LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped its first home game since Game 1 of a doubleheader on April 12, falling to Wilmington 8-7 on Thursday evening...The contest aired on SNY, the TV home of the New York Mets...Despite the loss, 38 Jesús Báez clubbed his 2nd home run of the season a 2-run shot to right field...Baez finished with 3 RBI...CF Carson Benge tallien his 5th-straight multi-hit game...18 Ronald Hernández also pitched in a multi-hit effort...The Cyclones committed 3 errors in the defeat...The 'Clones did claw their way back from down 7-4 to tie the game, but the Blue Rocks scored the winning run on a wild pitch in the 9th inning...The win for Wilmington marked their 1st road victory of the year.

BLAZIN' HOT BENGE: Cyclones OF Carson Benge is one of the hottest hitters in the league tering play on Friday...Benge is riding a 7-game hitting streak, during which he is 14-for-30 2 doubles, a triple, a home run, 9 runs scored, 5 batted in, and an even 5 walks to 5 strikeo Benge has picked up at least 2 hits in 5-straight games, including an outstanding 4-for-5 per mance on Tuesday that saw him score twice and drive in a pair...Since April 13, Benge is tied the league lead in hits with 20...He is also 3rd in batting average (.328), tied for 3rd in runs scc (13), and top 20 in OPS (.854)

ROARIN' RONALD: Brooklyn C/1B Ronald Hernández has been an integral piece of the puzzle for the Cyclones all season...The switch-hitter enters Friday on a 5-game hitting streak, during which he is 11-for-18 with multi-hit efforts in 4 straight contests...During that span, Hernandez has compiled 8 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 6 RBI...The 21-year-old has also made it a point to be more aggressive on the bases - Hernandez has already notched 8 stolen bases across his first 17 games...Hernandez logged 8 steals all of last year across 108 games

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After 4 former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, 3 alumni had already accomplished the feat before the end of March in 2025, and a 4th and 5th may be on its way...OF Rhylan Thomas (2023) had his contract selected by the Seattle Mariners from Triple-A Tacoma on Wednesday...C Hayden Senger (18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, Or Jake Mangum ('19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP Mike Vasil debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whifting 18 Ty France for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is 9 in 2015 and 2017.

LUCKY NUMBER... 15?: For the second time in April alone, the Cyclones put up a 15-spot in a 15-1 win over Wilmington on Wednesday afternoon...Sure enough, the first time Brooklyn accomplished the feat this season also came against the Blue Rocks - also in the 2nd game of that particular series...The 'Clones bashed 5 home runs in their takedown of the Nationals affiliate on Wednesday, good for the most in a game this season...Wednesday's win saw Brooklyn's run differential skyrocket to +50 on the year, trailing only Hudson Valley in the South Alantic League at +55...The 15-1 win on April 5th came thanks to a bit of a different brand of ball - Brooklyn did not hit a single home run that day...Brooklyn had not scored 15 runs in a single game at Maimonides Park since 2010

REIM TIME: INF Jacob Reimer remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...Reimer became the first player in 20 years to record a 3-home run game for the Cyclones...He is one of only three players in the history of the franchise to do so, joining Caleb Stewart on July 29, 2005, at Hudson Valley and Noel Devarez on July 1, 2001, vs. New Jersey...Reimer recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer is tied for 8th in all of Minor League Baseball in triples (3)...He leads the South Atlantic League in doubles (8), is tied for the league lead in triples (3), and is tied for 4th in home runs (5)...Reimer also leads the league in extra-base hits (16), total bases (57) and slugging (.633), is tied for 2nd in hits (28), 3rd in RBI (21), 3rd in OPS (1.007), and tied for 2nd in runs scored (19).

DIALED IN DÍAZ: RHP **Joel Díaz** has been outstanding to start the 2025 season...The 21-year-old's scoreless inning streak to start the year came to an end at 17.1 IP after allowing a run against Wilmington on April 30...The righty sports a 0.44 ERA, which is tops in the SAL among active players entering play on Friday...His 0.68 WHIP also leads the league, while boasting a 24:2 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The San Cristóbal, D.R. native is also 4th in batting average against (.164)

RUNNIN' WILD!: The Cyclones' 7-6 win over Wilmington on Tuesday saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 different players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...On a night where 8 of Brooklyn's 9 starters were Top 30 prospects in the Mets organization per MLB Pipeline, C Chris Suero and DH Jesús Báze each swiped 2 bags, while 5 other players finished with a steal...Tuesday's performance catapulted Brooklyn upwards in the stolen base category across the South Atlantic League...Gilbert Gomez's crew enters Friday with 40 stolen bags on the year...Nearly a quarter of Brooklyn's steals this season came on Tuesday night.

NEW KIDS ON THE BOARDWALK: Brooklyn made a plethora of roster moves on Monday...The Cyclones added INF AJ Ewing, RHP Chandler Marsh, and INF Marco Vargas from Single-A St. Lucie...In corresponding moves, RHP Ryan Lambert and LHP Zach Thornton were transferred to Double-A Binghamton, while INF Nick Roselli was transferred to St. Lucie...RHP Eduardo Herrera was reinstated from the Development List, and RHP Layonel Ovalles was placed on the Development List...Ewing was hitting, 400/,506/,615/1121 in 18 games with the Mets, adding a home run, 20 RBI, and 14 stolen bases...The 20-year-old led the Florida State League in steals (14), batting average (.400), on-base percentage (.506), OPS (1.121), and hits (26)...Ewing is also tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in triples (4), 11th in batting average (.386), 13th in OPS (1.074), tied for 5th in stolen bases (15), and top 20 in on-base percentage (.488)...Marsh held a 1-0 record with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 10.2 IP), and 1 save, allowing only 2 hits and 1 walk with 14 strikeouts over 8 appearances...Among FSL pitchers with 10.00 more innings of work, the 22-year-old was 5th in the circuit in strikeout rate (41.2%) and 7th in walk rate (2.9%)...Vargas slashed .409/.527/.545/1.072 in 13 games with 5t. Lucie, collecting a home run, 5 RBI, and 2 steals...Before joining Binghamton, Lambert did not receive a decision and held a 113 ERA (1 ER in 8.0 IP), allowing 3 hits, walking 1, and striking out 17 in 7 appearances...Thornton was dominant for Brooklyn, hoisting a 3-0 record with a 0.44 ERA (1 ER in 20.2 IP), 2 walks, and 25 strikeouts in 4 starts...The southpaw leaves the South Atlantic League with a league-best ERA (0.44) and 9th in WHIP (0.68)...Roselli hit 133/.220/.222/.422 with 7 runs batted in over 13 games for Brooklyn. in WHIP (0.68)...Roselli hit 133/.220/.222/.422 with 7 runs batted in over 13 games for Brooklyn.

HANG ESTAR ON THAT BABY: INF Estarling Mercado has been red hot with the bat to start 2025...The 22-year-old tallied his 3rd 3-hit game of the season last Friday night, clubbing a 2-run home run in the 3rd inning...Entering play on Friday, Mercado is hitting .367 (18-49) with 7 runs scored, 5 extra-base hits, a home run, and 10 RBI...Since April 10, the left-handed swinger has reached base safely in 10 of 11 games, posting a .395 average (15-38) with 5 runs scored, 3 extra-base knocks, a home run, and 9 batted in...Among South Atlantic League players with 50 or more plate appearances, Mercado ranks 3rd in batting average (.367), 4th in OPS (.989), 9th in slugging percentage (.531), and 6th in on-base percentage (.458).

vs. WILMINGTON: After a two-week road trip, Brooklyn returns home for a 6-game series with the Blue Rocks...Wilmington enters the series after taking 4-of-6 at home against Aberdeen...The Cyclones swept the initial series with the 'Rocks taking all 3 games from April 4-6 on Coney Island... Wilmington is 1-11 on the road this season...The Blue Rocks boast 11 of the Orioles' Top 30 prospects: INF Seaver King (4), LHP Alex Clemmey (5), C Caleb Lomavita (8), LHP Jake Bennett (17), LHP Jackson Kent (20), OF Elijah Green (24), and OF Brenner Cox (30)...Bennett is currently on the injured list...In 113 all-time meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 62-51 (.549)...Brooklyn is 36-21 in 57 home games against Wilmington (.632).

HALL OF A START: After an injury-shortened 2024, RHP Noah Hall has returned to form in 2025...
Over his first 5 starts, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 1-2 with a 2.28 ERA (6 ER in 23.2 IP), 29 strikeouts and only 18 hits allowed...Entering Friday, Hall is tied for tied for 9th in the South Atlantic League in ERA (2.28)...The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the 1st player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

START ME UP: Brooklyn's starters have been exquisite over the season's first 23 games...Cyclones starting pitchers possess a 2.87 ERA (30 ER in 94.0 IP)...Under the leadership of first-year pitching coach Jordan Kraus, the starters hold an impressive 115-to-29 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The 2.87 ERA is the lowest among starting pitching staffs in the South Atlantic League...Aberdeen is 2nd (32.98)...It is also 2nd among all High-A franchises...Kansas City's Quad Cities (197) has the lowest mark at the level...Overall, Brooklyn's pitching staff has a 3.15 ERA (70 ER in 200.0 IP). which is good for the 3rd-lowest at High-A and 2nd-lowest in the SAL behind only Quad Cities (2.52) and Hudson Valley (3.10)...The 3.15 ERA ranks 8th in all of Minor League Baseball...Quad Cities (2.52) holds the top spot.

WHAT A RELIEF!: Brooklyn's bullpen has been dominant in the 2025 season....Entering play on Friday, Cyclones relievers have an 9-3 record with a 3.40 ERA (40 ER in 106.0 IP), 4 saves, 54 walks, and an eye-popping 148 strikeouts...Brooklyn's 1.08 WHIP from relief arms is the lowest at the High-A level and 4th-lowest in Minor League Baseball...Detroit's Double-A Erie (0.96) is 1st...For the season, Brooklyn's bullpen has posted a 166 batting average against, which is the 3rd-lowest mark in Mil.B...Miami's Double-A Pensacola (.153) is 1st.

SUPER SUERO: C Chris Suero has been unstoppable in 2025...On April 17, he delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen...On April 15, the 21-year-old recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory...Suero powered a 2-run blast in the 2nd and added another 2-run shot in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his solo shot in the 6th inning on April 13 vs. Hudson Valley...Entering play on Friday, Suero is tied for 4th in the South Atlantic League in home runs (5), 4th in slugging per-centage (.590), tied for 4th in extra-base hits (11), 4th in OPS (.985), tied for 7th in RBI (16), doubles (6), and tratl bases (36) (6), and total bases (36).

ELI'S ELITE NIGHT: OF Eli Serrano III put together his best game as a professional in Thursday night's win at Jersey Shore...The 21-year-old went 5-for-6 at the plate, scored 3 runs, doubled twice, blasted a solo home run in the 8th, and drove in 3...Since 2005, Serrano is the 1st Cyclone to record 5+ hits, 3 runs, 3+ extra-base hits, a home run, and 3+ RBI in a single game...He is only the 2nd Brooklyn player to record 5-or-more hits, hit a home run, and drive in 3-or-more runs in a single game since 2005...2B Luke Ritter also accomplished the feat with 5 hits, a home run, and 3 RBI in a 5-4 win vs. Lowell in 11 innings on June 28, 2019...Ritter's home run was a game-tying blast in the 9th...Serrano is also the 2nd Cyclone to tally a 5-hit game at the High-A level and 9th overall since 2005...IF Alex Ramírez was the last player to accomplish the feat with a franchise-record 6 hits on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley....Entering Friday, Serrano is tied for 11th in the South Atlantic League in walks (15).

BORN TO RUNS: The Cyclones tallied 15 runs and 16 hits en route to a 15-1 win v. Wilmington on Wednesday,..lt marked the 3rd time this season in which Brooklyn collected 12 or more runs and 16 or more hits in a single game, and the 2nd time they've hit the 15 run plateau...The Cyclones also accrued 15 runs and 20 hits in a 15-1 win vs. Wilmington on April 5...April 24th's 12-5 win over Jersey Shore marked the 6th time Brooklyn had tallied 12-plus runs and 17-plus hits in a single game since moving to the High-A level before the 2021 season...It was also the first time since 2021 that the Cyclones have had multiple games with 12+ runs and 17+ hits in the same season.

REMEMBER ME?: Brooklyn's roster features a former Wilmington Blue Rock entering this we 6-game set... Conix Vega, who is currently on the Cyclones' Development List, spent parts seasons with the Blue Rocks from 2022 until 2024...In 91 games with Wilmington, the 26-year hit .251/.364/.360/.724 with 42 runs scored, 21 extra-base hits, 5 home runs, and 39 RBI.

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: Despite the loss on April 16, Cyclones' pitching dominated... After 4-straight runners reached base in the bottom of the 1st, Brooklyn pitching combined to retire 23 of the final 24 batters in order, allowing just one infield hit in the 3rd inning...14 of those 24 outs were recorded via strikeouts..RHP Noah Hall sat down 14 of the last 15 batters he faced, striking out 7 over 5.0 innings in the 2-1 defeat...The 23-year-old created a team-high 11 swings-and-misses...LHP Ryan Ammons, RHP Ryan Lambert, and RHP Alfred Vega united to sit down the last 9 hitters of the game in a row, 7 of which struck out...Lambert whiffed 4 of the 5 batters he faced, inducing 8 whiffs.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 10 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (12), INF Boston Baro (13), INF Marco Vargas (14), INF Jacob Reimer (20), C Chris Suero (21), OF Eli Serrano III (22) and C Ronald Hernández (26), and INF AJ Ewing (27)...Of those 10, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 8 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), and Ewing (24)...Brooklyn also hosts 9 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), and Hernández (26).

LAST START: Took a no-decision in his first Major League rehab start with Brooklyn on April 19 at Aberdeen...Allowed 1 run on 2 hits in 2.0 innings...Walked 2 and struck out 1...Threw 38 pitches and 22 strikes (57.89%)...Only run allowed came on a solo home run by SS Griff O'Ferrall in the bottom of the 1st...Relieved by RHP Eduardo Herrera to start the bottom of the 3rd inning and the game tied at 1...The Cyclones took the lead for good in the top of the 8th on a run-scoring ground out by C Chris Suero in a 4-3 series-clinching win over the IronBirds.

ON THE MEND: Blackburn will make his 2nd start as part of a Major League rehab assignment with the Cyclones on Friday...New York Mets manager **Carlos Mendoza** stated Thursday that Blackburn is slated to throw 2 innings...The 31-year-old was placed on the Mets' 15-day injured list on March 27 (retro March 24) with right knee inflammation...RHP **R.J. Gordon**, Friday's originally scheduled starting pitcher, is expected to follow Blackburn in a piggyback role...Blackburn has not pitched since April 19 due to an illness.

2024: The 31-year-old battled through injury during the season...Blackburn opened the season in the Oakland Athletics rotation...Tossed 7.0 innings of shutout ball, taking a no-decision in his season debut on 3/31 vs. Cleveland (7.0 IP, 3 H, 1 BB, 3 K)...Started his season with a 22.1-inning scoreless streak...Longest scoreless streak to start a season by an A's starting pitcher in franchise history...Broke the previous mark of 16.0 innings set by RHP Matt Keough in 1980...3rd-longest streak by an A's pitcher to begin a season behind RHP Ryan Cook in 2012 and LHP Harry Kraus in 1910...Landed on Oakland's 15-day injured list on 5/13 (retro to 5/11) with a stress reaction of the fifth metatarsal of his right foot...Sent to Single-A Stockton on a Major League rehab assignment on 7/9...Rehab transferred to Triple-A Las Vegas on 7/14...Reinstated on 7/26...Acquired by the New York Mets from the Oakland Athletics in exchange for RHP Kade Morris on 7/30...Went 4-2 with a 4.41 ERA (25 ER in 51.0 IP), 14 walks, and 38 strikeouts in 9 starts for the A's...Joined the Mets' roster on 8/2...Earned the win in his New York debut on 8/2 at Los Angeles-AL (6.0 IP, 6 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 6 K)...Landed on the Mets' 15-day IL on 8/25 (retro 8/24) with a right hand contusion...Joined Triple-A Syracuse on a MLB rehab assignment on 9/3...Reinstated on 9/30...Placed on the 60-day IL on 10/5 with a spinal fluid leak...Underwent left thoracic 12 Hermilaminotomy surgery to repair a cerebral spinal fluid leak on 10/11 at Cedars Sinai in Los Angeles...In 5 starts for the Mets, posted a 1-2 record with a 5.18 ERA (14 ER in 24.1 IP), 7 walks, and 21 strikeouts.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: Blackburn was named to his first Major League All-Star team in 2022 as a member of the Oakland Athletics...Was the A's lone representative in the contest...Earned a hold in the mid-summer classic, tossing a scoreless 4th inning in relief, picking up a swinging strikeout of San Francisco Giants OF **Joc Pederson**...The American League won the All-Star Game, 3-2...Before the All-Star Game at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles, the California native registered a 6-5 record with a 3.62 ERA (39 ER in 97.0 IP), 27 walks, and 77 strikeouts in 18 starts...Held a 2.26 ERA (18 ER in 71.2 IP) and a .616 opponent in his first 13 starts through 6/16/22...His season was cut short after being placed on the injured list on 8/5/22 with an inflamed right middle finger...Blackburn was also named an All-Star on 3 occasions at the minor league level in 2014 with Single-A Kane County, 2016 with Double-A Tennessee, and in 2017 with Triple-A Nashville.

TRADE DEAL: The Chandler, Ariz. resident has been traded 3 times throughout his professional career...After being selected by the Chicago Cubs in the 1st round (56th overall) in the 2012 MLB Draft out of Heritage High School (Brentwood, Calif.), Blackburn spent 5 seasons in the organization...Was dealt by the Cubs with 1B **Daniel Vogelbach** to the Seattle Mariners in exchange for LHP **Mike Montgomery** and RHP

Jordan Pries on 7/20/16...Montgomery would record the final out of the 2016 World Series for Chicago-NL, snapping their 108-year drought...Was dealt again 4 months later...Dealt by Seattle to the Oakland Athletics in exchange for INF **Danny Valencia** on 11/12/16.
