**Today's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and Charlotte Knights conclude their six-game series this afternoon. Nashville has won four of the first five games, including a 9-1 win last night. Right-hander Luis Perdomo opens for the Sounds today against right-hander Emilio Vargas for the Knights.

**Luis Perdomo:** 28-year-old Luis Perdomo starts for the Sounds in the series finale. The right-hander is making his first start of the season and seventh appearance overall. In 6.1 innings, Perdomo has not allowed any runs and has yielded only 3 hits. He has not walked a batter and has struck out 10. He has pitched twice against Charlotte - a pair of relief appearances on April 19 and April 21. Milwaukee signed Perdomo to a minor league contract on January 4, 2021 but he did not pitch last year. He has a 20-31 lifetime record in the big leagues, all with San Diego from 2016-2020.

**Emilio Vargas:** 25-year-old Emilio Vargas starts for Charlotte this afternoon. The right-hander is 0-2 with a 10.03 ERA (11.2 IP/13 ER) in three starts this year. The Dominican Republic native last pitched in the series opener on Tuesday and the Sounds hit him hard. In 2.2 innings, he allowed 4 runs on 5 hits and 2 walks to go along with 3 strikeouts. Vargas spent the 2021 season with Double-A Birmingham and went 7-4 with a 2.90 ERA in 21 games (15 starts). He covered 83.2 innings and allowed 69 hits while recording 99 strikeouts. Vargas joined the White Sox organization on November 20, 2020 when he was claimed off waivers from Arizona.

**2022 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2022: First: 3, Second: 8, Third: 3, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Three and Counting:** Last night's win clinched another series win for Nashville, their third straight to start the season. The last time a Nashville club won its first three series of the season was in 2003. Back in '03, the Sounds played Iowa and Albuquerque, and went 6-0 with a pair of three-game sweeps after both finales were postponed due to rain. They then went on the road to Iowa and won three of four. The Sounds returned home to welcome Memphis for a four-game series and swept the Redbirds to improve to 13-1 on the season.

**Mendoza Line:** Nashville pitchers continue to stifle hitters. After yielding only three hits in 30 at-bats last night, Sounds pitchers have held opponents to a .199 batting average. Nashville is the only pitching staff in Triple-A Baseball holding the opponent under .200. The staff is allowing only 6.4 hits per game.

**Small ERA:** Ethan Small improved to 2-0 on the season and lowered his ERA to 0.49 (18.1 IP/1 ER) with 5.0 shutout innings on Friday night against Charlotte. He leads the International League in ERA and batting average against (.098) and is fourth in strikeouts (24).

**Defense Wins Games:** The Sounds have not made an error since April 14 at Gwinnett, going 79.1 innings without a miscue in the field.

**Earn It:** Nashville's team ERA went down to 2.50 after last night's win. The Sounds have the lowest ERA in Triple-A Baseball and the second-lowest ERA in all of Minor League Baseball behind only Single-A Lake County at 2.46.

**White Hot:** Sounds infielder Tyler White continues to swing a hot bat and knocked in two more runs with a two-run blast last night. White has recorded at least one RBI in six consecutive games and has hit safely in seven straight. He's hitting .440 (11-for-25) with 6 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs, 10 RBI and 4 walks during the streak.

**vs. Charlotte:** The Sounds and Knights are scheduled to play each other 12 more times in 2022 after today, with two of the series at First Horizon Park (April 19-24, July 26-31) and one in Charlotte (September 6-11). Nashville won 7 of 12 games last year, the first time the two clubs have met. The two teams split a six-game series in Charlotte June 1-6 and the Sounds won 4 of 6 games June 22-27 at First Horizon Park. Nashville is 10-6 all-time against the Knights.

**Hold the Line:** Nashville relievers have amassed 18 holds this season, the most in all of Minor League Baseball. (Triple-A Oklahoma City has the second-most with 14).

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 520-465 record during this span.

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.
