ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Jersey Shore jumped out to an early lead and held on late to beat Brooklyn 5-3 on Wednesday night to even the series at one game apiece. RHP **Junior Santos** struck out a career-high eight batters over five innings, but allowed a career-high-tying nine hits in the loss. Offensively, the Cyclones struck out 16 times, including 13 times against No. 8 Phillies prospect RHP **Griff McGarry** who turned in one of the most impressive outings of his young career. The Cyclones scored three runs at the end of the game, highlighted by 1B **JT Schwartz** who collected his team-leading 26th RBI with an RBI single in the sixth.

FIVE MILLION: The Cyclones are 2,918 fans away from 5,000,000 fans entering the gates since the team's inception in 2001. On August 19, 2015 Pete Mulvey walked through the gates as the four-millionth fan.

FIRST HALF CLOSING: The first half of the season ends today. The second half begins on Friday, June 24th. Aberdeen clinched the first half division title last Wednesday night, beating Jersey Shore. The first half division winners in the North and the South clinch a playoff berth against the winners of the second half. In case of a repeat winner at the top of the division, the team in that division with the best full season record is awarded the playoff spot.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs in Coney Island, Brooklyn has completely turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 27 home runs in the past 31 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

JT JOLTING!: 1B **JT Schwartz** clobbered a three-run home run on Sunday at Wilmington, his second of the season. During June, Schwartz is hitting .338

vs. JERSEY SHORE: The Philadelphia farm system returns to Maimonides Park for the first time since the opening home series of the year April 12-17. This season, the Cyclones have won nine of the 13 games in the series. Jersey Shore hosts nine of Philly's Top 30 prospects, including No. 1 and No. 2 prospects RHP Andrew Painter and RHP Mick Abel. OF Johan Rojas is the No. 4 prospect in the org.

with a .382 on-base percentage. The No. 19 New York Mets prospect, according to MLB Pipeline, is slugging .460 after slugging just .317 in May and .362 in April. During this month, Schwartz has hits in 14 of 19 games.

BYE-BYE BMAC: OF **Brandon Mcllwain** earned a promotion to Double-A Binghamton Saturday. Prior to his call-up, he had been on base in 21 of his past 23 games and 14 straight. Since April 30th, Mcllwain was hitting .330 with a .430 OBP in 35 games.

ARMS STRONG: Brooklyn arms have posted a 3.68 earned run average in 22 games with 12 home runs in June, after posting a 5.27 ERA in 23 May games with 20 home runs allowed. In April, the Cyclones pitching staff stood as one of the best in the minors, posting a 2.98 ERA with just four home runs allowed and a 27% strikeout rate.

GRRR-ERRERA: Watertown, CT native OF **Justin Guerrero**, who attended Fairfield University, earned the promotion from Low-A St. Lucie on June 10. Guerrero earned All-MAAC First Team honors and Fairfield University Male Athlete of the Year in 2021 before being selected by the Mets in the 20th round.

PALMER'S POP: Brooklyn native OF **Jaylen Palmer**, the team's top prospect according to *MLB Pipeline* (No. 14), leads the club with six home runs, including a grand slam to win the game Sunday, June 12 against Aberdeen. His career high is seven home runs.

THE HIGH-A DEBUT CONTINUES: Mike Vasil makes his fifth start with Brooklyn and second against Jersey Shore.

TOP 30: Vasil ranks as the No. 21 prospect in the Mets organization, according to MLB Pipeline, after his draft selection in 2021. The righty signed for \$181,200 after his 8th-round selection by New York (NL).

FLORIDA PHENOM: Vasil dominated his time in St. Lucie, pitching with the Low-A affiliate of the Mets. In eight starts with the Baby Mets, Vasil compiled a slim 1.80 ERA over 35.0 innings. Amongst qualified arms, Vasil departs the Florida State League with the lowest ERA (1.80) and a 2.29 FIP, marking the best metrics in the circuit at the time of his promotion.

TAMP DOWN: In his penultimate appearance with the St. Lucie Mets, Vasil struck out 11 Tampa Tarpons hitters over a career-high seven innings on May 17.

VASIL AT VIRGINIA: The 6-foot-5 Vasil pitched in the ACC with Virginia, making 34 career appearances and 32 starts. He posted a 4.74 ERA in 161 1/3 innings. In his 2021 season, his junior year on campus, Vasil made 16 starts which tied for second-most in the ACC, ranking fifth in strikeouts looking (33).

MASSACHUSETTS MIKE: The righty pitched at the University of Virginia after earning No. 1 overall player in the state of Massachusetts by Perfect Game in 2017. He was a First Team All-State pick by USA Today and the 2017 Massachusetts Player of the Year.
