Good Morning

The Fightin Phils kick off a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, on Tuesday. It is the first of 18 matchups between the teams this season, and first of two in Reading. The Fightin Phils won the season-series over Hartford in 2023, going 14-10 against the Yard Goats.

R-Phils.

A Quiet Sunday

Reading fell at Portland on Sunday 2-1, as the Fightin Phils were held to just four hits. The R-Phils lone run came in the came on a sacrifice fly from Casey Martin in the top of the second. Lachlan Wells was excellent on the mound, twirling six-shutout innings, but earning a no-decision. Portland took the lead in the seventh inning. After a leadoff walk issued from Andrew Baker, Matthew Lugo crushed a two-run, go-ahead, home run 420 feet over the Maine Monster in left field. Baron Radcliff nearly hit one out in the ninth, then William Simoneit hit a double off the top of the wall in left, but was stranded at second. The game was played in two-hours and one-minute, which marks the shortest nine-inning game played by Reading this season.

Taylor's Tantalizing April

Fightin Phils first baseman Carson Taylor was named the Phillies Minor League Hitter of the Month on Friday. In April, Taylor slashed .354/.426/.708, with a 1.134 OPS. He added three doubles, one triple, four home runs, 18 RBI, five walks, two stolen bases and eight runs over 13 games. Taylor had a career-high five RBI in game one of Saturday's doubleheader. It was the most RBI in a game by a R-Phils this season and the most since Nick Ward had five on Aug. 10, 2023, at New Hampshire. Taylor now has 24 RBI on the season, which leads all of Double-A.

One-Two Rotation Punch

Robinson Pina and Lachlan Wells are establishing themselves as the top-two pitchers in the R-Phils rotation. On Saturday at Portland, Pina struck out 11 hitters, which marks a season-high for Pina and the most struck out by a Fightin Phils picher this season. It also was the first time a Reading picher struck out 11 batters since Tyler Viza did it on August 27, 2018, at Richmond. On Sunday, Wells tossed six-shutout innings, but did not factor into the decision.

Zoom Zoom

The Fightin Phils continue to rack up the stolen bases this season. They matched a season-high with five stolen bases in game one of Saturday's doubleheader win over Portland. Reading has 36 stolen bases this season in 41 attempts, which is a 88% success rate. The Fightin Phils 36 stolen bases rank tied for fourth in the Eastern League. Reading is on pace for 184 stolen bases this season, after swiping just 119 last season, which ranked 10th in the Eastern League.

Defense Heating Up

After a slow to the start to the season defensively, the R-Phils have been much improved in the field as of late. After committing six errors last Tuesday at Portland, the Fightin Phils have not committed an error in five-straight contests. The Fightin Phils are the only team in the Eastern League with a perfect fielding percentage dating back to last Wednesday.

Max Lazar'd In

Max Lazar continued his red-hot start to the season with another scoreless inning on Sunday at Portland, where he struck out two hitters in a perfect innings. Lazar remains the only Fightin Phils pitcher to not allow an earned run, nor walk any hitters. He also owns a 0.29 WHIP and .088 opponents batting average. Lazar is the only pitcher in the Eastern League who has pitched north of 10 innings this season to not allow a run or walk.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 7, 2021: At Reading, the R-Phils were able to win their first game since September 1, 2019 after the pandemic-cancelled season, with a score of 8-4.

The Goat

Hartford enters today with a 14-10 record, which is second in the Northeast Division. The Yard Gosts continue a two-week road trip after going 2-3 at Binghamton last week. They won the first two games, before dropping the last three, and Sunday was cancelled. After this week, Hartford returns home and welcomes New Hampshire. Last season, Hartford finished with an Eastern League-worst 57-76 record. The Yard Goats roster includes nine of the Rockies top-30 prospects, featuring No. 1 Adael Amador and No. 3 Yanquiel Fernandez.

Goat on the Bump

Righty Connor Van Scoyoc gets the ball this morning for Hartford. This season, he's 1-2, with an 8.10 ERA (16.2 IP, 22 H, 12 BB, 13 SO). Van Scoyoc last pitched on Wednesday at Binghamton, getting the win, allowing no-earned runs on four hits over five innings, with five strikeouts. He split last season between the Angels and Rockies systems, pitching for High-A Tri-City, High-A Spokane and Double-A Hartford. He combined to go 7-6, with a 3.80 ERA over 23 starts. Van Scoyoc was traded from the Angels to Rockies on June 25, 2023, in exchance for Mike Moustakas. The 24-year old was drafted in the 11th round of the 2018 draft out of Jefferson High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa.
