh Hatcher was incredible for the RoughRiders in 2024 and he has picked up right where he left off in 2025. Hatcher hit .300/.350/.448/.798 over 107 games with Frisco last season. He was one of just three qualified hitters in all of Double-A baseball to hit .300 or better. To start 2025, he reached safely in all 15 of 19 games he's played in, batting .313 (26-for-83)/.322/.518/.840 with five doubles, four home runs, 19 RBIs, a stolen base and 12 runs scored. His .313 batting average is eighth in the Texas League. Hatcher already has eight multi-hit games and is 7-for-14 when putting the first pitch of an at-bat in play with two home runs. His .291 career batting average with the RoughRiders is second in franchise history (min. 700 PA), trailing only **Craig Gentry** (.292)

VERSUS THE WIND SURGE:

The Riders have gone 17-21 against Wichita in the Wind Surge's five seasons in the Texas League. Last season, Frisco went 7-5 against the Twins affiliate, owning a 3.33 ERA as a team. In 12 games, Frisco allowed just five home runs. The Riders took down the Wind Surge in the 2022 Texas League Championship Series, sweeping them in two games.

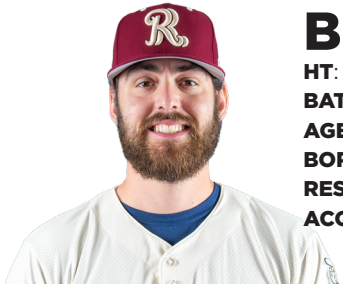

ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 28th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2025 SEASON

-In his first outing of the 2025 season, worked out of the bullpen in long relief, allowing four runs over 3.2 innings to Corpus Christi.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out three side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John" ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22
