TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! Tonight, your Quakes host the Lake Elsinore Storm (Padres) in the final game of a six-game series. Tonight, 1,500 fans will take home a set of 2025 Team Trading Cards. Kids will "Run the Bases" after the game, thanks to San Antonio Regional Hospital. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE STORM: Today's game is the 18th of 24 head-to-head games and the last of 15 here at LoanMart Field. Thanks to winning four of five in the current series, the Quakes are 14-3 against the Storm with a 12-2 record here at home. Last season, the Quakes went just 10-20 against the Storm, 7-8 at home.

LAST GAME: The Quakes won their third straight overall, as they used three runs in the bottom of the seventh inning to take home a 4-1 win over the Lake Elsinore Storm on Saturday night at LoanMart Field. Justin Chambers (2-0) retired all six batters he faced to earn the win, while Jhonny Jimenez worked around a two-out walk in the ninth, earning his fourth save of the year. Rancho pitching held Lake Elsinore to just two hits, a season-low for Quakes' pitching. The Quakes finished with just three hits themselves, as they capitalized on three walks and an error in the seventh, sacking Storm reliever Igor Gil (3-1) with his first defeat of the year. Joendry Vargas (4) homered for the second time in the series. The win for Rancho secures a series win, giving them a series record of 12-7-1 this year.

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS: Infielder Nico Perez, who's been on the Injured List since July 27, has been activated and is in Sunday's starting lineup. Starting pitcher Logan Tabeling has been promoted to High-A Great Lakes.

WELCOME BACK TO JOENDRY VARGAS: 19-year-old infielder Joendry Vargas has spent a significant amount of time on the Injured List this year, with two different stints. Vargas homered on Wednesday night, giving him his first hit since being activated from his latest injury stint. He homered again on Saturday, tying the game at 1-1 with his fourth long-ball of the year. Vargas is hitting .237 in 27 total games, with four homers, 22 RBIs and 17 steals in 19 attempts. He's ranked by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 11th-best prospect overall.

FOUR WINS, NOT MUCH HITTING: The Quakes have enjoyed a solid offense this year with a .255 average for third in the league and 83 homers, behind only San Jose's 92. Despite winning four of five in the current series, the Quakes' offense has been scuffling, including a season-low three hits in last night's win. Their hit totals over the five games go: 5, 7, 6, 8 and 3 for a five-game total of 29. Five of those 29 have left the yard.

CHRISTIAN ZAZUETA: 20-year-old right-hander Christian Zazueta makes his 16th start of the year and his third against the Storm, his second in this series. In his first game against Lake Elsinore this year, he earned the win, allowing just one hit over five scoreless innings. This past Tuesday, he worked a scoreless first, but allowed the first two batters to reach to open the second inning and was removed after just 33 pitches, eventually being charged with one run. Last year in Rancho, Zazueta went 1-5 with a 6.36 ERA over 14 games (11 starts) and 52.1 innings. Zazueta signed with the Yankees in 2022 out of Mexico and then was traded to the Dodgers in February of 2024 in the trade that saw former Quake Caleb Ferguson go to the Yankees. Zazueta is rated by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 18th-best prospect. **TUCKER MUSGROVE:** Righty Tucker Musgrove will make his tenth appearance for the Storm and his third start, as he was activated from the Injured List today in time to make his first appearance against the Quakes. Musgrove hasn't pitched since July 12 at Visalia, where he allowed four runs on one hit with three walks over just one inning in a no-decision against the Rawhide. Musgrove has only worked a total of 15.1 innings this year. He was drafted by the Padres in the seventh round of the 2023 draft out of Mobile College in Mobile, Alabama. **BROADCAST HOME:** Catch all the 2025 action with the "Voice of the Quakes" Mike Lindskog from the ease of
