YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Erie SeaWolves, 5-3, in 11 innings. Trailing, 2-2, in the bottom of the eighth, **Diego Rincones** tied the score with a two-run homer. Richmond loaded the bases with one out in the bottom of the 10th but did not score. Erie took a 5-2 lead in the 11th with an RBI single by Parker Meadows and a two-run homer by Josh Crouch. **Tristan Peters** drove an RBI single in the bottom of the 11th. **Kyle Harrison** started and allowed one run over five innings and struck out six batters.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This week's set is the final series of the 2022 regular season and the SeaWolves' second visit to The Diamond this year. The Flying Squirrels dropped four-of-six at UPMC Park from April 19-24. In a six-game series in Richmond from June 7-12, the Flying Squirrels won five games, clinching a winning record against the SeaWolves in the first half.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 23-41 in the second half. They are 17-33 in the last 50 games. The Flying Squirrels have won eight series, lost 10 and split five this year. Last week in Bowie, the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win of the second half. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1,453 strikeouts, the most in the history of the Eastern League, and rank fourth with 160 homers.

THE SEAWOLVES are in first place in the Southwest Division standings with five games remaining, one game ahead of the Baysox. If Erie and Bowie finish the second half tied, the SeaWolves hold the tiebreaker and would earn a spot in the Eastern League playoffs. Erie lost four-of-six in last week's series against Akron and split the previous week against the Baysox. On the year, Erie is tied for the highest team batting average (.248) and rank second in homers (171). Erie's roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Wilmer Flores (3), RHP Ty Madden (4), RHP Reese Olson (9), C Dillon Dingler (10), OF Parker Meadows (17), LHP Brant Hurter (22), SS Luis Garcia (24) and RHP Elvis Alvarado (27).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Landen Roupp** makes his fifth Double-A start. He last pitched last Thursday at Bowie and allowed three runs (two earned) over 5.1 innings, striking out six and working a career-high five walks. After allowing four runs in four innings in his Double-A debut on August 21 against Binghamton, Roupp has gone 2-0 with a 2.60 ERA (5 ER/17.1 IP) over his last three starts since August 27. Among pitchers who have worked at least 100 innings this year, Roupp is ranked third in the minors in K/9 (13.19), third in strikeout percentage (36.4) and has the second-highest K-BB% (27.9) in MiLB, trailing only Kyle Harrison. Roupp was promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 18. Over his final six starts with the Emeralds, he went 3-0 with a 0.95 ERA (3 ER/28.1 IP) with 45 strikeouts and six walks. During his time with the Emeralds from July 3-August 16, Roupp led the Northwest League in ERA (1.67) and strikeouts (52). He began the year with Low-A San Jose and went 5-2 with a 2.59 ERA in 14 outings, including two starts, before being promoted to High-A on June 30. Roupp was selected in the 12th round by the Giants in 2021 out of UNC Wilmington. **For more on Roupp, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Reese Olson makes his 25th start of the season. Last time out, Olson allowed two unearned runs over five innings in a win last Thursday against Altoona. In that game, Olson passed the SeaWolves' single-season strikeout record, passing the previous record of 153 set by Seth Atherton in 1999. Over his last five starts since August 12, he has gone 4-1 with a 2.48 ERA (8 ER/29.0 IP) with 39 strikeouts and six walks. For the season, Olson is ranked fourth in the Eastern League in ERA (4.15), tied for second in wins (8), second in strikeouts (159), fifth in games started (24), seventh in innings pitched (115.0) and fifth in WHIP (1.24). Among qualified pitcher in the league, Olson is first in K/9 IP (12.44). Olson was selected in the 13th round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Brewers out of North Hall High School in Gainesville, Ga. He was traded to the Tigers on July 30, 2021 for LHP Daniel Norris.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,136) and rank second in total attendance (380,428). Richmond is 14th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 160 home runs this season, which is fourth in the Eastern League. On August 7 in the 101st game of the season, **Riley Mahan** hit a grand slam to give the Flying Squirrels their 128th homer of the season, breaking the previous franchise record. Last year, the Flying Squirrels broke the team record for homers with 127 in just 113 games, passing the previous record of 109 from 2013.

CASEY AT THE BAT: Third baseman **Casey Schmitt** was promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 9. Dating back to his Double-A debut on August 10, Schmitt has the second-best batting average (.358) in the Eastern League, the ninth-best OBP (.398), eighth-best SLG (.557), seventh-best OPS (.955), third-most hits (38) and he is tied for the fifth-most doubles (10). Over his last nine games since September 1, Schmitt is batting .395 (15-for-38) with two homers, four doubles and 10 RBIs. He has picked up multiple hits in five-of-his-last-nine games.

FITZ ON FIRE: **Tyler Fitzgerald** has 21 homers this season, which ranks as the second-most in a season in franchise history, one homer ahead of **David Villar's** previous franchise record of 20 set last year and trailing 25 by **Sean Roby** this year. He is the first player in franchise history to record 20-or-more homers and steals in a single season. After hitting .194 (55-for-284) with 15 homers in his first 83 games of the season through July 27, he is batting .297 (74-for-158) with six homers in his last 39 games since July 28.

BRAND NEW MAN: **Will Wilson** returned to action late last month after missing nearly three months with a broken hamate. After a rehab assignment in the Arizona Complex League, Wilson was assigned to Richmond on August 24. He hit .160 (4-for-25) in his first seven games back with Richmond. Over his last 12 games, Wilson is batting .261 (12-for-46) with two homers, a double, seven walks and six RBIs. After going 0-for-9 in a three-game stretch, he had two hits in Sunday's finale in Bowie, including a go-ahead homer in the top of the ninth inning, and added a solo homer on Tuesday night.

SHANE TRAIN: **Shane Matheny** has reached base five times in the two games of this week's series against the SeaWolves. On the season, he has posted a .380 on-base percentage, which is third-best in the Eastern League. He has worked 57 walks this year, which is tied for the sixth-most in a season in franchise history. His 90 career walks with the Flying Squirrels are the sixth-most in team history.

GO, DIEGO, GO! Since returning from the injured list last week, **Diego Rincones** is batting .269 (8-for-26) with two homers, a double and five RBIs. He hit a solo homer on Tuesday night and clubbed a game-tying, two-run homer on Wednesday. Including his time on the injured list, Rincones is batting .341 (15-for-44) with three homers in his last 13 games since August 9.

SAY HEY: **Jacob Heyward** clubbed two homers in last week's series against the Baysox. He now has six homers in his last 21 games played, giving him 32 for his Richmond career, which is the second-most in franchise history, trailing on 37 by **Ricky Oropesa** (2013-16). He has also extended his career franchise walks record to 157.

BANGED UP: The Flying Squirrels currently have 10 players on the injured list, including pitchers **Jake Dahlberg**, **Jorge Guzman**, **Ryan Murphy**, **Taylor Rashi** and **Blake Rivera**, catcher **Brett Auerbach**, infielders **Frankie Tostado** and **Sean Roby** and outfielders **Vaun Brown** and **Michael Gigliotti**.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Sean Roby** is tied for fourth in homers (25). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for ninth in stolen bases (24). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for 10th in homers (21) and tied for second in runs scored (73). **Shane Matheny** is third in OBP (.380) and tied for sixth with 57 walks. **Ryan Walker** is tied for eighth in games pitched (43).

RING CHASING: The Giants have four affiliates playing in the MiLB playoffs this year, including Richmond. High-A Eugene has a 2-0 lead in the Northwest League Championship Series over Vancouver. Low-A San Jose is down 1-0 in their series against Fresno in the California League playoffs. The ACL Giants Black won the Arizona Complex League title with a walk-off single by P.J. Hilson on August 28. Eugene and San Jose both won their league titles in 2021 and Sacramento won the Triple-A National Championship in 2019.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Casey Schmitt** (6), **Vaun Brown** (14 - on IL), **Ryan Murphy** (15 - on IL), **Will Wilson** (22) and **Ricardo Genoves** (30). Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. Schmitt is listed as the "Best Defensive Infielder" and "Best Infield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Schmitt (6), Brown (10), Murphy (15), **Tristan Peters** (21), **Will Wilson** (26) and **Landen Roupp** (27). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 18 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 22 overall prospect.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Pitcher **Cole Waites** made his MLB debut for the Giants on Tuesday night, working a scoreless inning against the Braves. He is the 84th Flying Squirrels alum to reach the majors and the ninth this season.
