Thomas Jankins: 26-year-old Thomas Jankins makes his 14th appearance (12th start) for the Sounds tonight and is 1-5 with a 7.05 ERA in 2021. Jankins last pitched on July 16 in a start at First Horizon Park against Louisville. He allowed 5 runs on 8 hits in 3.2 innings and was tagged with his fifth loss of the season. In 2019, Jankins went 11-5 with a 4.19 ERA in 25 games (23 starts) with Triple-A San Antonio and Double-A Biloxi. He finished tied for fifth in the Pacific Coast League for wins (10), logged 10 quality starts and four starts of 6+ IP and one or less runs allowed. The Brewers drafted Jankins in the 13th round of the 2016 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

Shawn Morimando: 28-year-old Shawn Morimando starts for the Jumbo Shrimp tonight. The left-hander is 2-3 with a 5.19 ERA in 10 games (all starts) with Jacksonville in 2021. He has also pitched in two games with Miami and is 0-0 with a 6.35 ERA. The southpaw last pitched on July 17 in a start against Durham and went 6.0 innings in a no decision. He allowed 5 runs on 6 hits, including 3 home runs. He walked 1 batter and struck out 5 among his 92 pitches. Morimando signed with Miami as a minor league free agent in February and was drafted by the Cleveland Indians in the 19th round of the 2011 MLB First-Year Player Draft

**2021 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 38, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Against The Southpaw: The Sounds face a left-handed starter tonight for just the 12th time in 2021 and enter the game 8-3 in the 11 contests thus far. Nashville is hitting .253 (143-for-565) with a .839 OPS against left-handed pitchers in 2021. Active Sounds who have had the most success against lefties this year include Christian Kelley (.500, 9-for-18), Weston Wilson (.300, 12-for-40), Matt Lipka (.281 (9-for-32) and Dustin Peterson (.270, 10-for-37). The Sounds are averaging 1 extra base hit every 8.19 at-bats against a lefty compared to 1 every 10.65 at-bats against right-handers.

Wilson's Career Day: Weston Wilson matched a career-high with 4 hits in yesterday's win and is hitting .317 (19-for-60) with a 1.071 OPS in the month of July. Wilson hit his 14th home run of the season and knocked in 4 runs as well. It was Wilson's fourth career 4-hit game and first since April 20, 2019 with Double-A Biloxi when he went 4-for-5 with 4 runs scored, 2 home runs and 2 RBI in a 12-7 win over visiting Jacksonville.

Extra Extra Read All About It: Nashville managed yet another extra-inning win yesterday and are now 7-2 in extra inning games in 2021. The Sounds have won four consecutive extra-inning games and haven't lost one since June 30 vs. Louisville.

Six Shooter: Josh Lindblom got to the major number of 6.0 innings for a starter yesterday to improve the teams record to 10-5 when a starter goes at least six frames. It's the second time for Lindblom (5-4 win on 7/15 vs. Louisville) and also his second quality start. It is Nashville's 12th quality start of 2021 and fifth in the month of July.

Lipka's on a Roll: Outfielder Matt Lipka has been on a tear since joining the Sounds via trade on June 28. He has reached base safely in 15 of his last 16 games, batting .352 (19-for-54) with 7 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 10 RBI, 8 walks and 5 stolen bases.

**How Sweet It Is:** Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,072-1,948. The 2,072 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the court team Southeets Divisions
