TODAY'S GAME: Sitting one game ahead of Oklahoma City in the PCL standings, the Space Cowboys look to even their six-game set against the Aces.

ABOUT THURSDAY NIGHT: A five-run third inning sparked the Sugar Land Space Cowboys to an 11-4 win over the Reno Aces on Thursday night at Constellation Field... César Salazar drove in three runs, including a two-run single in the third, while Zach Cole added three RBI, including a home run and an RBI single... RHP Jason Alexander earned his fourth win of the season after tossing 5.0 innings with seven strikeouts, allowing three runs, two earned... Sugar Land added four runs in the seventh to break the game open, with Cole driving in the final run of the inning.

OF Jake Meyers recalled by Houston... RHP Nic Swanson promoted to Sugar Land... INF Trevor Austin promoted to Sugar Land... C Matt Thaiss released by Houston... 8/30 - RHP Brandon McPherson reinstated from the temporary inactive list... 8/28 - INF Alberto Hernandez transferred to Corpus Christi... 8/27 - INF Alberto Hernandez reinstated from the Development List... INF Braden Shewmake placed on the IL... 8/25 - INF Alberto Hernandez placed on the development list... 8/24 - INF Raynel Delgado optioned to Sugar Land... 8/23 - INF Alberto Hernandez promoted to Sugar Land from Corpus.

HOW THE TEAM WAS BUILT: The Space Cowboys roster is comprised of 11 players drafted by Houston, 4 players signed as free agents, 2 international free agents, 4 non-drafted free agents, 2 players acquired in trades, 1 player claimed off waivers, 1 player selected in the Major League Phase of the Rule 5 draft and 2 player selected in the Minor League Phase of the Rule 5 draft.

PROSPECTING: Per MLB Pipeline, the Space Cowboys roster features five of the Astros' Top 30 prospects, including RHP Bryce Mayer (#8), OF Lucas Spence (#12), RHP Miguel Ullola (#14), RHP Jackson Nezuh (#16) and RHP Alimber Santa (#17).

THAT'S A LOT OF K'S: Sugar Land hurlers combined to strikeout 14 batters on Thursday night, the fifth straight game in which Sugar Land has struck out at least 10 batters (16, 16, 11, 12, 14)... This season the Space Cowboys are second in the Pacific Coast League in total strikeouts as a pitching staff (1,193).

HAT TRICK: César Salazar went 3-for-4 with a double, three RBI, a walk and a run scored on Thursday night... It was Salazar's second three-hit game of the season, with his first coming on July 17 at El Paso... Salazar also collected his second three-RBI game of the season on Thursday night, with his first coming on July 11 against Albuquerque.

Zach Cole went 2-for-5 with a home run and three RBI on Thursday night... His three RBI matched his season high across all levels, matching his three-RBI performance with Houston on May 8 at Cincinnati.

MONTHLY HONOR: RHP Alex Santos was named the Astros Minor League Pitcher of the Month for August, marking his first career Astros Pitcher of the Month honor... In August, Santos made 10 appearances between Sugar Land and Double-A Corpus Christi, going 1-0 with a 0.68 ERA... He tossed 13.1 innings and allowed just one run while walking seven and striking out 24.

Santos earned his first career promotion to Triple-A on August 22 and continued his strong month with the Space Cowboys... In four appearances, he did not allow a run, tossing 4.1 innings while allowing one hit, walking three and striking out six.

Santos made his first appearance of September on Tuesday night against the Reno Aces, striking out five batters to set a new Triple-A career high... It marked his first five-strikeout performance since August 20, when he struck out five against Midland while with Corpus Christi.

HOME SWEET HOME: Joey Loperfido went 2-for-5 with an RBI and a run scored on Thursday night, his first multi-hit game at Constellation Field since July 30 against Salt Lake, when he went 2-for-3 with a double, an RBI, a walk and two runs scored.

SCORELESS DEBUT: RHP Nic Swanson made his Triple-A debut on Wednesday night... Swanson faced the minimum over his first two innings of work and went on to toss 2.2 scoreless innings, allowing just one hit while walking two and striking out three.

NEW LOOK: RHP Jackson Nezuh made his second appearance out of the bullpen on Thursday night... Nezuh came on in relief in the sixth inning and worked around two base runners to toss a scoreless inning while allowing one hit and recording one walk and one strikeout.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Pascanel Ferreras laced two doubles on Wednesday night... Since making his Space Cowboys debut on June 2, Ferreras has tallied 21 doubles, which leads all Sugar Land batters and ranks third in the Pacific Coast League over that span... Ferreras also recorded his 22nd multi-hit game of the season on Wednesday night, the second-most among players on Sugar Land's active roster, trailing only Cavan Biggio (23).

Ferreras has recorded a multi-hit game in five of his last seven games, going 11-for-29 (.379/.438) with three doubles, four RBI, two runs scored, three walks and a stolen base.

COLE TRAIN: Over his last eight games (since 8/25), OF Zach Cole is 9-for-27 (.333/.438) with three doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, six runs scored, five walks and three stolen bases, notching an extra-base hit in five of his last eight appearances.

HISTORIC TENTH: In the 10th inning on 8/7 @ ABQ, Sugar Land erupted for 11 runs as part of an 18-10 victory... It marked just the second 10-plus-run inning in franchise history, joining a 17-run sixth inning against Oklahoma City on Aug. 19, 2022, while falling one run shy of the PCL record for runs in a single extra inning.

WHY NOT A WALK OFF?: Trenton Brooks delivered yet another walk-off victory for the Space Cowboys on 8/21, a 4-3 win in 10 innings over Oklahoma City... It was Sugar Land's 13th walk off of the season, tied for the second most walk offs in Minor League Baseball in 2026 (Charleston - 14) and the most in a single season in Space Cowboys history, surpassing the 10 Sugar Land collected in 2024.

STRIKKKKKKKKKKKKKE 'EM OUT: Space Cowboys hurlers struck out at least 13 batters in seven-consecutive games from 7/26 - 8/2, totaling 100 strikeouts in that stretch, the most in MiLB (next, Brooklyn - 86)... It is the first time in franchise history the Space Cowboys have struck out at least 13 batters in seven-straight contest (previous, 3G, 3X, last, 8/23 - 25/24) and the longest streak of consecutive games with at least 13 strikeouts in MiLB this season (previous, Inland Empire, 6G, 4/7 - 12).

EXTRA, EXTRA!: A night after they were held to seven singles, Sugar Land connected for 14 extra-base hits on 6/17 @ ABQ (6 2B, 2 3B, 6 HR)... Their 14 extra-base hits tied the most in a single game in franchise history, which came on 5/7/23 @ ABQ (6 2B, 8 HR) in a contest Sugar Land won 24-8... Each of the Space Cowboys first nine hits on Wednesday went for extra bases.

Sugar Land's six home runs were its most in a game since 5/14/24 at Albuquerque... The Space Cowboys also recorded two triples in a game for the first time this season and their first multi-triple game since 7/22/25 at El Paso. Additionally, Sugar Land's 24 hits on Wednesday set a season high and marked the club's first 20-hit game since May 17, 2024, at Albuquerque, in which they collected 21 hits.

WHERE TO FIND US: All 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on audio streaming at SLSpaceCowboys.com/Listen. All Space Cowboys games can also be seen on the Bally Sports Live App for free, MiLB.TV, MLB.TV and the MiLB App. Garrett Greene returns for his fourth season as the primary play-by-play broadcaster for Sugar Land and will be on the call for all 150 games. He'll be joined at home and on select road games by Gerald Sanchez, who continues in his sixth season calling games for Sugar Land.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his seventh season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his sixth with Sugar Land, continuing as the only manager in Sugar Land's history since they became affiliated with the Astros. Storey earned his 500th professional win on June 4, 2025 over the Sacramento River Cats. He was named the Pacific Coast League Manager of the Year in 2024 after guiding Sugar Land to their first Pacific Coast League title. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with five seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Sean Buchanan, hitting coach Drew Saylor and development coach Wladimir Sutil. 2026 is Saylor's first in the Astros organization after he worked in the Royals organization from 2020 - 2025, mostly as a minor league hitting coordinator. He previously managed in the Pirates organization (West Virginia - 2019), Dodgers' organization (Rancho Cucamonga, 2016 - 2018) and Rockies (Tri-City, 2015). Buchanan enters his second year at the helm in Sugar Land after one season as the pitching coach with Double-A Corpus (2024) and one year with High-A Asheville (2023), along with a year in the Florida Complex League (2022). Buchanan previously coached in the collegiate ranks, working for eight seasons with stops that included Lehigh University, Albright College and DeSales University. Sutil enters his fifth season on the Space Cowboys' staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds the Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

Returned to the Pioneer League in 2024 with the Yolo High Wheelers (Davis, CA) and made 16 starts, going 6-2, 5.22 ERA in 89.2 IP, 102 H, 55 R, 52 ER, 30 BB, 78 K... Started 2025 in the Pioneer League with the Yuba-Sutter High Wheelers (Marysville, CA), making two starts... Went 2-0, 2.38 ERA in 11.1 IP, scattering 11 hits to give up only three runs with two walks and 16 strikeouts.
