JUMBO SHRIMP HOLD ON FOR 3-2 WIN

A three-run fourth inning on Wednesday was just enough for Jacksonville to edge Nashville 3-2. The Sounds started the scoring on a solo shot by Lane Adams to lead off the third. In the fourth, Johnny Olmstead's two-run double put the Jumbo Shrimp in front. Olmstead then scored on Deyvison De Los Santos' RBI single. Nashville moved to within one in the seventh on Tyler Black's RBI single. The Sounds stranded two in that inning and could get no closer. Braxton Garrett struck out five in 4.2 innings of one-run ball in his start for Jacksonville.

MEN OF STEAL

The 2025 Jumbo Shrimp swiped 305 bases, blowing past the previous club record of 192 set by the 1979 Jacksonville Suns. The 2026 Jumbo Shrimp got off to a slower start in the steals department, with their 29 stolen bases through the season's first 24 games placing in a tie for 13th place in Triple-A. Since that point, however, has been a completely different story; Jacksonville's 72 steals are far and away the most in Triple-A since April 24, with Syracuse's 61 swipes ranking second.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville homered just two times in the seven games from May 2-9 - the fewest total of any Triple-A team. The Jumbo Shrimp have now gone deep in 18 of the last 21 games since that point, including an International League-season-best 13 consecutive contests from May 10-24. During these last 21 games, Jacksonville has bopped 39 long balls, the most of any team in Triple-A. Those 39 home runs have been hit by 15 different players since May 10, with Matthew Etzel's six leading the club.

GOOD MORNING, GOOD AFTERNOON, GOODNIGHT!

Jacksonville's pitching staff has recorded a whopping 622 strikeouts through 59 games, a rate of 10.5 per game. The Jumbo Shrimp have 62 more punchouts than Norfolk, the team that ranks second in Triple-A. Thus, the Tides' 560 strikeouts are closer to 18th-place Columbus/Indianapolis (500 apiece) than they are to Jacksonville in first. In addition to the swings and misses, the Jumbo Shrimp have also shown an ability to limit hard contact; their 87.3 average exit velocity against is the best such figure in Triple-A.

APRIL SHOWERS BROUGHT MAY (& JUNE) FLOWERS

The Jumbo Shrimp lost for the eighth time in 11 games on April 30 at Durham, dropping the club a season-high 6.0 games out of first place in the International League. Jacksonville responded by rattling off 18 wins during the 27 games during May - the first time a Jacksonville team won more than 17 games in May since the 2006 Suns, who went 20-10 in May. Including their contests in June, the Jumbo Shrimp have now gone 20-9 in their last 29 games. During this stretch, Jacksonville has outscored their opponents 183-144 (+39) and outhit them by a 269-218 margin (+41).

ON THE OFFENSIVE

Heading into play on April 22, Jacksonville had scored at least five runs in a contest just three times in 22 affairs, ranking last in Triple-A in runs (68, 3.1 per game) and each slash line category (.186/.296/.282/.578). The Jumbo Shrimp have now plated at least five runs 26 times in the 37 games since. During this stretch, the club ranks seventh in Triple-A in runs (235, 6.4 per game) while collectively batting .270/.354/.447/.801. They place in the top 11 in Triple-A in home runs (4th, 52), hits (T-8th, 347), average (10th, .270), OPS (11th, .801) and slugging (11th, .447).

PINTAR-EST

Over his first 20 games on the season, Andrew Pintar was just 15-for-81 at the plate, slashing a woeful .185/.295/.235/.530 with two doubles, one triple, seven RBIs, 13 walks, nine runs and 24 strikeouts (25.3 strikeout rate). The BYU product has changed his season around significantly since then; over the last 25 games, Pintar is 28-for-92 (.304/.405/.576/.997) with five doubles, one triple, six homers, 22 RBIs, 16 walks and 22 runs. Since this run began on April 28, Pintar ranks 11th in the IL in both slugging and OPS, tied for 19th in RBIs, tied for 20th in runs scored and 21st in OBP.

SHRIMP BITES

During the first two games of this series against Nashville, Jacksonville's bullpen has tossed 9.2 innings of one-run ball (4 H, R, ER, 10 BB, 10 K)... With a victory on Thursday over the Sounds, the Jumbo Shrimp will secure their fourth five-game winning streak of the season. Jacksonville has not won more than five games in a row thus far in 2026.

ABOUT BRANDON

-White was originally selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 14th round of the 2018 draft out of W.F. West High School (Chehalis, Wash.). He opted to honor a commitment to play at Washington State University, where he appeared in 30 games, including 29 starts, over three seasons (8-12, 5.69 ERA, 131.1 IP, 153 H, 67 BB, 119 K). At Washington State, White was teammates with current Cleveland Guardians first baseman Kyle Manzardo.

-The Miami Marlins selected White in the 12th round of the 2021 draft, but did not appear in a professional game until 2023 while recovering from injuries. With his professional debut for the FCL Marlins on June 6, 2023, 693 days went by between when he was drafted and when he first stepped on a mound in professional baseball.

-White was a terrific basketball player at W.F. West High School, where he was coached by his dad, Chris. Brandon earned four letters and was a two-time All-Evergreen League forward. He was named to the All-State Tournament team as a senior after leading WFHS to a 24-5 record and second-place finish in the 2A tournament. White also lettered three times in football as a wide receiver.

-After finishing high school with a 3.96 GPA, White majored in electrical engineering while at Washington State. His uncle Eric and aunt Linnda both graduated from Washington State.

-White is the oldest of three children (parents are Chris and Inga). He has a younger brother, Colby, and a younger sister, Hillary. His father, Chris, played basketball at Lower Columbia College (Longview, Wash.).

2026 SEASON
