TONIGHT: The Stripers continue the second leg of a 12- DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. has game road trip with game two of a six-game series vs. the Norfolk Tides (Baltimore Orioles) at Harbor Park. It is the 14th of 18 meetings between the two clubs this year, and the eighth of 12 games Gwinnett will play in Norfolk.

AT NORFOLK: The Stripers are 63-67 (.485) in 130 games all-time at Norfolk's Harbor Park, including 3-4 (.429) in seven games this season. Gwinnett is 6-6-0 in 12 season road series vs. the Tides all-time (2009-current), including 4-2-0 over the last six years (2015-current).

KINGS OF THE "K": Stripers pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 751 in 73 games (10.29 SO per game). That's 18 more than Round Rock and Sacramento of the PCL (T-2nd, 733 in 73G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (1st, 99), Tucker Davidson (6th, 69), Bryce Elder (T-14th, 59), and Huascar Ynoa (T-15th, 59) all rank among the International League's top 15 in strikeouts.

ROSARIO ON REHAB: Atlanta Braves' OF Eddie Rosario is batting .214 (3-for-14, 2 RBI) in three games since joining Gwinnett on a rehab assignment on 6/25. He is on the 10day IL following a procedure to correct blurred vision and swelling in his right retina. Rosario, the 2021 NLCS Most Valuable Player, is rehabbing with Gwinnett for the second time in his career (13G from 8/11-26, 2021).

JACKSON AND MATZEK ALSO ON REHAB: The Braves have also assigned RHP Jay Jackson and LHP Tyler Matzek to Gwinnett for injury rehab in the last two days.

- Jackson: Has been on the 60-day IL since 3/19 (right lat strain) and hasn't pitched for Atlanta since being acquired via trade with San Francisco on 11/22/21. In 57 career MLB games (with SD, MIL, SF), is 3-1 with a 4.31 ERA .216 BAA, and seven holds.
- Matzek: The Braves' 2021 Postseason hero has been on the 15-day IL since 5/14 (left shoulder inflammation). Prior to injury, he went 0-1 with a 5.06 ERA and .167 BAA in 13 games this season. It is his second career stint with Gwinnett (0-0, 9.00 ERA in 5G in 2019).

RISING WATERS: Over his last nine games since 6/18, Drew Waters is batting .306 (11-for-36, 2 3B, 1 HR, 5 R, 4 RBI, 2 SB, .905 OPS) with three multi-hit efforts. In 39 games overall this season, he's batting .258 (39-for-151, 6 2B, 3 3B, 4 HR, 21 R, 14 RBI, 3 SB, .730 OPS).

- Start it With a Bang: Waters has three XBH on the first pitch of the game this year (leadoff homers on 5/3 vs. CLT and 5/11 at DUR, leadoff triple on 6/11 at JAX).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .249 (165-for-662, 33 2B, 4 3B, 17 HR, 108 R, 62 RBI, 34 SB, .715 OPS) in 168 games.

JOLTIN' JOE DUNAND: Joe Dunand blasted his second home run with Gwinnett last night (solo, off LHP Kevin Smith). Oveer his last five games, he's batting .389 (7-for-18, 1 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 3 R, 4 RBI, 1.310 OPS).

SHEWMAKE STOPPED AT EIGHT: Braden Shewmake saw his season-best eight-game hitting streak snapped last night (0-for-4). During the streak from 6/7-6/26, he batted .344 (11-for-32, 2 2B, 1 HR, 4 R, 4 RBI, 1 SB, .871 OPS). In 52 games overall on his Triple-A debut, he's batting .267 (52-for-195, 10 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 27 R, 12 RBI, 5 SB),

reached base safely in 12 of 14 games with at least one plate appearance this month, batting .361 (13-for-36, 2 2B, 1 HR, 11 R, 6 RBI, 5 SB, 1.000 OPS). Overall with the Stripers this season, he has reached base safely in 42 of 50 games (84.0%) with a plate appearance, batting .277 (39for-141, 6 2B, 1 HR, 24 R, 16 RBI, .766 OPS).

• IL Leaderboard: DeShields ranks among the IL top 15 in steals (T-11th, 15) and walks (13th, 35).

CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin fanned a seasonhigh five batters over 2.0 scoreless innings (1 H, 0 BB) on Sunday in Nashville. The outing extended his scoreless innings streak to 8.1 spanning his last seven outings since 6/5. In that stretch, he's posting a 0.48 WHIP (3 H, 1 BB), .107 BAA, 16.20 SO/9.0 IP ratio (15 SO), and two saves (2-for-2). In 22 games overall with Gwinnett, Tonkin is 3-0 with a 2.35 ERA (6 ER in 23.0 IP), .186 BAA, 15.26 SO/9.0 IP ratio (39 SO), and five saves (5-for-6).

MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller produced his fifth consecutive quality start on Saturday in a loss at Nashville (7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 2 BB, 7 SO, 1 HR, season-high 105 pitches). Over that five-start span, he is 2-1 with a 1.87 ERA (7 ER in 33.2 IP), 0.77 WHIP, .171 BAA, and 11.49 SO/9.0 IP ratio (43 SO).

- IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (99) and is among the top 10 in ERA (2nd, 2.96), innings (2nd, 76.0), WHIP (2nd, 1.08), and BAA (2nd, .215).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-8 with a 3.18 ERA (55 ER in 155.2 IP), .219 BAA, and 192 strikeouts (11.10 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 30 starts.

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte is batting .167 (7for-42, 4 R, 1 RBI, 2 SB) in 11 games with Gwinnett since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 170 of 200 games (85.0%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .277 (192-for-693, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 130 R, 138 RBI, 15 SB, .914 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

CASTEEL IN THE CLUTCH: Ryan Casteel lifted an oppositefield two-run homer (#6) to right off RHP Alec Bettinger on Thursday at Nashville, leading the Stripers to a 4-1 win. Of Casteel's 15 hits this season, 10 have gone for extra bases (3 doubles, 1 triple, 6 homers). For his Gwinnett career, 48.0% of his hits have been for extra bases (24 of 50), including nine doubles, one triple, and 14 homers.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

TONIGHT'S START: Nolan Kingham makes his eighth start and 19th appearance of the season in game two of a six-game series at Norfolk. Each of his last four outings have been starts (0-0, 2.70 ERA, 0.98 WHIP, .231 BAA, 2 HR, 1 BB, 15 SO).

- GWN Career: Makes his 26th appearance (14th start) for the Stripers ... Is 1-5 with a 5.91 ERA and .275 BAA with the club since making his Triple-A debut in 2021.
- Triple-A Splits: In 13 starts with Gwinnett, is 0-4 with a 6.04 ERA and .289 BAA ... In 10 road games (5 starts) at the Triple-A level, is 1-1 with a 4.23 ERA and .248 BAA.
- Last Win as Starter: Hasn't won in a start since 8/20/21 with Double-A Mississippi at Montgomery (7.0 IP, 6 H, 1 ER, 0 BB, 5 SO in 3-1 victory).

2022 SEASON: Was a member of Gwinnett's Opening Night roster for the first time in his career ... Did not allow a run over his first five games (9.1 IP), all relief outings ... 4/30 vs. NOR: Made his first start of the year, tossing a season-high 4.0 scoreless innings (1 H, 1 BB, 2 SO) in a combined six-hit shutout (won 5-0) ... 5/10 at DUR: Earned his first career Triple-A win in relief (2.0 IP, 0 H, 3 SO in 8-4 victory) ... 6/9 at JAX: In his fifth spot start, tied his season high with 4.0 IP (4 H, 1 R, 0 ER) and struck out seven (won 5-1), his most strikeouts in a game since 8/16/19 with Double-A Mississippi vs. Birmingham (8 SO in 7.0 IP).
