**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels snapped their eight-game losing streak, their longest since 2016, with a 6-4 win over the Fightin Phils. Reading opened the scoring in the first inning with an RBI double by Carson Taylor and an RBI single by Caleb Ricketts to take a 2-0 lead. Richmond tied the game in the bottom of the second with a run-scoring groundout by Luis Toribio and a Reading error. In the bottom of the eighth with two outs, **Grant McCray** gave the Flying Squirrels a 4-2 lead with a two-run double. Toribio brought in a run with a double and **Adrian Sugastey** added an RBI single to stretch the lead to 6-2. In the top of the ninth, Reading scored two runs, by **Tyler Myrick** stranded the potential tying run at the plate to end the game. **Evan Gates** threw 2.2 scoreless innings and **Wil Jensen** followed with 1.1 scoreless innings, including stranding runners at second and third in the eighth inning. **Ryan Murphy** started for Richmond and allowed two runs, both in the first inning, over four innings with four strikeouts. **Jimmy Glowneke**, McCray and Sugastey each had two hits.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies, in the second of a six-game series. This week marks the only series between the two team this season. Last year, the Flying Squirrels went 8-1 against the Fightin Phils, their best record against Reading in franchise history. Richmond swept a three-game series at The Diamond to open the season and won five-of-six at Reading in June and July.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have dropped 12-of-14 dating back to April 28, including 11-of-12 on the last road trip to Akron and Erie. They had lost eight straight games before winning on Tuesday night. In their last series at home, the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win of the year, taking four-of-six against the Baysox.

**THE FIGHTIN PHILS** are in fifth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division. They won five-of-six in last week's series in Reading against Hartford, outscoring the Yard Goats 34-23 for the series. Reading's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Phillies prospects, including OF Gabriel Rincones (No. 10), OF Carlos De La Cruz (No. 16), RHP Christian McGowan (No. 17), C Caleb Ricketts (No. 20) and RHP Tommy McCollum (No. 29). There are six Reading players on MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects list, including Rincones (No. 10), De La Cruz (No. 13), McGowan (No. 16), Ricketts (No. 21), INF Robert Moore (No. 26), INF Jose Rodriguez (No. 28).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Hayden Birdsong** makes his seventh start of the season and the first of his career against the Fightin Phils. Last time out, Birdsong worked five innings and allowed one run with six strikeouts last Thursday at Erie. On the year, he has allowed two-or-less runs in five-of-six starts and one-or-less in four of them. Birdsong leads in the Eastern League (min. 25 IP) in K/9 (12.43) and ranked second in strikeout percentage (33.3%). Last year, he climbed three levels in the Giants' system en route to being named a 2023 MiLB.com Organization All-Star in his first full professional season. For the season, he posted the second-highest K/9 (13.32) and strikeout percentage (34.9) in the minors (min. 100 IP). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and posted a 2.16 ERA in 12 outings (10 starts). He was leading the California League in strikeouts (70) when he got promoted to High-A Eugene in June. After going 2-2 with a 3.25 ERA in eight games (seven starts) for the Emeralds, he was promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 5 for the remainder of the season. Birdsong was selected by the Giants out of Eastern Illinois University in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com entering the 2024 season. **For more on Birdsong, see page two.**

Left-hander **Nick Swiney** starts Game 2 of the doubleheader. It is his first Double-A start in his career and his first start overall since 2022. Swiney last pitched on Sunday at Erie and allowed one run in one inning. Last year, Swiney started the season with Richmond and went 3-0 with a 1.15 ERA (2 ER/15.2 IP) over six relief outings before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento in mid-May. Today marks his 12th outing of the 2024 season. Swiney was selected by the Giants in the second round (67th overall) of the 2020 MLB Draft out of NC State University, where he was teammates with current Richmond infielder **Will Wilson** and former catcher **Patrick Bailey**.

**FOR READING:** Right-hander Efrain Contreras makes his fifth start of the season. He last pitched last Wednesday against Hartford and pitched 4.1 innings, his longest outing of the year so far, and allowed three runs in a no-decision. After going 0-2 with a 19.50 ERA (13 ER/6.0 IP) in his first two starts this season, Contreras is 0-0 with a 7.71 ERA (6 ER/7.0 IP) in his last two starts. Contreras originally signed with the San Diego Padres out of Mexico in 2017. He reached Double-A last year for the first time with the San Antonio Missions and went 6-7 with a 4.92 ERA in 35 games (17 starts). Contreras signed with the Phillies as a free agent on March 17.

Left-hander Lachlan Wells starts Game 2 for Reading in his sixth start of the year. Last time out, he worked five innings and allowed three runs in a loss against Hartford on Saturday. He originally signed with the Twins as a free agent in 2014 and pitched at the High-A level the last two years. He signed with the Phillies as a free agent on January 7. Wells is the twin brother of former Bowie Baysox and Baltimore Orioles pitcher Alex Wells.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked second among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (7,860).

**RISPY BUSINESS:** In their last 17 games since April 25, the Flying Squirrels have hit .113 (11-for-97) with runners in scoring position, averaging 2.06 runs per game (35 total runs). On the last road trip to Akron and Erie, Richmond hit .058 (4-for-69) with runners in scoring position and averaged 1.7 runs per game (20 total runs). After going 0-for-37 with runners in scoring position over seven games plus the first seven innings on Tuesday's game, the Flying Squirrels picked up three straight hits to bring in four runs in the win.

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** There are four relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 15 IP), four Richmond pitchers rank in the top 11 in ERA, including **Evan Gates** (3rd - 0.95 ERA - 2 ER/19.0 IP), **Tanner Kiest** (9th - 1.76 ERA - 3 ER/15.1 IP), **Nick Garcia** (10th - 1.80 ERA - 3 ER/15 IP) and **Wil Jensen** (11th - 1.96 ERA - 5 ER/23.0 IP). Jensen also leads the league in relief innings pitched (23.0).

**GLOW SHOW:** In his last five games dating back to May 1, **Jimmy Glowneke** is batting .294 (5-for-17) with a double, two walks and two runs scored. In those five games, he has a pair of two-hit games, including Tuesday night against the Fightin Phils. This year, he has picked up two-or-more hits in four-of-15 games played, including a four-hit game on April 6 at Somerset.

**TORIBIO TRACKING UP:** **Luis Toribio** has picked up a hit in four-of-his-last-five games dating back to May 5. In that span, he is batting .250 (4-for-17) with a homer, a double and four RBIs. Last year, Toribio hit 17 homers with High-A Eugene after clubbing 21 homers for the Emeralds in 2022. He is in his first season with Richmond.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Ryan Murphy** is first in games started (8). **Carson Ragsdale** is seventh in strikeouts (37) and ninth in BAA (.206). **John Michael Bertrand** is eighth in innings pitched (36.1).

**MOVIN' UP:** On Tuesday, **Reggie Crawford** and **Hunter Bishop** were promoted to Triple-A Sacramento. In his nine outings with Richmond, Crawford struck out 19 batters over 9.2 innings of work and posted a 4.66 ERA. Bishop played 26 games for the Flying Squirrels. He ranked second on the team in batting average (.242), tied for second in homers (2), second in OBP (.314), second in SLG (.358), second in OPS (.672), tied for second in doubles (5). He also led the team in total bases (34) and stolen bases (5) and ranked tied for first in hits (23).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrian Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).
